VESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the RubberDucks, 5-4, in extra innings. Richmond took a 1-0 lead in the first with a solo homer by Ismael Mun-guia. Akron took a 2-1 lead in the fourth with an RBI double by Milan Tolentino and an RBI single Joe Naranjo. In the fifth, Jimmy Glowenke tied the game, 2-2, after stealing third and scoring on a throwing error. Later in the inning, Yoshi Tsutsugo gave Richmond a 3-2 lead with an RBI single. Logan Wyatt extended the lead to 4-2 in the sixth with an RBI single. The RubberDucks rallied to tie the game, 4-4, with a two-out, two-run homer by Michael Berglund in the top of the ninth. Richmond walked off in the bottom of the tenth when Brady Whalen placed a bunt and a throwing error allowed him to reach and scored Shane Matheny from second.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. The two teams split a six-game series at The Diamond from May 16-21 and split another six-game series at Canal Park from July 18-23 coming out of the All-Star Break.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 40-26 in their last 66 games since June 18, the best record in the Eastern League in that span, and have gone 6-1 in their last seven games. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.97 ERA is third-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 471.0 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 633.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.82 ERA, which is the fourth-lowest in Double-A. Richmond hitters have homered 27 times over the last 14 games since August 22, which is the most in the minors during that time frame.

THE RUBBERDUCKS are 6-11 in their last 17 games, including dropping six straight from August 18-24. Akron's roster includes two of Baseball America's top-30 Guardians prospects, including 2B Juan Brito (No. 7) and OF Petey Halpin (No. 22). MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects list includes six Akron players, including Brito (No. 6), RHP Tanner Burns (No. 19), Halpin (No. 20), LHP Doug Nikhazy (No. 26), LHP Will Dion (No. 27) and INF Milan Tolentino (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Nick Zwack takes the mound for his 15th start of the year and his third against Akron. He last pitched on Friday at Hartford and threw four innings, surrendering two runs. He first faced the RubberDucks on May 20 at The Diamond and allowed four runs over 31 innings in a no-decision. He pitched at Akron on July 21 and was charged with a loss, allowing three runs over 4.2 innings with five strikeouts. Zwack was selected in the 17th round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Mets out of Xavier and traded to the Giants last August as part of the deal for Darin Ruf. After starting the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, Zwack earned a promotion to High-A Brooklyn, where he went 5-1 with a 1.84 ERA in 14 outings, landing him a South Atlantic League Post-Season All-Star selection. He closed the season with six starts for High-A Eugene following the trade. Zwack, a native of Minneapolis, played his college career at Xavier, where he was a First-Team All-Big East selection in 2021 as a senior. For more on Zwack, see page two.

FOR AKRON: Left-hander Doug Nikhazy makes his 22nd start of the season and his third against Richmond. Last time out, he threw 4.1 innings and FUR AKRON: Left-hander Doug Nikhazy makes his 22nd start of the season and his third against Richmond. Last time out, he threw 41 innings and allowed two runs while striking out 10, one shy of his season high, on Friday at Bowie. At The Diamond on May 18, he allowed one unearned run over five innings and struck out nine, which was a season high at the time. He faced Richmond on July 21 at Canal Park and threw five scoreless innings with six strikeouts in a win. He has not surrendered an earned run over 10 innings of work against Richmond this season. On the season, Nikhazy has struck out 120 batters, which is tied for the seventh-most in the Eastern League this year and leads all Akron pitchers. Nikhazy was selected by Cleveland in the second round (58th overall) in 2021 out of Ole Miss. In college, he set the Rebels' freshman record with 86 strikeouts in 2019 and ranked fifth in NCAA Division I with 142 strikeouts in 2021. He began his first professional season last year with High-A Lake County and went 4-4 with a 319 ERA in 21 starts. He joined Double-A Akron for his final six outings of the year, going 0-2 with an 11.57 ERA. Nikhazy is rated by MLB.com as the No. 26 Guardians prospect.

PLAYOFF CHASE: With 10 games remaining in the regular season, the Flying Squirrels are tied for first place the Southwest Division Second-Half stand-ings, even with the Erie SeaWolves, who have already clinched a spot in the postseason by winning the division's first half, and two games ahead of the Bowie Baysox. Akron is seven games back in fourth. The winner of the second half in the Southwest Division will face Erie in the first round of the playoffs, unless the SeaWolves win the second half, which would lead to the second-place team (determined by winning percentage) in the second half advancing to the postseason. The Flying Squirrels are aiming to reach the playoffs for the fourth time in team history. They reached the proteesers in 2011 2014 and 2020 postseason in 2011, 2014 and 2022.

POWER SURGE: The Flying Squirrels have homered 27 times in their last 14 games dating back to August 22, which is the most in the minors during that span. Last Thursday in Hartford, the Richmond hitters combined for eight home runs, which set a new single-game franchise record. It was also tied for the most homers by a team in a single game in the minors this year, even with an eight-homer performance by Sugar Land at Albuquerque on May 7. It was also the most homers in an Eastern League game since the Harrisburg Senators homered eight times at Erie on June 18, 2006.

