JACOB DEGROM FANS THREE IN REHAB START AS RIDERS DOWN MISSIONS, 5-4:

The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the San Antonio Missions 5-4 on Thursday evening from Riders Field. San Antonio (22-25, 53-62) opened the scoring against Frisco (26-22, 70-47) starter and big league rehabber Jacob deGrom. Cole Cummings doubled to open the game and late scored on an RBI single by Connor Hollis, making it a 1-0 game. After allowing the first two to reach, the two-time Cy Young award winner settled in to retire the next five he faced. deGrom finished after 2.0 innings, surrendering one run on two hits and no walks while striking out three. In the bottom of the second, **Keyber Rodriguez** launched a two-run homer to left that gave the Riders a 2-1 lead. **Mitch Bratt** (2-1), piggybacking off of deGrom, entered in the third and struck out the side. The lefty sat down the first nine batters he faced. **Cody Freeman** unleashed on a solo homer in the home half of the third, giving the Riders 3-1 advantage and setting a new career-high for Freeman with 14 home runs. Frisco added another in the bottom of the fourth on a sacrifice fly by Luis Mieses that allowed Aaron Zavala to tag from third, extending the RoughRiders lead to 4-1. Bratt and deGrom combined to retire 14 batters in a row before a leadoff walk in the top of the sixth snapped the streak. San Antonio came within a run on a two-run single from Hollis that plated Anthony Vilar and Cummings. Leading 4-3 in the bottom of the seventh, **Cooper Johnson** belted his 11th homer of the season to give the Riders some breathing room at 5-3. Skylar Hales entered in eighth after Bratt tossed 5.0 innings in which he allowed two runs (one earned) on one hit and three walks with seven punchouts. In the top of the eighth, Lucas Dunn tripled and came around to score on a sacrifice fly by Cummings that cut the RoughRiders lead to 5-4. Ricky DeVito toed the rubber in the top of the ninth. After hitting the first batter he faced and walking the second, the righty struck out the side to earn his third save of the season. The Riders managed just five hits in the game, but three homers helped manufacture five runs in the win. Zavala led the way with two runs scored and Rodriguez paced Frisco with two RBI.

REHAB CITY:

After Jacob deGrom made his first rehab start for the RoughRiders on Thursday, that put Frisco at eight rehabbers this season. The hitters include Josh Jung and Nathaniel Lowe while Cody Bradford, Dane Dunning, Josh Sborz, Jacob Latz and Tyler Mahle make up the pitchers. In 2018, the RoughRiders had 12 rehabbers, the most in franchise history. This season marks the highest volume of rehabbers since 2018.

PLEASE DON'T HIT ME ONE MORE TIME:

The Riders pitching staff has been a strenghth this season, but they have struggled over their last nine games. During that stretch, Springfield and San Antonio have hit. 322 (109-for-338) with 22 doubles, six home runs and averaging 7.1 runs per game on the offensive side, taking six of eight games. Frisco's bullpen had a 7.43 ERA (33ER/40.0 IP) and has allowed 60 hits over 40.0 innings while blowing leads in four of their six losses. The Riders have lost back-to-back series for the first time all season now and are 5-10 in their last 15 games.

HOMER HAPPY

Last Friday, the Riders hit a season-high four home runs with Luis Mieses capping the night with his second for a walk-off home run. It was Mieses's third multi-home run game of his career. The RoughRiders have hit 11 home runs in the last six games, with those 11 home runs being second in the Texas League this week (Amarillo, 12). Frisco is still just seventh in the Texas League in home runs this season with 87 across their 117 games (on pace for 103, which would be for the fifth-fewest in the 21 seasons of the franchise).

RISP-FCT THIS PLEASE

Over the last 27 games, the Riders are fourth in the Texas League with a .739 OPS, third with a .261 batting average and are sixth with 4.4 runs per game. Holding them back, Frisco is just batting just .195 (48-for-246) with runners in scoring position over their last 27 games.

READY TO ROCK(ER)

RoughRiders starting pitcher Kumar Rocker has been fantastic in his five starts with the RoughRiders since returning from his "Tommy John" surgery rehab this season. In the four starts, he has pitched 19.2 innings, allowing just one run on nine hits and three walks with 29 strikeouts. Additionally, he has been incredibly efficient, averaging just 13.0 pitches per inning with the Riders. Rocker, who was selected by the Rangers as the No. 3 overall pick in the 2022 draft, is the No. 3 prospect in the Rangers organization and the No. 1 pitching prospect.

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 38-21 at Riders Field this season. At home this season, Frisco has a +66 run differential, a 4.06 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .765 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 32-26 with a 3.22 ERA, but a +21 run differential while averaging 3.9 runs per game and owning a .638 OPS (10th in the league). **Cody Freeman** has 10 of his 14 home runs at home while **Abimelec Ortiz** has hit nine of his 10 homers at Riders Field. Ortiz is batting .307/405/.525/.930 at home as opposed to .138/.202/.204/.406 on the road.

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior son, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 5-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MiLB experience.

2024 SEASON

-Krauth enters 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation

-Became the first RoughRiders pitcher to complete a quality start on 4/14/24 against Corpus Christi.

2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers.

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads

2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, one-hitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
