LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn completed the series sweep with a 7-6 victory vs. Winston-Salem in 10 innings on Sunday...The contest was televised on SNY...After the Dash took the lead in the top of the 10th on a wild pitch, LF Carson Benge tied the game with a double to left on the first pitch of the home half of the frame...C Ronald Hernandez provided the game-winning RBI on a fielder's choice...Benge added a 3-run home run in the 5th, as part of a 4 RBI day...CF A.J. Ewing tallied 3 hits, a RBI, and a stolen base...RF Jefrey De Los Santos added a multi-hit game...RHP Matt Allan yielded 2 unearned runs over 0.2 innings in his first start and appearance for the Cyclones in 2,077 days since September 10, 2019, vs. Lowell...RHP Joel Diaz tossed a season-high-tying 5.0 innings and struck out a season-high-matching 6 in relief...RHP Ben Simon earned the win, punching out 4 over 2.0 innings, allowing 1 unearned run.

HOW SWEEP IT IS: With Sunday's 7-6 walk-off victory vs. Winston-Salem in 10 innings, the Cyclones completed their first 6-game sweep since 2022 and their first at home since 2021...Brooklyn had not completed a 6-game sweep since taking all 6 contests at Jersey Shore from August 23-28, 2022...The Cyclones outscored the BlueClaws, 53-18, in that series...It was Brooklyn's first 6-game sweep on Coney Island since July 20-25, 2021, vs. Wilmington...The 'Clones outscored the 'Rocks, 41-22, in that set...Brooklyn has also won 6-straight games for the first time since September 3-9, 2022, vs. Wilmington and at Winston-Salem...The Cyclones clinched the Second Half South Atlantic League North Division crown during that win streak...Brooklyn has not won 7 consecutive games since August 23-30, 2022, at Jersey Shore and vs. Wilmington...Additionally, the Cyclones' 26-12 record through 38 games is tied with the 2009 squad for the franchise's best through 38 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital Era (2005-present).

CAN EW BELIEVE IT?: IF/OF A.J. Ewing has had a marvelous start to his 2025 season and was recognized as the South Atlantic League Player of the Week on Monday...In 5 games vs. Winston-Salem, the 20-year-old went 9-for-18 (.500) at the plate with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 3 RBI, 5 walks, and 6 stolen bases...Ewing led the SAL in steals (6) and on-base percentage (.609) for the week...He is the first Cyclone to receive a league weekly honor since INF Nick Lorusso and LHP Felipe De La Cruz took home Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, for May 20-26, 2024...Entering play on Tuesday, the Springboro, Ohio native is tied for 2nd in Minor League Baseball in triples (6), 3rd in stolen bases (27), 4th in batting average (.381), 5th in on-base percentage (.477), and 9th in OPS (1.064)... Since debuting with Brooklyn on April 29, Ewing leads the league in steals (13) and is tied for 3rd in triples (2), 4th in hitting (.361), tied for 4th in hits (22), 6th in on-base percentage (.443), and tied for 7th in extra-base hits (8)...The 2023 4th-round pick enters Tuesday riding 22-game on-base streak since April 18 and a 10-game hitting streak since May 6.

KEEP THE 'COASTER MOVING: The Cyclones have yet to drop a series through the first 38 games of the 2025 season...Through Brooklyn's first 7 series of the year, the Cyclones hold a 5-0-2 record...In home series, Brooklyn is 3-0-1, splitting their first full 6-game set with Hudson Valley from April 8-13...The Cyclones have not lost a series since they dropped 5-of-6 at home vs. Jersey Shore from August 20-25, 2024...Since then, Brooklyn is 7-0-2 in a series of any length.

