YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels split a doubleheader with the Sea Dogs. Portland won Game 1, 4-3. Tyler Fitzgerald gave Richmond a 1-0 lead in the second with an RBI single. Portland tied the game, 1-1, in the third with an RBI single by Ceddanne Rafaela. The Flying Squirrels moved back in front with a solo homer by Frankie Tostado in the fourth. Mike Gigliotti extended the lead to 3-1 in the fifth with an RBI single. The Sea Dogs moved ahead in the sixth with a solo homer by Rafaela and a two-run homer by Tyreque Reed. In Game 2, the Flying Squirrels won, 4-2. Matt Frisbee pitched a complete game and allowed two runs. Richmond took a 3-0 lead in the after a run scored on an error and Sean Roby hit a two-run homer. The Sea Dogs closed the score to 3-2 in the fifth with a two-run double by Tyler Dearden. Roby hit his second homer of the game, his 18th of the year, in the sixth to push the lead to 4-2.

**TODAY'S GAMES:** The Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. This series is the first between the two teams since 2019. That year, the Flying Squirrels won two in a three-game set at Hadlock Field from June 4-6 before being swept in a three-game set at The Diamond from July 30-August 1. This year, the Flying Squirrels and Sea Dogs will also face each other in a six-game series in Portland from August 9-14. Richmond 3-6 in games against teams from the Northeast Division this year.

PLAYOFF HUNT: Richmond tied for second place in the Southwest Division, one game behind Akron and even with Erie. The Flying Squirrels hold the tiebreaker against both teams with a winning head-to-head record. Three games remain before the Eastern League's first half closes on Sunday. The first-half and second-half division champions will meet in a best-of-three series in the Eastern League Postseason, followed by a best-of-three championship series.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 15-7 since May 29 after losing nine of their previous 12. Last week, they won four-of-six on the road against Harrisburg, maintaining first place in the Southwest Division. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost three and split one this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 725 strikeouts and 58 HBPs. They are second with 86 homers. Richmond pitchers lead the league with 275 walks issued. The Flying Squirrels are 20-13 at home this year.

**THE SEA DOGS** have gone 5-3 in their last eight games after losing their previous seven games from June 7-14. Portland is 7-17 since May 27. The Sea Dogs are 9-6 against the Southwest Division this season, having faced Harrisburg in two sets prior to this week. Portland's roster includes four of MLB.com's top-30 Red Sox prospects, including LHP Chris Murphy (10), LHP Jay Groome (11), SS Christian Koss (26) and OF/INF Ceddanne Rafaela (27).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Kai-Wei Teng makes his team-leading 14th start of the season. Last time out, he struck out eight batters and allowed two runs over six innings in a win at Harrisburg on Saturday. Teng has allowed three-or-less runs in each of his last five starts since May 26, working at least four innings in four of them. Teng spent the entire 2021 season with the High-A Eugene Emeralds, going 5-6 with a 4.33 ERA in 21 starts. For the season, Teng led the High-A West with 142 strikeouts, ranked tied for second with 21 games started, tied for first with one complete game and sixth with 95.2 innings pitched. He also ranked fourth in the Giants system in strikeouts. Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins out of Taiwan in 2017. During his second season in 2018, he was traded to the Giants along with outfielder Jaylin Davis in exchange for right-handed pitcher Sam Dyson. For more on Teng, see page two.

FOR PORTLAND: Right-hander Brett Kennedy makes his fifth start and sixth overall Eastern League appearance on the year. In his last outing, Kennedy pitched six innings and allowed three runs with no strikeouts. He has pitched six innings in each of his four starts for the Sea Dogs. Kennedy began the season with the independent Long Island Ducks and went 2-1 with a 3.03 ERA in six starts. He signed as a free agent with the Red Sox on May 24. Kennedy was selected in the 11th round of the 2015 MLB Draft by the San Diego Padres out of Fordham in 2015. He reached the majors with the Padres for six starts in 2018, going 1-2 with a 6.75 ERA.

STRONG ARMS: Richmond pitchers have combined for a 2.16 ERA (18 ER/75.0 IP) in nine games since June 14, the best in the Eastern League, with 84 strikeouts and 33 walks. Opposing batters are hitting .216 in that span.

