#### Leading Off

The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series with the Harrisburg Senators on Friday night. It is the third-of-12 matchups between the teams this season and third-of-six in Reading. Reading won the season-series over Harrisburg last season 7-5, with a 3-3 record at home, and 4-2 on the road. The teams play next in the final week of the regular season in Harrisburg from Sept. 10-15. The season-series is tied 1-1.

#### All Around Dub

It was an all-around 9-1 win on Thursday night for Reading over Harrisburg. The Fightin Phils were paced by six runs in the second inning and excellent pitching in the win. Carlos De La Cruz, Caleb Ricketts and Robert Moore each had two hits. De La Cruz had two doubles, Ricketts two home runs and Moore drove in two runs. Ricketts also had three RBI and De La Cruz finished with two. Lachlan Wells took a perfect game into the sixth inning and allowed one blemish, a home run to the 17th hitter he faced. Wells ultimately got the win over six innings, while the bullpen closed the door with three-scoreless frames.

#### On Last Nigh

Thursday night marked a season-low two-hits allowed for Reading's pitching staff. It was the first combined two-hitter thrown by Reading pitching since Aug. 27, 2023, at Harrisburg. The game flew by as well, played in just 2:11, which marked the shortest nine-inning home game this season. The Fightin Phils collected six-extra base hits, which ties a season high.

#### Caleb Crushed It

Fightin Phils Catcher Caleb Ricketts had two home runs in Thursday night's win over Harrisburg. It marked the first multi-homer game of Ricketts career, since being drafted by the Phillies in 2022. It was also the fifth time this season a member of the Fightin Phils hit two home runs in a game. Ricketts is currently on a 12-game on-base streak, dating back to May 19. Over that stretch, Ricketts is slashing .304/.407/.543, with a .950 OPS. He's also added eight runs, two doubles, three home runs and 13 RBI. Ricketts .290 batting average would be second amongst Eastern League catchers, but he does not qualify.

### Wishing Well

Lachlan Wells tossed his best-outing of the 2024 season. He went six innings, allowing just one hit and one run, with five strikeouts. He was quite literally nearly perect, with his lone blemish a solo home run by CJ Stubbs in the top of the sixth inning. Wells retired the first 16 hitters he faced and 18-of-19 Senators' batters overall. It marked Wells' first winning decision since Apr. 10 against Portland. The last Fightin Phils pitcher to carry a perfect game past five innings was Tyler Phillips who retired 15-straight to start the game against New Hampshire on May 10, 2023. Wells 5.1 no-hit innings were also the most no-hit innings since Phillips went six no-hit innings on June 14, 2023, against Hartford.

### **Defensive Improvement**

The Fightin Phils have seen their defense improve over the past week. Dating back to May 28, the Fightin Phils have the best fielding percentage in the Eastern League at .989, and have committed the least errors with three. Reading now ranks 10th in the Eastern League in fielding percntage at .970, after spening much of the season ranked as last in the league.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

June 7, 2000: At Reading, Pete Zamora, making his first start of the season in game two of a double-header, retires all 21 Harrisburg batters to record the first perfect game in R-Phils history. A batter after Eric Valent makes a fantastic sliding catch to preserve the perfecto, Zamora srikes out Dan McKinley to end it. The 6-0 win earns the Phils a split on the day as the Senators take the first game, 1-0, defeating Brandon Duckworth on an unearned run.

### Coming from the Capital

Harrisburg enters tonight in second place in the Eastern League's Southwest Divison with a 31-22 record. The Senators are on the back-half of a two-week road trip, after splitting a six-game series at Binghamton last week. Following this week, Harrisburg returns home and welcomes Bowie to FNB Field. Harrisburg's roster features 10 players ranked amongst the Washington Nationals' top-30 prospects: Dylan Crews (2), Brady House (3), Yohandy Morales (4), Robert Hassell III (8), Andrew Pinckney (17), Cole Henry (21), Israel Pineda (22), Dustin Saenz (25), Andry Lara (28) and Marquis Grissom (29).

### Senators Pitche

Righty Brad Lord makes the start tonight for Harrisburg. This season, Lord is 6-1, with a 1.60 ERA over nine starts. He's tossed 50.2 innings, allowed 39 hits, 17 walks and 54 strikeouts. Lord earned the win at Binghamton on June 1, tossing six innings and not allowing a run, He surrendered three hits and two walks, while striking out six. Lord also pitched one game for High-A Wilmington this season, going four innings. Lord split 2023 between Single-A Fredericksburg and High-A Wilmington, combining to go 4-6, with a 4.04 ERA over 27 games and 17 starts. He made 18 appearances for Fredericksburg and nine for Wilmington. Lord was an 18th round pick in 2022 by the Washington Nationals out of South Florida. Lord was teammates at South Florida with former Fightin Phils, and current Phillies pitcher, Orion Kerkering. Lord pitched for USF in 2021 and '22, amd previously pitched for Santa Fe College in 2019 and '20.