REIM TIME: INF Jacob Reimer remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...The former 4th-round pick recorded more RBI (8) in the first 2 games of 2025 than he had in 25 outings (7) in an injury-plagued 2024...Reimer launched his 7th home run of the season in last Thursday's wim...Entering play on Tuesday, Reimer is 3rd in Minor League Baseball in extra-base hits (25), 4th in slugging percentage (.652) and OPS (1.085), tied for 5th in doubles (15), and tied for 6th in total bases (88)...The former 4th-round pick leads the South Atlantic League in runs scored (33), slugging percentage (.652), OPS (1.085), extra-base hits (25), hits (46), and doubles (15), and is tied for the league lead in total bases (88)...Reimer is also 3rd in battling average (.341), tied for 3rd in triples (3), 4th in RBI (30), 6th in on-base percentage (.433), and tied for 6th in home runs (7)...Reimer enters Tuesday on a 19-game on-base streak since April 24...In that time, he is hitting .361/.477/.694/.172 with 20 runs scored. 9 doubles, 5 home runs, 17 RBI, 13 walks, 4 steals, and 3 hit-by-pitches...Reimer is also riding a 8-game hitting streak since May 8, in which he is 11-for-29 (.379) at the dish.

ALL ABOUT THE BENGE-AMINS: OF Carson Benge has been heating up at the plate over the last few weeks...The 2024 first-round pick enters Tuesday tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in runs scored (27), tied for 6th in hits (38), 7th in batting average (.309) and slugging percentage (.504), tied for 7th in total bases (62) and RBI (25), tied for 8th in OPS (.919), 9th in on-base percentage (.415), and tied for 9th in extra-base hits (14)...The 22-year-old is riding an 9-game hitting streak since May 8 at Asheville in which he is 13-for-34 (.382) at the plate with 8 runs scored, 3 doubles, a triple, 2 home runs, 14 RBI, 8 walks, and 4 stolen bases...Benge has also reached base safely in 12-straight games since May 3 vs. Wilmington, hitting .341/.464/.659/1.123 with 11 runs scored, 3 doubles, a triple, 3 home runs, 16 RBI, 11 walks, and 5 stolen bases.

OFF AND RUNNING: The Cyclones' 7-6 win over Wilmington on April 29 saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 different players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 set on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...Brooklyn continued to wreak havoc on the bases in a May 17 win over Winston-Salem, during which the Cyclones stole 6 bases courtesy of 3 players...Brooklyn enters play on Tuesday with 88 steals, good for the 2nd most in the South Atlantic League behind only Aberdeen (109)...The 88 swiped bags are the most by the Cyclones through the team's first 38 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital ERA (2005-present) by 23 swipes...The 2024 club is 2nd with 65 steals through 38 games...

WHAT A RELIEF!: Brooklyn's bullpen has been dominant in the 2025 season...Entering play on Tuesday, Cyclones relievers have a 15-5 record with a 3.34 ERA (66 ER in 177.2 IP), 8 saves, 89 walks, and an eye-popping 237 strikeouts...Brooklyn's relief staff holds the 3rd-best strikeouts-per-9-innings ratio in Minor League Baseball (12.01), Chicap-NL's Triple-A lowa is first (12.78)...The Cyclones relievers have also held opponents to a .188 batting average, which is the 2nd lowest in the South Atlantic League and 4th-lowest in MiLB...Hudson Valley is 1st (182) in the circuit, and Miami's Double-A Pensacola (.165) leads the Minors...On the year, Brooklyn relievers have a 32.24% strikeout rate.