COMING UP CLUTCH: Of the Flying Squirrels' last 12 wins, they have scored the winning run in the seventh inning or later in eight of them. On August 17, **Victor Bericoto** hit a walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning the beat Harrisburg after Richmond entered the inning trailing, 6-2, tying the largest ninth-inning comeback in franchise history. On August 19 against the Senators, **Sean Roby** won the game with a walk-off scriftce fly in the bottom of the ninth. On August 23 at Portland, **Jimmy Glowenke** hit a go-ahead single in the top of the ninth inning at Portland to give Richmond a 9-8 win. On August 27 in the second game of a doubleheader at Hadlock Field, the Flying Squirrels rallied after trailing, 8-6, down to their final out in the seventh before **Brady Whalen** and Bericoto hit back-to-back homers to tie the game and **Logan Wyatt** hit a two-run, pinch-hit homer for a 10-8 win. On August 30 at Hartford, Wyatt broke a 4-4 tie with a solo homer in the top of the seventh for a 5-4 win. On Saturday night, **Will Wilson** hit a go-ahead single in the eighth, starting a burst of seven runs over the next two innings in a 10-3 win. In the series finale at Hartford on Sunday afternoon, Richmond scored five runs in the seventh to take a 9-6 lead and won by that score. On Wednesday against Akron, the Flying Squirrels picked up a walk-off win in the 10th on an error.

BERICOTO BASHING: Victor Bericoto has homered six times in his last 11 games dating back to Thursday. In his last 17 games since August 16, Bericoto is batting .333 (21-for-63) with six homers, six doubles and 19 RBIs. On August 17 against Harrisburg, he hit walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning to cap a four-run comeback, which was tied for the largest ninth-inning comeback win in franchise history. On August 24 at Portland, he homered and drove in two runs. He added another homer on August 26 at Portland. Bericoto hit a game-tying homer in the last inning of Game 2 of the August 27 doubleheader at Portland. Last Wednesday, he hit a two-run homer at Hartford. On the year, Bericoto leads the Giants system with 25 homers (16 with Eugene and nine with Richmond) and also leads the organization with 82 RBIs.

LONGBALL LOGAN: Logan Wyatt is batting .341 (15-for-44) with five homers, three doubles and 13 RBIs in his last 13 games since August 20. He has homered four times in his last 10 games since August 26. He hit a two-run homer in the ninth inning that night at Portland. On August 27 in the second game of a doubleheader, he hit a go-ahead, two-run homer with two outs in the seventh to lift Richmond to a 10-8 win over the Sea Dogs. Last Wednesday at Hartford, he launched a go-ahead, solo homer in the top of the seventh for a 5-4 win. His 17 homers between Eugene and Richmond this season are tied for the third-most in the Giants organization.

GLUW SHOW: Jimmy Glowenke is has picked up 18 hits and eight RBIs in his last 13 games dating back to August 23, batting .487 (18-for-37) with three homers, two doubles and nine walks. He started this most recent hot stretch on August 23 at Portland, when he hit a two-run homer and picked up two RBI singles, matching his season high with four RBIs for the game. On the year, Glowenke is batting .355 (39-for-110) in road games, including all seven of his Double-A homers, compared to .175 (18-for-103) at The Diamond. Since July 1, Glowenke is batting .324 (46-for-142) with seven homers and 27 RBIs in 45 games. On Monday, Glowenke was named the Eastern League Player of the Week for his performance at Hartford last week.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has reached base 67 times in his last 37 games since July 25 (36 hits, 30 walks, 1 HBP), hitting .277 (36-for-130) with six homers, seven doubles, two triples and 25 RBIs. In the last home series against the Senators, Matheny hit .412 (7-for-17) with three homers, one double, nine RBIs and three walks. He is hitting .173 (9-for-52) in his 12 games since. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 138 walks, ahead of **Ricky Oropesa** (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

ALRIGHT, ALDRETE: On Thursday, Carter Aldrete hit three home runs in consecutive at-bats. He hit a two-run homer in the third inning, added another two-run homer in the fourth inning and hit a solo home run in the fifth. The three-homer performance tied the Richmond single-game franchise record. The last player to homer three times in a game was **Thomas Neal** on June 26, 2010 at Erie. Aldrete reclaimed the team lead in homers this year with 12. Prior to Thursday, Aldrete had not homered in his previous 36 games, back to his most recent home run on June 18.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 5 - on IL), OF Vaun Brown (No. 7 - on IL), RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 12), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 16), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 17 - on IL) and RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 28). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and Jose Cruz as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes five Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Birdsong (No. 10), Brown (No. 13), Roupp (No. 15) and Seymour (No. 23).