THE STARTING LINE: Over the last nine games since June 14, Flying Squirrels starting pitchers have combined to go 5-2 with a 1.86 ERA (11 ER/53.0 IP), picking up 55 strikeouts with 18 walks. Over that span, Bryan Brickhouse is 1-1 with a 0.82 ERA (1 ER/11.0 IP) in two starts, Kyle Harrison is 1-0 with a 0.82 ERA (1 ER/11.0 IP) in two starts, Jake Dahlberg is 0-1 with a 3.48 ERA (4 ER/10.1 IP) in two starts, Matt Frisbee is 2-0 with a 1.84 ERA (3 ER/14.2 IP) in two starts and Kai-Wei Teng is 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA (2 ER/6.0 IP) in one start.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,058) and total attendance (193,845). Richmond is 12th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 86 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (88). Sean Roby is tied for second in the league with 18 homers on the season, with 15 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 180 homer runs. The Flying Squirrels have already hit more homers than entire seasons in 2010 (71), 2011 (83) 2012 (76), 2014 (74) and 2015 (61), 2016 (83) and 2019 (84).

GO, DIEGO, GOI: After hitting 173 (22-for-127) over his first 35 games of the season, Diego Rincones is batting .421 (16-for-38) with three doubles, four homers and 13 RBIs over his last 10 games since June 7. He started the stretch with two doubles on June 7 against the SeaWolves and hit his first homer of the season the next day. He collected a season-high three hits in the series finale against the SeaWolves on June 12, capping the game with a walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning. It was his second walk-off hit as a member of the Flying Squirrels. He has hit a home runs in three consecutive games played, going deep on Friday and Saturday at Harrisburg and again on Tuesday against the Sea Dogs.

HOMER STREAKING: Diego Rincones has homered in his last three games, the third time in his Richmond career he has compiled a three-game homer streak, which is the most in team history. He also hit homers in three consecutive games from July 17-20, 2021 and August 21-24, 2021. No player in team history has homered in four straight games. The only other player with multiple three-game homer streaks is **Sean Roby**, who did it in April and again earlier this month. Other three-game homer streaks for the Flying Squirrels were accomplished by **Charlie Culberson** (2011), **Jarrett Parker** (2013), **Adam Duvali** (2013), **K.C. Hobson** (2017) and **Gio Brusa** (2019).

SHANE TRAIN: Since May 1, Shane Matheny is batting .308 (33-for-107) with six homers, four doubles, a triple and 19 RBIs. He has picked up a pair of two-homer games, one on May 1 at The Diamond against Bowie and another on May 12 at Harrisburg. They were the second and third multi-homer games of his professional career and his first since 2019. From May 14-June 10, he posted a 13-game hitting streak, tied for the longest in the EL this season, even with a 13-game streak for Portland's Pedro Castellanos from May 6-22. He was placed on the 7-day IL on May 29 and reinstated on June 7. In his return, he picked up a pair of RBI singles. From May 1-June 11, Matheny posted a 24-game on-base streak, which was the second-longest in the league this season.

**TOASTY: Frankie Tostado** went hitless over his a five-game stretch from June 9-15, going 0-for-19 in that span with six strikeouts before picking up six hits over his last six games since June 16. From April 22-June 8, Tostado hit .342 (51-for-149) with seven homers, nine doubles, a triple and 26 RBIs in 39 games. In the Eastern League, Tostado is ranked fifth in batting average (.295), tied for fourth hits (65) and tenth in total bases (109).

ROBUST: Sean Roby hit his 17th and 18th homers of the season in the second game of Thursday's doubleheader. He is second in the EL in home runs this year, trailing Erie's Kerry Carpenter (22). He has hit 15 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by Adam Duvall in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He also extended his franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four. Roby is also now tide for the second-most homers in a single season in team history with 18, even with Jarrett Parker (2013) and Mario Lisson (2014) and trailing only David Villar's record 20 homers last season.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: Frankie Tostado is ranked fifth in batting average (.295), tied for fourth hits (65) and tenth in total bases (109). Sean Roby is second in home runs (18) and ninth in SLG (.502). Mike Gigliotti is tied for seventh in stolen bases (15). Ryan Walker is tied for first in wins (6) and Bryan Brickhouse is tied for third in wins (5). Chris Wright is tied for fifth in saves (6).

WHERE THE SEA DOGS RANK: In the Eastern League, Pedro Casellanos is eighth in RBIs (42), tied for fourth in hits (67), tied for third in doubles (18), tied for sixth in extra-base hits (27) and tied for sixth in total bases (111). David Hamilton is first in triples (6) and tied for first in stolen bases (25). Devlin Granberg and Jonathan Guzman are tied for second in triples (4).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Kyle Harrison (2), R.J. Dabovich (17), Ricardo Genovés (24) and Chris Wright (27). Franklin Labour is rated by Baseball America as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Simon Whiteman is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by Baseball America as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Dabovich (16), Brett Auerbach (27), Genovés (29) and Kai-Wei Teng (30). Harrison is Baseball America's No. 64 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 45 overall prospect.
