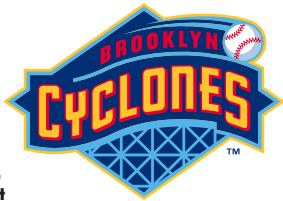

LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones dropped Saturday's contest to Aberdeen, 8-3...IronBirds jumped out to a 3-0 lead in the first on a 3-run home run to left by C **Samuel Basallo**...Aberdeen added 2 runs on balks in the 3rd, a fielding error in the 4th, and a fielder's choice and walk in the 9th... Brooklyn scored a pair in the 3rd on a 2-run double to right-center from 1B **Ryan Clifford**...Clifford finished with a pair of doubles, while LF **Rhylan Thomas** reached base 4 times on 2 singles, a double, and a walk...Basallo reached base 3 times for Aberdeen and drove in a game-high 4...1B **Jacob Teter** also garnered a pair of hits for the 'Birds...RHP **Dylan Heid** struck out 5 over 3.0 shut-out innings of relief for his 3rd win.

CHURVEY ISLAND: LHP **Joey Lucchesi** is scheduled to make his 2nd rehab start for the Cyclones on Sunday afternoon...The southpaw allowed 1 run on 4 hits and struck out 5 over 3.1 innings on Tuesday night vs. Aberdeen...Throws a "churve" that he holds it deep in his palm like a classic circle changeup, but snaps the pitch off like a breaking ball...PerStatcast, his curve had an average 8.9 inch vertical drop in 2019, which was the most movement of any pitcher's changeup by more than a full inch...Lucchesi was placed on Triple-A Syracuse's 7-day injured list on July 20 (retroactive 7/19)...In 12 starts (11 appearances) with Syracuse, the 30-year-old is 6-3 with a 3.99 ERA (30 ER in 67.2 IP) and 63 strikeouts...Lucchesi has also made 5 starts this season at the Major League level with the Mets...The southpaw composed a 1-0 record with a 4.43 ERA (11 ER in 22.1 IP) and 17 K's.

BIG RED DAWG: OF **Ryan Clifford** was added to Brooklyn's roster on August 3...The 20-year-old was acquired by the New York Mets with OF **Drew Gilbert** from the Houston Astros in exchange for RHP **Justin Verlander** on August 1...The 2022 11th-round pick enters Sunday leading the South Atlantic League in slugging percentage (.538)...Greenville's INF **Blaze Jordan** (.533) is 2nd...He is also 2nd in OPS (.892) and tied for 3rd in home runs (18)...Among players with at least 250 plate appearances, Clifford is 1st in isolated power (.271), 4th in OPS (.892), and 6th in wOBA (.392) and wRC+ (138).

THE RHY-T STUFF: In 25 games since July 4 at Wilmington, OF **Rhylan Thomas** is slashing .379/.415/.460 with a .875 OPS at the dish and a 142 wRC+...Thomas has added 11 runs scored, 4 doubles, a home run, 9 RBI, and 6 walks to only 6 strikeouts...Since July 18 at Hudson Valley, the left-handed swinger is slashing .397/.423/.500 with a .923 OPS and 155 wRC+ in 19 games...Thomas already has as many RBI (9) as he did in St. Lucie in 32 fewer plate appearances (139 to 107)...Among players with 95 or more plate appearances since the start of July, Thomas ranks 2nd in the South Atlantic League in batting average (.367) and has 5 fewer strikeouts (7) than any other batter.

PLUNK-O: The Cyclones pitching staff tied a painful franchise record on Saturday night by plunking 5 Aberdeen hitters...Brooklyn pitching had not drilled 5 batters in a game since they hit 5 on July 3, 2018, in a 5-1 loss at home vs. Staten Island...The Cyclones also plunked 5 in an 8-3 loss vs. Hudson Valley on June 26, 2017...Only 1 team in the South Atlantic League has plunked more in 2023...Hudson Valley plunked 6 Cyclones hitters on May 19 in Wappingers Falls.

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: Brooklyn collected their 9th shutout win of the season with a 5-0 blanking of Aberdeen on Friday night...2 different pitchers combined on the 3-hit shutout...RHPs **Joander Suárez** (6.0 IP) and **Brendan Hardy** (3.0) united to blank the IronBirds...3 of Brooklyn's 9 shutouts have come against Aberdeen...The 13 strikeouts were the most for the 'Clones in a shutout since they whiffed in an 8-0 victory at Jersey Shore on May 30...It was the Cyclones' first shutout since a 3-0 victory vs. Wilmington on July 26...Brooklyn has surpassed their shutout total from 2022 (7)...Since 2005, Brooklyn's record for shutouts in a season is 10 on 4 occasions...It last happened over 76 games in the New York-Penn League in 2014.

