TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

LHP Adam Serwinowski (5-2, 5.31 ERA)

- T The 22-year-old was selected by the Cincinnati Reds in the 15th round of the 2022 draft out of Eastside High School in Taylors, SC.
- T He was traded twice in two days at the 2025 trade deadline going from the Reds to the Rays then to the Dodgers. The trade to the Dodgers also included Paul Gervase and Ben Rortvedt and sent former Driller Hunter Feduccia to the Rays.
- T He is the #11 ranked prospect in the Dodgers organization according to MLB Pipeline.
- T In his professional career, Serwinowski is 11-12 with a 4.12 ERA in 76 games (69 starts) while giving up 233 hits, 145 runs, 132 ERs, 24 HRs and 155 walks with 368 Ks in 288.1 IP.
- T In 2025, Serwinowski pitched for Dayton, Great Lakes and Tulsa. He was a combined 5-7 with a 4.03 ERA in 25 games (24 starts) while giving up 97 hits, 57 runs, 50 ERs, 12 HRs and 55 walks with 140 Ks in 111.2 IP.
- T In 2025, Serwinowski led the Midwest League in Ks with 136 in 108.2 IP. He also finished fifth in ERA at 3.89.
- T In his one start for Tulsa in 2025 against Arkansas, Serwinowski pitched 3.0 innings and gave up 6 hits, 5 runs, 3 ERs and 2 walks with 4 Ks.
- T In his 14 starts in 2026, Serwinowski is 5-2 with a 5.31 ERA while giving up 58 hits, 40 runs, 37 earned runs, 7 home runs and 38 walks with 78 Ks in 62.2 IP.
- T In his last start on June 20 against NWA, Serwinowski pitched 6.1 innings and gave up 6 hits, 3 runs, 1 earned run and 2 walks with 6 Ks.
- T In his four starts in June, Serwinowski is 2-0 with 2.18 ERA while giving up 14 hits, 7 runs, 5 earned runs, 1 HR and 13 walks with 21 Ks in 20.2 IP.
- T Serwinowski has won four of his last six starts, allowing 19 hits, 9 runs, 7 earned runs, 1 HR and 18 walks with 39 Ks in 33.0 IP. He has also held opponents to a .168 average during that stretch.
- T Serwinowski is 2-2 with a 7.79 ERA in 8 games at ONEOK Field and is 3-0 with a 2.67 ERA in 6 road games. Twenty-nine of his 37 earned runs allowed and 6 of his 7 home runs allowed have been at ONEOK Field.
- T In 2026, left-handed hitters are batting .241 with 36 Ks and 15 walks and right-handed hitters are batting .247 with 42 Ks and 23 walks against Serwinowski.
- T Serwinowski is third for the most strikeouts in the TL with 78. He has struck out six or more hitters in five of his last seven games.
- T Serwinowski has struck out the second most hitters in the TL to lead off an inning with 24. He has also walked 10 leadoff hitters which is tied for the second most in the league.

GAMEDAY NOTES

- T The Drillers have been outscored 22-5 and outhit 26-13 in the first three games against Corpus Christi. Over the past nine games, Tulsa has the second lowest team batting average in Double-A at .198 and has struck out the second most times in the TL at 92. Tulsa starting pitchers have a 6.69 ERA over the last nine games, which is the second highest in the TL and relievers also have a 2.79 ERA in that span, which is the lowest in the TL.
- T Tulsa's 24 home wins are the second most in the TL and the third most in Double A. The 23 road wins are the most in the TL and the second most in Double A.
- T Drillers starting pitchers have turned in 11 quality starts this season, the third most in the TL. Adam Serwinowski leads the Drillers with four.
- T The Drillers are 15-6 in June and are second in Double A with 40 home runs for the month. Tulsa is also batting .249 and has scored 134 runs for the month, the fifth most in the TL. The pitching staff has a 4.73 ERA in June with opponents batting .245 while striking out 197. Jake Gelof and Chris Newell have each hit eight home runs in June which is tied for the second most in Double A.
- T Since the Drillers ended their season-long, five-game losing streak on May 16, they are 27-8 and are hitting .275 with 240 runs scored, 327 hits, 60 home runs and a .867 OPS over the last 35 games. All five are best in the TL during that span. Tulsa has also scored at least six runs in 22 of the last 35 games.
- T Tulsa has scored the most runs this season in the sixth inning with 73, which are the most in the Double A in that inning. The Drillers also lead the TL batting .292 with 17 home runs, 51 walks and a .928 OPS in the sixth.
- T Josue De Paula (22), Zyhir Hope (21), Kyle Nevin (20), Elijah Hainline (11), Newell (10), Gelof (10) and Mike Sirota (10) have all recorded double digit multi-hit games. De Paula (3), Hope (1) and Kendall George (1) are the only Drillers to record four-hit games this season.
- T Tulsa has 26 comeback victories this season with 15 coming at ONEOK Field. The Drillers have scored 77 combined runs in the eighth and ninth innings, which is the third most in the TL. The Drillers largest comeback win was when they rallied from five runs down twice on April 22 at Frisco in game two of a DH and on June 13 against Wichita.
- T The Drillers are 26-9 when scoring first and have scored first in 21 of 35 road games and in 14 of 36 home games.
- T De Paula currently leads active players in the TL in average at .315, hits with 86, doubles with 22 and he is tied for the most runs score with 59.
- T Tulsa relievers have inherited 130 runners this season and have allowed 51 to score, the most in the TL.
- T The Drillers have allowed a combined 147 runs (136 ER) to score in the first, second and third innings for a 5.67 ERA, which is the second highest ERA in those innings in the TL. The Drillers also lead Double A with the most combined runs scored in the first, second and third innings with 156.
- T Tulsa's pitching staff has issued 395 walks, the most in Double A. The Drillers offense also leads Double A in walks drawn with 372.
- T The Drillers have a .260 team batting average against left-handed pitching, which is the third highest in Double A, and have hit 24 home runs, the second most in the TL. Tulsa is also batting .264 against right handers, which is the third highest in the TL and the fifth highest in Double A.
- T Fifty-seven of the Drillers 98 home runs have been hit with runners on base, which is the most homers with runners on base in Double A.
- T Hope has drawn a walk in five straight games and eight total during that span.
- T Gelof has reached base in 35 consecutive games and 55 times total, batting .258 with 31 hits, 9 HRs and 24 walks in that stretch.
- T Since joining the Drillers on May 19, Sirota has reached base in all 31 games he has played and reached base 70 total times. He is also on a 61 game on-base streak combined between Great Lakes and Tulsa and has reached base 140 times total during that span. The streak is the longest in all of MLB and MiLB this season. Since 2005, Sirota is just the 3rd player among full-season affiliated Minor League Baseball to have an on base streak over 60. It is the longest on-base streak since 2018 when Nick Martini reached base in 66 consecutive games with Triple-A Nashville. The all-time Minor League Baseball record is 74 straight games set by Andrew Velazquez in 2014 with Single-A South Bend.

TULSA RALLIES LATE— The Tulsa Drillers scored all three of their runs on Thursday night in the final two innings and earned the win, defeating the Corpus Christi Hooks 3-2 at ONEOK Field. The game was scoreless until the sixth inning when Corpus Christi scored on a bases-loaded walk. The Hooks double their lead in the eighth on Jason Schiavone's RBI single. Tulsa's comeback began in the bottom of the eighth when Mike Sirota hit a solo home run. In the ninth, Kole Myers began the inning with a game-tying solo homer and following a single, walk and sacrifice bunt, Frank Rodriguez scored the winning run on a wild pitch.