SUPER SUERO: C Chris Suero has been unstoppable in 2025...On April 17, he delivered the go-ahead 2-run double in the 9th, in a 7-3 comeback win at Aberdeen...On April 15, the 21-year-old recorded the 2nd multi-home run game of his career in an 8-7 victory...Suero powered a 2-run blast in the 2nd and added another 2-run shot in the 3rd...The Bronx native homered in 3-straight at-bats dating back to his solo shot in the 6th inning on April 13 vs. Hudson Valley...Entering play on Tuesday, Suero is 2nd in the South Atlantic League in hit-by-pitches (11), tied for 5th in stolen bases (15), tied for 6th in home runs (7), and 8th in slugging percentage (.491).

vs. JERSEY SHORE: After sweeping a 6-game homestand vs. Winston-Salem, Brooklyn hits the road for a 7-game series with the BlueClaws...Jersey Shore enters the series after dropping 4-of-6 at Wilmington...The BlueClaws are 7-10 at home this season and dropped 3-of-5 to Brooklyn in Lakewood from April 22-27...Jersey Shore boasts 8 of the Phillies' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: INF Devin Saltiban (9), INF Bryan Rincon (14), INF Carson DeMartini (15), OF John Spikerman (16), LHP Mavis Graves (17), RHP Alex McFarlane (18), RHP Micah Ottenbreit (28), and OF Dylan Campbell (30)...Saltiban and Chilerman are currently on the injured list. In 115 meetings Spikerman are currently on the injured list...In 115 meetings since 2022, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 59-56 (.513)... Brooklyn is 31-30 (.508) in 61 games at ShoreTown Ballpark.

MARCO POLO: IF Marco Vargas has not stopped hitting since joining the Cyclones at the end of April...The 19-year-old has reached safely in all 15 games played with Brooklyn, and in all 28 contests he has appeared in this year between the Cyclones and Single-A St. Lucie...During the 28-game on-base streak, Vargas is hitting .300/.415/.380/.795 with 23 runs scored, 3 doubles, a triple, a home run, 15 RBI, 20 walks, and 10 stolen bases.

HOMER HAPPY: Brooklyn's offense erupted in the 2nd inning on May 9 at Asheville...RF Eli Serrano III, DH A.J. Ewing, and CF Carson Benge clubbed back-to-back-to-back home runs with 1 out in the frame off Asheville's RHP Yeriel Santos...lt marked just the 2nd time Brooklyn had hit 3-straight home runs in Minor League Baseball's Digital Era (2005-present)...2B Luke Ritter, 1B Joe Genord, and C José Mena first accomplished the feat with back-to-back-to-back shots in the 6th inning on June 20, 2021, at Wilmington...SS Jesús Báez added a 4th homer run in the frame, marking the first time in MiLB's Digital Era that the Cyclones powered 4 long balls in a single inning...The feat has been accomplished just 2 other times in MiLB this season...Miami's Double-A Pensacola accomplished the feat with 4 homers in the 3rd inning on April 26 vs. Knoxville...Chicago-NL's Triple-A lowa blasted 5 homer runs in the 7th inning on April 16 vs. St. Paul...Brooklyn enters Tuesday ranked 3rd in the South Atlantic League in home runs (36)...Since 2005, only the 2021 team (39) has hit home runs through the team's first 38 games.

HALL PASS: After an injury-shortened 2024, RHP Noah Hall has returned to form in 2025... Over his first 8 starts, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 3-2 with a 1.82 ERA (8 ER in 39.2 IP), 42 strikeouts and only 26 hits allowed...Entering Tuesday, Hall is 3rd in the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.82), tied for 5th in inings pitched (39.2), 6th in batting average agiants (183), and tied for 7th in double plays induced (3)...Hall's 44.8% infield fly ball rate is 1st in the league and his 55.6% groundball rate is 2nd...The University of South Carolina product became not only the 1st player in franchise history to start on consecutive Opening Days, but the 1st player in franchise history to start multiple Opening Days.