DIAL IT UP TO TEN: RHP **Joander Suárez** became the 5th different Cyclone pitcher to strike out 10 or more batters in a game in 2023 when he whiffed 11 IronBirds on Friday night...RHP **Jordany Ventura** punched out 10 vs. Aberdeen on Wednesday, RHP **Cameron Foster** K'd 12 vs. Wilmington on July 29, RHP **Tyler Stuart** struck out 11 vs. Hudson Valley on June 22, and RHP **Blade Tidwell** accomplished the feat on 4 separate occasions...Only Greenville has had more pitchers (6) strike out 10-plus hitters in a game this year (RHP **Ángel Bastardo** [2x], RHP **Isaac Coffey** [3x], RHP **Hunter Dobbins**, RHP **Wikelman González** [3x], LHP **Dalton Rogers**, RHP **Luis Peralés**)...Since 2005, only one other Brooklyn squad had 5 different arms punch out 10 or more in a single game during a season...In 2013, LHP **Dario Álvarez** (12; 7/24 @ LOW), RHP **Miller Díaz** (11; 8/23 @ VER), RHP **Robert Gsellman** (13; 8/24 @ VER), RHP **Dawrin Frías** (11; 8/27 vs. TRI), and RHP **John Gant** (7/26 @ ABD).

YO-JOANDER: RHP **Joander Suárez** continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...The 23-year-old set a new career-high with 11 strikeouts over 6.0 innings in a shutout victory vs. Aberdeen on Friday night...Over his last 10 appearances (9 starts) since June 14 at Aberdeen, Suárez holds only a 3-5 record, but a 3.28 ERA (7 ER in 46.2 IP), 15 walks (7.8 BB%), and 66 strikeouts (34.2 K%)...Narrowed down to his last 6 starts, the Cumaná, Venezuela native is 1-4, yet holds a 3.00 ERA (9 ER in 33.0 IP) with 8 walks (5.9 BB%) and 47 strikeouts (34.8 K%)...Since the start of July, Suárez trails only Hudson Valley's RHP **Drew Thorpe** (52) among SAL pitchers in strikeouts (50).

THE BEST AROUND: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Sunday, Brooklyn has posted a MiLB-low 3.04 ERA (221 ER in 655.0 IP) over their last 75 games, holding a 42-33 record in that span...The Yankees' High-A Hudson Valley (3.23) is 2nd in the minors and SAL...The Cyclones have hurled 8 shutouts in that span and hold a strikeout rate of 27.9% and a walk rate of 10.8%...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 2nd lowest opposing OPS (.621), in addition to the 3rd lowest hits-per-9 innings (6.93) and batting average against (.210) in that period...RHPs **Blade Tidwell** (1.92), **Christian Scott** (2.35), and **Tyler Stuart** (2.37) hold the 2nd, 4th, and 5th best ERAs in MiLB during that time (min. 65.0 IP).

BULLPEN BOOM: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Sunday, Brooklyn holds 2nd-best bullpen ERA (3.45) in the entire South Atlantic League and the 5th-lowest throughout Minor League Baseball...The Rangers' Single-A Down East (3.10) leads MiLB and Hudson Valley (3.37) is tops in the SAL.

TOP OF THE CYCLONE: Brooklyn's 7-series streak without losing a set came to a close with last Sunday's loss at Jersey Shore...Brooklyn had not dropped a set since Greenville won 4-of-6 on Coney Island from June 6-11, going 5-0-2...The Cyclones are 25-16 in the second half and hold a 2.5-game lead in the North Division of the SAL over Jersey Shore (23-17).

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects on Wednesday...10 members of the 2023 squad are featured...OF **Ryan Clifford** (No. 3), SS **Jett Williams** (4), C **Kevin Parada** (7), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (9), RHP **Christian Scott** (10), OF **Alex Ramírez** (12), 3B **Jacob Reimer** (14), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (22), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (24), and RHP

vs. ABERDEEN: Brooklyn returns home to open up a 2-week homestand with 6 games against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...The IronBirds possess 4 of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: C **Samuel Basallo** (5), C **Creed Willems** (24), RHP **Juan Núñez** (26), and RHP **Trace Bright** (30)... Brooklyn and Aberdeen are meeting at Maimonides Park for the 2nd and final time and the first time since the two side split a 6-game series from May 2-7...The Cyclones are 9-8 (.529) against the IronBirds in the first 17 meetings of the campaign...Dating back to their first meeting in 2002, Brooklyn is 125-113 all-time against Aberdeen (.525).

