#### New England Double

The Fightin Phils remain in New England and continue a six-game series at the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays, on Wednesday afternoon. It is the 7th-of-17 matchups between the teams this season, and seventh-of-11 in Manchester. The Fisher Cats come to Reading for their lone series in Baseballtown from Aug. 13-18. Reading currenly leads the season-series over New Hampshire 4-2.

#### Shutout Win in Game One

The Fightin Phils won their third-straight game with a 2-0 victory over New Hampshire on Tuesday night. Lachlan Wells was spectacular again, going seven-shutout innings and striking out 11. Offensively, Justin Crawford led the way with three hits and his first Double-A RBI. As a team, Reading stole nine bases on the night. Reading scored a run in the third on a Caleb Ricketts sac fly and another in the fifth, thanks to a RBI single from Crawford. Behing Wells, Daniel Harper and Andrew Schultz both posted zeros out of the bullpen, with Schultz earned his fourth save, and third in as many appearances. It was Reading's fifth shutout win of the season and it was the second time a Reading pitcher struck out 11 in a game, with the other being Robinson Pina on May 4 at Portland.

#### Into The Wishing Well

Lachlan Wells was spectacular on the mound once again on Tuesday night. He tossed his second-straight outing of seven innings and no runs allowed. Wells matched a career-high with 11 strikeouts, with the last time he set that mark was on Sept. 1, 2016, with Cedar Rapids in the Twins system. It was just the third time in Wells' career he struck out 10+ batters in a game. With back-to-back seven-shutout innings outings, Wells has now not allowed a run in 14-straight innings. For the month of July, Wells is now 3-0, with a 1.44 ERA over four starts. Wells currently leads the Eastern League with a 1.03 WHIP, is seventh with a 3.55 ERA and 10th with 91.1 IP. He is second in the league in strikeout-to-walk ratio at 7.00. The only pitcher with a better stikeout-to-walk ratio than Wells in teammate Robinson Pina, who is at 7.42.

#### Swiper Yes Swiping

The Fightin Phils blew away a season high last night with nine stolen bases. Gabriel Rincones Jr. led the way with a career-high three stolen bases, which is also the most stolen bases by a R-Phils' player this season. The last time a Fightin Phil stole three bases in a game was Johan Rojas on June 20, 2023, at Portland. Carson Taylor also matched a season, and career-high, with two stolen bases, while Justin Crawford had two as well. Reading additioanly pulled off two double steals in the ballgame.

#### **Double Play Machines**

The Fightin Phils have turned double plays at a much higher clip as of late, with three turned in Tuesday night's win. Since the conclusion of the All-Star Break on July 19, Reading is tied with Hartford for the most double plays turned in the Eastern League with eight.

#### Castellano Cruises in Debut

Eiberson Castellano wasted no time in picking up his first victory in a Fightin Phils uniform. The 23-year old allowed two runs over six innings, with six strikeouts on Sunday. He became the first Reading pitcher to win their Double-A debut since Andrew Painter did it on Aug. 21, 2022, against Portland at home.

#### **Bombs Away**

The Fightin Phils continue to hit home runs at a torrid pace this summer. On June 1, Reading sat fourth in the Eastern League in homers hit with 44. Since then, the R-Phils have slugged an Eastern League-best 55 long balls, which leads second place Somerset by seven over that span.

#### Scouting the Fisher Cats

New Hampshire enters tonight after finishing in sixth place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division for the first half with a 30-38 record. They are sixth in the Northeast Division with a 4-16 record in the second half of the season. New Hampshire most recently dropped two-of-three at Harrisburg. Following this week, Portland heads to Binghamton. New Hampshire's roster features seven players ranked amongst the Toronto Blue Jays' top-30 prospects: Adam Macko (9), Josh Kasevich (11), Cade Doughty (13), CJ Van Eyk (16), Dahian Santos (20), Alex De Jesus (22) and T.J. Brock (28).

#### Fisher Cat Pitche

Righty Nick Fraze makes the start this afternoon for New Hampshire. He's split the season between Triple-A Buffalo and New Hampshire and has combined to go 0-2, with a 3.13 ERA over 22 games and five starts (46 IP, 39 H, 16 BB, 43 SO). He was transferred back to New Hampshire on Tuesday. Fraze last pitched two-scoreless inning on July 19 with Buffalo against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, with five strikeouts. It will be his first start since July 1. He split 2023 between New Hampshire and Buffalo, going 2-3, with a 6.12 ERA over 15 games/14 starts. The 26-year old was drafted by Toronto in the 22nd round in 2019 from Texas State