SIR SERRANO: OF Eli Serrano III put together his best game as a professional in April 24's win at Jersey Shore...The 21-year-old went 5-for-6 at the plate, scored 3 runs, doubled twice, blasted a solo home run in the 8th, and drove in 3...Since 2005, Serrano was the 1st Cyclone to record 5+ hits, 3+ runs, 3+ extra-base hits, a home run, and 3+ RBI in a single game...He is only the 2nd Brooklyn player to record 5-or-more hits, hit a home run, and drive in 3-or-more runs in a single game since 2005...2B Luke Ritter also accomplished the feat with 5 hits, a home run, and 3 RBI in a 5-4 win vs. Lowell in 11 innings on June 28, 2019...Ritter's home run was a game-tying blast in the 9th...Serrano is also the 2nd Cyclone to tally a 5-hit game at the High-A level and 9th overall since 2005...LF Alex Ramírez was the last player to accomplish the feat with a franchise-record 6 hits on July 21, 2023, at Hudson Valley...Entering Tuesday, Serrano is tied for 3rd in the South Atlantic League in doubles (10), tied for 4th in extra-base hits (16), tied for 9th in RBI (24), and tied for 10th in runs scored (24).

BORN TO RUNS: The Cyclones tallied 15 runs and 16 hits en route to a 15-1 win vs. Wilmington on April 30..lt marked the 3rd time this season in which Brooklyn collected 12 or more runs and 16 or more hits in a single game, and the 2nd time they've hit the 15-run plateau..The Cyclones also accrued 15 runs and 20 hits in a 15-1 win vs. Wilmington on April 5...April 24's 12-5 win over Jersey Shore marked the 6th time Brooklyn had tallied 12-plus runs and 17-plus hits in a single game since moving to the High-A level before the 2021 season...It was also the first time since 2021 that the Cyclones have had multiple games with 12+ runs and 17+ hits in the same season...Before this season, the Cyclones had not scored 15 or more runs in a game at home since putting up 16 runs and 19 hits in a 16-5 win vs. Hudson Valley on June 24, 2010.

BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS: After 4 former Cyclones made their Major League debuts in 2024, Salumni have already accomplished the feat in 2025...RHP Blade Tidwell (2023) became the 5th to debut this year, suffering the loss in a start for the New York Mets in Game 1 of Sunday's doubleheader at St. Louis...Tidwell punched out C Pedro Pagés swinging for his first MLB strikeout in the 2nd...OF Rhylan Thomas (2023) went 1-for-4 with a double and 2 RBI in his debut Friday night for the Seattle Mariners at Texas...C Hayden Senger (18, '21) came off the bench and became the 103rd former Cyclone to play in the Majors and the 68th to debut with the New York Mets on Opening Day, March 27 at Houston...Three days later, on March 30, OF Jake Mangum ('19, '21) batted second and played right field for the Tampa Bay Rays and went O-for-3 with a walk...RHP Mike Vasil debuted for the Chicago White Sox a day later, tossing 2.0 innings of two-hit shutout relief, whiffing 18 Ty France for his first Major League strikeout...The franchise record for debuts in a single season is 9 in 2015 and 2017.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 11 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF Carson Benge (3), INF Jesús Báez (7), LHP Jonathan Santucci (12), INF Boston Baro (13), INF Marco Vargas (14), RHP Nate Dohm (18), INF Jacob Reimer (20), C Chris Suero (21), OF Eli Serrano IIII (22) and C Ronald Hernández (26), and OF A.J. Ewing (27)...Of those 11, 5 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn...The Cyclones also possess 10 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per Baseball America...The list features Báez (3), Benge (7), Baro (15), Santucci (16), Vargas (17), Suero (20), Reimer (21), Dohm (23), Ewing (24), and RHP Raimon Gómez (26)...Brooklyn also hosts 11 of SNY's Top 30 from Joe DeMayo...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Dohm (20), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), Hernández (26), and Gómez (28).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his 2nd victory of the season in the best start of his career last Tuesday night vs. Winston-Salem...Allowed only 1 run on 1 hit over a career-long 5.0 innings...Walked 2 and struck out a career-high 9...The 9 K's are tied with RHP **R.J. Gordon** for the most by a Cyclone pitcher in 2025 (4/25 @JS)...Only run and hit allowed came on a leadoff home run in the top of the 1st by RF **Cole McConnell**...Retired the final 13 batters he faced in order...Threw 77 pitches and 52 strikes (67.53%)...Relieved by RHP **Jace Beck** to start the top of the 6th inning and the Cyclones leading 5-1...Brooklyn went on to take the series opener from the Dash, 7-2.

