LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox were handed their first walk-off loss of the season on Friday night, falling on the wrong-end of an 11-10 game in extra innings to the Reading Fightin Phils. Bowie lead twice in the game, and were up by as many as four runs, but Reading used three home runs as part of a constant fight back. Bowie outthit Reading 16 to 15, the third time this season Bowie has lost while outthitting their opponent. The 31 combined hits are the most in any game in the Eastern League so far this season. Shayne Fontana was a key contributor at the plate for Bowie, going 3-for-5 with two doubles, an RBI, and three runs scored. Cody Roberts popped his second home run of the season, a two-run shot in the seventh inning.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

One of the most tenured teams in the entire league, Reading is running into many of the same struggles that plagued them in 2021, as they have been at least five games back in the Northeast Division standings for 12-straight games. The Fightins are batting a league-worst .203 at the start of this series. Opponents have made the most against Reading pitching this season, as their 5.04 ERA is the third-highest in the league. Despite playing in a notably hitter-friendly stadium, Reading pitchers have allowed only 22 home runs, the fourth-fewest in the league, with 12 coming at home.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander James McArthur opened the season 0-3 with an ERA north of 10, but has since bounced back for two strong starts to bring those numbers to a more reasonable level. Bookending the series in Portland for Reading, McArthur fired ten total inning against the Sea Dogs, and allowed only two runs and six hits while striking out 11 batters. A member of the Phillies 40-Man, McArthur's fastball can hit up to 96 at points, and only compliments it with two other pitches, a curveball that has been graded as above-average, and can move on both planes, as well as a changeup.

FUN WITH NUMBERS

The 10-11 loss for Bowie on Friday was their highest-scoring loss of the season, and the first time Bowie scored ten or more runs in a loss since 8/31/21 when they fell to Somerset 13-10. Bowie also lead in that game, 10-7, but allowed six runs in the eighth inning. The 31 combined hits in Friday's loss is the most in any game in the Eastern League this season, the 21 total runs is the second-most in a game this year, trailing Bowie's other high-scoring affair, their 20-6 win over Akron on 4/19. The 372 total pitches thrown was the fifth-most in a game this season in the EL, and one of only six games in the league this season to extend past ten innings.

SETTLING OUT WEST

Infielder Jordan Westburg may have found a new home in the Bowie lineup after a recent change. In a 16-game stretch from 4/20-5/10, Westburg was only able to manage a 6-for-59 mark at the plate (.102) with two doubles, one home run, three RBI, three runs scored, eight walks, and 23 strikeouts, all while batting among the first four spots in the lineup. After moving down into the fifth spot in the lineup on Wednesday, Westburg has hit 5-for-11 (.455) with three doubles, one home run, six runs driven in, four runs scored, and only three walks against three strikeouts.

NO-NO? YES-YES!

Garrett Stallings and Morgan McSweeney joined Baysox history on Sunday, combining for the team's 11th No-Hitter, a seven-inning win over Harrisburg. Of Bowie's 11 No-Hitters in franchise history, five of them have now been thrown against Harrisburg. Expanding on the coincidence of the beltway affiliates, each of Bowie's last four no-hitters, stretching back to 2007, have all been against the Senators.

TOP GUNNAR

Infielder Gunnar Henderson was named the Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday, after going 9-for-17 at the plate with a double, a home run, four RBI, and five runs scored. With a 1-for-3 day at the plate on Friday, he extended his on-base streak to 29 consecutive games, every game this season for the Baysox, and the longest stretch in the league. His 31 walks and 26 runs scored also leads the league. Gunnar has increased his walk rate from just 12.1% across three levels played last season up to over 20% so far this season. Henderson is ranked as the Orioles #3 prospect and Minor League Baseball's #64 overall prospect entering the 2022 season according to MLB Pipeline. Listed as #4 for the Orioles and #57 in MiLB by Baseball America. He was named the Orioles Organization All-Star at third base by MiLB.com for his 2021 season.

Career Notes

- Spent his time following the 2020 draft at the Angels alternate site at Long Beach State before being dealt to Baltimore the same December
- Initially drafted by the Angels in the 5th round of 2020 out of the University of Tennessee, but did not appear in a game for the organization.
- Orioles EVP/GM Mike Elias had targeted Stallings in the 2020 draft, but was taken earlier by the Angels.
- Threw two complete game shutouts in his junior season at Tennessee. He earned two SEC Pitcher of the Week awards, and was also named to the 2019 SEC All-Defensive team

What They're Saying:

Baseball America (2021): "Stallings is a polished righthander who mixes his pitches, limits his walks and lasts deep into his starts. His fastball sits 90-92 mph and his short, sharp mid-80s slider is his best secondary offering. Stallings mixes in an average low-80s changeup he commands well and a big, upper-70s curveball he is trying to throw for more strikes early in the count. He has a smooth, up-tempo delivery that is easy to repeat and allows him to command and sequence his four-pitch repertoire effectively. Stallings has a chance to move fast because of his command, advanced feel for pitching and business-like approach. His lack of a plus pitch limits his ceiling to a back-of-the-rotation starter."

Baysox Pitching Coach Josh Conway - Working with Stallings at Aberdeen in 2021: "He's a gamer. As far as the stuff goes, he's not going to blow up the radar gun, but he knows how to use what he's got....He's always in the zone.....a very efficient guy pounding the zone, coming right after you and basically daring you to hit him, which is nice. And he takes his strikeouts as needed. He found himself in a ton of 0-2, 1-2 counts this year, just being ahead of hitters, attacking guys in four pitches or less. Really had that mentality of, 'I'm just going to go right after you.' It was intriguing to see. He did a great job."

Notes by Outing

- 4/13 @ BNG Allowed three baserunners in the first inning, but no runs across thanks to a double play. Struck out two batters in a perfect second inning, but allowed two runs across in the third on consecutive two-out doubles. Followed with a perfect fourth on a pop out and two ground outs. Bowie had an early three-run home run, Binghamton would tie the game, and Bowie would sneak a run across in the seventh to win.
- 4/20 v AKR Allowed a two-out single to Brayan Rocchio in the first inning, the only hit in the game for Akron. Logged two strikeouts looking in the second inning, part of a string of nine consecutive outs after the single. Allowed a two-out walk in the fourth inning, then again in the fifth inning. Ryan Watson piggybacked with four perfect innings. Tied for the longest scoreless outing of his career.
- 4/26 @ RIC Struck out the first two batters of the game, but allowed a solo home run to Sean Roby. Loaded the bases to start the second inning on a walk, a hit-by-pitch, and an error, but retired the next eight batters and worked a double play to avoid more runs. Bowie was shutout.
- 5/1 @ RIC All four hits given up to Richmond went for extra-bases, and all scored. Double and home run by Frankie Tostado, double by Rob Emery, and 2R HR by Shane Matheny.
- 5/8 v HBG **11th No-Hitter in Bowie Baysox history.** First game of a doubleheader against Harrisburg after rainouts the previous two days. Walked the third batter of the game, and eventually one more walk with one out in the third inning. Retired the last 11 batters faced. Worked eight ground outs, two fly outs, one pop out, and a line out. Morgan McSweeney closed the game with a perfect seventh inning.

Coaching Staff

Manager: Kyle Moore

The 2022 season will be the 13th season for Moore in the Orioles organization. He played 29 games over two seasons (2010-11) before becoming a coach.
