RIDERS BLOW OUT NATURALS IN FINAL HOME GAME:

Nick Krauth struck out eight batters in 7.1 sterling innings, **Keyber Rodriguez** homered on the first pitch of the first inning, **Wyatt Langford** went 2-for-4 and the Frisco RoughRiders ran away for an 11-2 win over the Northwest Arkansas Naturals on Sunday in the final game at Riders Field this season. Krauth (5-10) allowed just two runs and five hits in his start. The right-hander used 94 pitches to get through 7.1 innings with eight strikeouts, all season highs. He became the first RoughRiders (31-32, 62-69) starting pitcher to last more than seven innings this year. Krauth walked just one batter on the night and one of the two runs charged against him scored after he left the game in the eighth. Langford had a double, a single and a walk to finish out his first week of Double-A baseball. In his first series, he went 6-for-20 with two doubles, six walks and four RBIs. Frisco was playing its first game since being eliminated from playoff contention on Saturday. On the first pitch of the bottom of the first inning, Rodriguez homered to left field. Frisco then had three innings with at least three runs scored to cement the wire-to-wire victory. Each of those innings including a two-run double, coming from Langford, **Devin Hurdle** and **Chris Seise**. Hurdle made his Double-A debut for Frisco on Sunday and went 3-for-5 with a two-run double. The 2023 product of the University of Nebraska Omaha added an RBI single in the eighth inning. **Frainyer Chavez** went 3-for-5 with two RBIs and a run scored. **Kellen Strahm** chipped in a 2-for-4 night with a walk and two runs. **Liam Hicks** doubled and went 2-for-4 with an RBI and a walk. Rodriguez followed his home run with two walks. **Robby Ahlstrom** was the only reliever for Frisco on Sunday, tossing the final 1.2 innings with one hit and no runs allowed. Northwest Arkansas (31-31, 60-71) still won the series, four games to two. Noah Cameron (3-10) took the loss with four earned runs in five innings.

WELCOME, WYATT:

Wyatt Langford, who was taken with the No. 4 pick by the Rangers in the 2023 draft, was promoted to Frisco on Monday. He is the No. 2 prospect in the Rangers system and No. 13 in MLB.com's top 100 prospects. At the University of Florida, he was a Unanimous First Team All-American selection after leading the Gators to the College World Series Championship Finals, where they fell to the LSU Tigers. On the season, the outfielder hit an astounding .373/.471/.746/1.217 with 21 home runs and 57 RBIs over 64 games. In his Double-A debut on Monday against Northwest Arkansas, he went 0-for-4, and he went 2-for-2 with a walk and a sac fly in his second game on Wednesday.

THE CARTER STORY GETS EVAN BETTER:

On Thursday, the Texas Rangers announced that No. 1 prospect and former RoughRiders outfielder **Evan Carter** was called up to the Major League roster. A second-round selection in 2020 by the Rangers out of Elizabethton High School in Elizabethton, Tennessee, Carter spent the last week of 2022 and the playoffs with Frisco before beginning the season with the RoughRiders in 2023. During the 2022 season, he won the Tom Grieve Texas Rangers Minor League Player of the Year award, batting .295/.397/.489/.886 with 21 doubles, 10 triples, 12 home runs and 28 steals over 106 games. In 97 games with the RoughRiders in 2023, Carter hit .284/.411/.451/.862 with 15 doubles, six triples, 12 home runs, 62 runs, 74 walks, 68 runs scored and 22 steals. When he was promoted to Triple-A Round Rock, Carter was second in the Texas League in walks (74) and on-base percentage (.411) while he was sixth in OPS (.862). In his MLB debut, he went 1-for-3 with a single, a walk and a stolen base.

BROKEN BATS:

Since the exit of **Thomas Saggese** and **Luisangel Acuña** at the end of July, the RoughRiders have had a tough time scoring runs on the offensive side. Since August 1st, the RoughRiders are last in the Texas League with just 4.7 runs per game, a .239 batting average and 21 home runs over their 36 games. Frisco's record since August 1st is 16-19. The 21 home runs during that time frame are the fewest in Double-A.

DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have scored in the first inning in seven of the last 15 games. The Riders are first in the Texas League in first-inning runs with 97 over their 130 games. As a team, Frisco is hitting .273/.370/.437/.807 in the first inning with 15 home runs.

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

For almost the entire season, the RoughRiders have lead the Texas League in walks as an offense. Frisco has already shattered their franchise record for most walks in a season with 657 and counting (5.0 per game). Frisco's .356 on-base percentage is on pace to set a new franchise record as well. The Riders already have four players who have cracked the top 10 in single-season walks in franchise history: **Evan Carter** (74, 5th), **Trevor Hauver** (71, 6th), **Aaron Zavala** (71, 6th) and **Kellen Strahm** (70, 7th). In 2015, **Drew Robinson** set the single-season record with 83 walks. Strahm is also third in career walks in RoughRiders franchise history with 135. Next up is **Preston Beck**, who walked 143 times over his four seasons with the Riders.

HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 45 games, Hicks is batting .305 (47-for-154)/.429/.396/.825 with nine doubles, a triple, a home run, 23 RBIs, 26 walks and 20 runs scored. In August, he hit .338 (26-for-77) with a .890 OPS.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of five teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

ABOUT NOAH

-Grew up in Berkeley, California and played under father, Matt, at Berkeley High School. Mother, Shelly Neutefeld played basketball at University of California. Older brother, Tyler, played baseball at Baylor and was drafted in the 27th round by the Cubs in 2012 (Finished his minor league career with Double-A Jacksonville in 2017 after 164 career outings).

-Went to University of Washington for college. Earned Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American honors in 2015, going 6-3 with a 2.41 ERA. In 2016 and 2017, garnered All-Pac-12 honors with a 2.98 ERA and 3.15 ERA, respectively.

-Broke into the UW career and single-season record books including: career starts (16th, 40), innings pitched (3rd, 284), career strikeouts (6th, 205) and single-season strikeouts (7th, 103) over his three seasons.

2023 SEASON

-Returned from Tommy John Surgery on June 5th and pitched four games with AZL Rangers. Surgery was performed on March 30th, 2022.

-Made best start of the season on 8/29 vs. Corpus Christi. He threw five scoreless innings and tossed three separate 1-2-3 frames.

2021 SEASON

-Named Double-A Central Pitcher of the Week for 7/19-25 after fanning 7 batters, walking none, and allowing just 2 hits over a pair of scoreless relief outings (6.2 IP total).

-Went 3-1, 4.89 (21 ER/38.2 IP) in 15 relief app. and 2-3, 3.94 (13 ER/29.2 IP) in 7 starts.

-Allowed just 1 ER over his first five outings (1.54 ERA).