2025: Broke camp with Brooklyn...Did not receive a decision in his High-A debut, striking out a career-high 5 on 4/6 vs. WIL (2.2 IP, 3 H, R, ER, BB, 5 K)...Suffered the loss in his 1st appearance of the year in relief on 4/12-1 vs. HV (3.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, ER, 3 BB, 4 K)...Earned the 1st win of his professional career in relief on 4/23 @JS (3.0 IP, 4 H, R, ER, 2 BB, 2 K)...Tossed a career-high 4.0 innings and tied a career-best with 5 K's in a no-decision on 5/1 vs. WIL (4.0 IP, 4 H, 4 R, 2 ER, 5 K)...Earned the win and struck out a career-best 9 over a career-long 5.0 innings on 5/13 vWS (5.0 IP, H, R, ER, 2 BB, 9 K).

WHAT'S IN A ROLE: Girton has split time in 2025 between Brooklyn's rotation and bullpen...The 23-year-old started the year in a piggyback tandem with RHP Joel Díaz before moving to the rotation full-time after LHP Zach Thornton's transfer to Double-A Binghamton...In 3 starts, Girton has a 1-0 record and a 3.60 ERA (6 ER in 15.0 IP) with 12 hits allowed, 6 walks, and 23 strikeouts...In 2 appearances out of the bullpen, the right-hander is 1-1 with a 3.00 ERA (2 ER in 6.0 IP), 7 hits allowed, 5 walks, and 6 punchouts.

2024: Signed with the Mets on 7/20 and assigned to Single-A St. Lucie on 8/28...Made his professional debut in relief, striking out the side in order on 8/29 vs. Jupiter (1.0 IP, 3 K)...Took a no-decision in his first and only pro start on 9/3 at Clearwater (1.0 IP, 2 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 1 K)...In 3 appearances (1 start), did not receive a decision and tallied a 12.00 ERA (4 ER in 3.0 IP) with 5 hits, 4 walks, and 5 strikeouts.

OKLAHOMA! ON BROADWAY: Girton is one of three Oklahoma natives on the Cyclones' Opening Day roster...Girton (Gage, Okla.) joins RHP **Jace Beck** (Tuttle, Okla.) and OF **Carson Benge** (Yukon, Okla.) as Sooner State natives with Brooklyn.

BOOMER SOONER: Girton spent the 2024 collegiate season at the University of Oklahoma...Girton grew up about 177 miles northwest of the university in Gage, Okla... Corralled a 0-1 record with a 7.32 ERA (29 ER in 35.2 IP), 1 save, 44 hits, 31 walks, and 47 strikeouts in 16 appearances (10 starts) for the Sooners...In first outing as a Sooner, went 4.0 innings and surrendered 1 run on 3 hits and 3 walks with 9 strikeouts in a win vs. No. 9 Tennessee on 2/17...Tossed 4.0 innings of 1-hit ball with 2 strikeouts in a win at TCU on 3/16...Started and struck out a pair in 2 postseason appearances vs. Kansas (5/24) and vs. UConn (6/2).

RED RAIDER NATION: The 23-year-old started his college career at Texas Tech University...During his 3 years with the Red Raiders, Girton compiled a 7-2 record with a 5.21 ERA (54 ER in 93.1 IP), 1 save, 77 hits, 57 walks, and 77 strikeouts in 42 outings (9 starts)...Named to the All-Big 12 Academic Second Team in 2023...Named Big 12 Pitcher of the Week on 2/20/23 after tossing 6.0 shutout innings out of the bullpen on Opening Day vs. Gonzaga...Had his 2022 season cut short due to injury.
