FROM THE CROWS NEST

THE AX MAN: In his Single-A debut on Friday, **C Axiel Plaz** went 2-for-4 with a solo-home run in the seventh inning. The 18-year-old catcher was called up from the FCL Pirates on Friday night after spending all of last season with the FCL Pirates. Plaz was listed as the Pirates' No. 28 prospect by Baseball America last season.

HERE COMES THE POWER: The Marauders clubbed another two home runs on Friday night against Tampa to bring their team total up to a dozen home runs in 15 games durign the month of May, the second-most in the FSL.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Tuesday's win versus Tampa marked their 16th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own a 9-7 record in those games with 26 of their first 37 (70.3%) games having been decided by three runs or less. They played five one-run games during their 11-game winning streak thas was snapped on Wednesday.

THE TURTLE GUY: After tossing 1.1 scoreless frames on Tuesday to pick up his second save of the season, **Magdiel Cotto** extended his scoreless innings streak to 10.0 innings. Over his last five appearances, Cotto has allowed just four hits while striking out seven batters.

AWARDS SEASON: On Monday, Major League Baseball announced that **C Omar Alfonzo** was named the FSL Player of the Week, becoming the first Marauder this season to garner a weekly award. In six games last week against St. Lucie, Alfonzo went 9-for-18 with two doubles, one home run, six RBIs, five walks, two intentional walks, and five runs scored. The 20-year-old wrapped up his week reaching base five times on Sunday, going 3-for-4 at the plate with a double and two RBIs.

ILIKE TURTLES: Saturday night at LECOM Park was anything but ordinary when a turtle appeared in left-centerfield in the top of the second inning to halt play. LHP Magdiel Cotto swooped in to save the day by carrying the turtle back to the bullpen before being released in a pond just beyond the outfield wall. The video has been shared by several outlets, including The Athletic, Sports Center, Pardon My Take, Jomboy, and Sports Illustrated.

WE CALL THAT A WINNING STREAK: The Marauders' franchise-record 11-game winning streak came to an end on Wednesday night in Tampa, as they fell 5-0. At the time, it was tied with the Jersey Shore Blue Claws (PHI, A+) for the longest streak in the Minors this year. The Marauders had won won nine straight three times before, back in 2022 and 2011. They also won five straight from 5/25/21 - 6/3/21 en route to capturing the 2021 Low-A East Championship. Bradenton had three streaks of six-plus wins last season with their longest streak lasting from April 14 - April 21 et seven games.

KING OF THE HILLS: Since April 17, the Bradenton Marauders pitching staff holds the third-best ERA in Minor League Baseball at 2.73 with the Erie Seawolves (DET, Double-A) leading the way with a 2.66 ERA

GOT EM!:Hunter Furtado picked off Kevin Villavicencio in the eighth inning last Friday night for the Marauders 11th pickoff of the season. As of Saturday, the Marauders are currently tied for third in MilB, with the Quad Cities River Bandits (High-A, KC) leading the way with 13. Bradenton had 23 last season, which ranked the second-most in the FSL and 11th-most in MilB.

HEATING UP: Esmerlyn Valdez singled in the eighth inning on Friday to extend his on-base streak to 18 games. During the streak, Valdez is hitting