Jordany Ventura (29)...Williams (No. 98) and Clifford (99) also appear on the publication's list of Top 100 prospects...Former Cyclones listed include INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 6), RHP **Mike Vasil** (8), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (19), OF **Matt Rudick** (20), and RHP **Junior Santos** (27)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island...MLB Pipeline released their updated list on Thursday evening...8 members of the 2023 team are recognized...SS **Jett Williams** (No. 3), C **Kevin Parada** (5), OF **Ryan Clifford** (6), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (10), OF **Alex Ramírez** (11), RHP **Christian Scott** (12), IF **Jacob Reimer** (13), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (17), and RHP **Raimon Gómez** (25)...Former Brooklyn stars featured are: IF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 4), RHP **Mike Vasil** (9), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (16), and OF **Matt Rudick** (27)...Williams (No. 84), Mauricio (93), and Parada (96) are recognized in the Top 100.

OUT IN FRONT: SS **Jett Williams** started the home first inning for the Cyclones with a solo home run off RHP **Trace Bright** — the first of his Brooklyn career — in Wednesday's win vs. Aberdeen...The 19-year-old's blast marked the 2nd leadoff home run for the Cyclones in 2023...LF **Alex Ramirez** was the first to accomplish the feat, smacking a solo home run to left-center field off RHP **Johan Domínguez** on May 24 vs. Winston-Salem...Both leadoff home runs came in Wednesday afternoon games on Coney Island...OF **Ross Adolph** and INF **Rylan Sandoval** are tied for the franchise record in leadoff home runs with 3 in 2018 and 2010, respectively.

AIR JORDANY: RHP **Jordany Ventura** set new career highs in innings pitched (71) and strikeouts (9), earning the win and tossing a quality start in August 2's win at Jersey Shore...He then set a new career-high with 10 strikeouts in his next start on August 9 vs. Aberdeen, allowing 1 run and 1 hit over 6.2 innings...Ventura tossed a career and team-season-high 101 pitches and 66 strikes...The 101 pitches were the most thrown by a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP **Briam Campusano** tossed 103 pitches (57 strikes) over 5.2 innings in a 5-2 loss at West Virginia on July 28, 2018...In 5 starts with Brooklyn, the Mets' No. 29 prospect per *Baseball America* is 3-0 with a 2.73 ERA (8 ER in 26.1 IP), 13 walks (12.7 BB%), and 27 strikeouts (26.5 K%)...Narrowed down to his last 3 starts, Ventura is 3-0 with a 2.37 ERA (5 ER in 19.0 IP) and 8 walks (11.3 BB%) to 23 strikeouts (32.4 K%) with only 6 hits allowed... Brooklyn is 5-0 in starts made by the 23-year-old.

BIG APPLE ELI: LHP **Eli Ankeney** tossed a pair of shutout innings to earn his 3rd save of his professional career on Wednesday afternoon vs. Aberdeen...Between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie, the 22-year-old has accrued a 1.42 ERA (5 ER in 31.2 IP) in 21 appearances (1 start)...Among Minor League pitchers with 30.0-plus innings pitched and 1-or-fewer starts, Ankeney is 11th in ERA (1.42)...Ankeney is also tied for 2nd in fewest hits allowed (14) and 8th in opposing batting average (.133)... Since making his Brooklyn debut on June 3 at Jersey Shore, the Phoenix, Ariz. native is 7th among South Atlantic League relievers with 20.0-plus IP in ERA (1.99), tied for 2nd in fewest hits allowed (12), and 9th in batting average against (.160).

THE JETT AND JACOB SHOW: INFs **Jett Williams** and **Jacob Reimer** have made an impact since making their Cyclones debut on August 1...Since returning from the All-Star break on July 14, the 19-year-old is slashing .308/.486/.551 with a 1.037 OPS, 6 doubles, 2 triples, 3 home runs, 8 RBI, 26 walks, and 10 stolen bases in 24 games between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie...On the season, Williams is tied for 5th in Minor League Baseball in walks (80)...Since June 1, Reimer has recorded a .291/.427/.456 slash line with a .883 OPS, 33 runs scored, 8 doubles, 6 home runs, 31 RBI, and 31 walks in 48 games between 3 levels in the Mets' system.

ALEX THE AMAZING: Since the start of June, OF **Alex Ramírez** is 3rd in the South Atlantic League in runs scored (40)...Dating back to his 6-hit game on July 21 at Hudson Valley, the 20-year-old is slashing .300/.329/.438...Ramírez is 24-for-80 at the plate (.300) with 11 runs scored, 6 doubles, a home run, 11 RBI, 4 walks, and 5 stolen bases...Alex is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Sunday, the Dominican native passed INF **Luke Ritter** (80) for 2nd in franchise history in RBI on Friday and is 9 (82) behind INF **José Peroza** (91) for the all-time mark...He surpassed Peroza for 1st in doubles (36), is 2nd in total bases (225) and hits (152), and 3rd in runs scored (80).

THE ROCO SHOW: RHP **Robert Colina** has been on a tear since he struck out a season-high 7 on June 21 vs. Hudson Valley, which was matched on August 1 at Jersey Shore...After tossing a season-high 5.1 innings of shutout relief on Tuesday, Colina holds a 3-0 record with a 1.53 ERA (5 ER in 29.1 IP)...The 22-year-old has surrendered just 21 hits and walked 6 with 35 strikeouts over his last 8 appearances (3 start), Colina...Colina's strikeout rate is up 3.4 percent (31.8 K%) and walk rate is down 1.8 percent (5.5 BB%) during the time span.

DE RECORD SETTER: OF **Omar De los Santos** entered as a pinch-runner and stole second base on July 21 at Hudson Valley, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 34 swipes breaks INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 4th in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 104 stolen bases in that span, which is 7th most in MiLB...Only Mariners farmhand OF **Jonatan Clase** (115), Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (114), D'Backs prospect OF **Wilderd Patiño** (114), Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (113), Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (111), and Cardinals prospect OF **Mike Antico** (107) have tallied more...De los Santos has also snagged 56 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 48.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in his first rehab start on Tuesday night vs. Aberdeen...Allowed 1 run on 4 hits over 3.1 innings...Walked 1 and struck out 5...Tossed 52 pitches and 35 strikes (67.3%)...Relieved by RHP **Dylan Hall** in the top of the 4th with a runner at 1st, 1 out, and the game scoreless...Bequeathed runner scored...RF **Stanley Consuegra's** 2-run home run in the 4th tied it and C **Drake Osborn's** solo shot in the 5th gave Brooklyn the lead for good...RHP **Robert Colina** tossed 5.1 innings of scoreless relief to seal the Cyclones' 3-2 win.

ON THE MEND: Lucchesi was placed on Triple-A Syracuse's 7-day injured list on July 20 (retroactive to July 19)...The 30-year-old made 8 rehab appearances across 3 minor league affiliates in 2022...Suffered a torn UCL in his left elbow on June 18, 2021, with the Mets at Washington...Underwent Tommy John surgery on June 24 and missed the remainder of that season.

2023: Started the season with Triple-A Syracuse...Made 3 starts and went 2-0 with a 2.30 ERA (4 ER in 15.2 IP) with 7 walks (10.9 BB%), and 16 strikeouts (25.0 K%)...Recalled by New York on April 21...Tossed 7.0 shutout innings — striking out 9 — to earn the win on April 21 at San Francisco in his first MLB start since 6/19/21 at Washington...Posted a 1-0 record with a 4.43 ERA (11 ER in 22.1 IP), 8 walks (8.6 BB%), 17 strikeouts (18.3 K%) in 5 starts...Optioned back to Syracuse on May 14...Tallied a 4-3 mark with a 4.50 ERA (26 ER in 52.0 IP), 23 walks (11.9 BB%), and 47 strikeouts (24.2 K%) in 9 appearances (8 starts) before landing on the injured list on July 20.

EAST COAST BOUND: Lucchesi was acquired by the New York Mets from the San Diego Padres in a 3-team trade on January 19, 2021...The Pittsburgh Pirates sent RHP **Joe Musgrove** to San Diego and the Mets traded C/OF **Endy Rodríguez** to Pittsburgh...The Padres also dealt RHP **David Bednar**, OF **Hudson Head**, RHP **Drake Fellows**, and LHP **Omar Cruz** to the Pirates to complete the swap.

BEST IN CLASS: The southpaw was selected to a Major League roster for the first time on March 30, 2018, and made his debut in a start later that day vs. Milwaukee...Lucchesi became the first pitcher in the 2016 draft class to make his MLB debut...The Newark, Calif.-born left-hander was selected by the San Diego Padres in the 4th round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of Southeast Missouri State University (Cape Girardeau, Mo.).
