#### JACKSONVILLE SPLITS SERIES WITH LEHIGH VALLEY

Behind a strong outing from Sean Nolin (1-0), the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp split their series with the Lehigh Valley IronPigs, defeating them 5-1. The Jumbo Shrimp struck first with three runs in the third and added two runs in the fifth

#### STARTED FROM THE BOTTOM

Jacksonville starting pitchers have ceded three runs or fewer in 14 of their last 17 games. During that span, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have vielded 34 runs. 29 earned, on 75 hits (7.9 H/9) in 85.0 innings for a 3.07 ERA. This stretch has not seen Jacksonville starters strike out many opponents, with the club's rotation registering just 59 punchouts (6.2 K/9). However, they have only issued 24 walks during this run, a rate of 2.5 per nine innings.

#### WALKING ON SUNSHINE

Over the season's first eight games, Jacksonville mustered only 25 walks, the second-fewest such total in the International League. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have shown a significant amount of patience of late; Jacksonville has registered 85 free passes over the last 16 games since April 11, a figure that ranks tied for third in the International League. During this stretch, the club has walked in 13.7 percent of their plate appearances. The MLB average is roughly 8.6 percent. The Shrimp walked in just 7.6 percent of plate appearances in their first eight games. Jacksonville's 11 walks on Sunday, were their most in a game since tallying 12 against Birmingham on 6/15/19. The last time the club tallied 11 walks at home was 8/6/15 vs. Pensacola.

#### BYE-BYE BURDICK

Coming into 2023, Peyton Burdick hadn't recorded a multi-homer game since bashing two in Biloxi on August 4, 2021 while playing for Double-A Pensacola. The Cincinnati native has already registered two multi-homer games this season, and his 10 on the season are tied for second in the International League, Burdick is tied for fourth in the IL in RBIs (24), tied for fourth in runs scored (24), seventh in SLG (.636), tied for sixth in extra-base hits (14), 10th in OPS (1.017) and tied for 11th in hits (29). Burdick's HR/FB rate of 40.0 percent ranks third out of the 137 IL qualifiers.

#### 'PFN PALS

The Jacksonville bullpen struggled mightily during a seven-game stretch from April 14-26. Over that timeframe, Jumbo Shrimp relievers collectively surrendered 27 runs, 26 earned, on 38 hits (11.7 H/9) in 29.1 innings for a 7.98 ERA. That stretch saw the club's bullpen fan 35 batters (10.7 K/9) but walk 23 hitters (7.1 BB/9). However, in the five games since then, Jacksonville relievers have combined to cede seven runs, but only three earned, on 20 hits (8.7 K/9) in 20.2 innings for a 1.30 FRA. The Jumbo Shrimp bullnen has combined for 26 strikeouts (11.3 K/9) against 11 walks (4.8

#### BIRD HUNTING SEASON

Since 2021, Jacksonville's first year back in Triple-A, they are 21-8 against the Memphis Redbirds. In 2022, the club matched up 18 times with the Redbirds, winning 14 of those contests (.778). The Jumbo Shrimp tallied 42 wins on the road with nine of those wins coming at AutoZone Park. Jacksonville pitchers had a 3.08 ERA, third-best among 2022 opponents. On the offensive side, Jacksonville owned Memphis pitching, slashing .266/.338/.451/.789 with 28 home runs. 91 RBIs and 11 stolen bases.

#### JERARASSIC PARK

Jerar Encarnacion has been on a tear since Jacksonville's two-week homestand (4/18-4/30). In that span, Encarnacion leads the Jumbo Shrimp in batting average (.364), hits (12), total bases (20), extra-base hits (6), OBP (.523), SLG (.606) and OPS (1.129). This hot streak has seen Encarnacion raise his batting average 100 points from .264 to start the season. He debuted with the Marlins on 6/19/22 at Citi Field against the New York Mets, smacking a grand slam.

#### SHRIMP RITES

Prior to an eight-run outburst on Saturday, Jacksonville had scored just 16 runs in the previous seven games. That figure ranked as the fewest in Triple-A and second-fewest out of the 120 MiLB teams during that stretch... Charles Leblanc's grand slam on Saturday was Jacksonville's first since Peyton Burdick launched a grand slam on 8/2/22 against Memphis. It was the only grand slam the Jumbo Shrimp hit during the

#### ABOUT RONALD

-Before coming to the United States, Bolaños played for Mayabeque of the Cuban National Series. He signed with the San Diego Padres as an International free agent on August 11, 2016.

-The Padres selected Bolaños' contract and promoted him to the major leagues for the first time on September 2, 2019. He made his major leagues debut on Spetember 3rd vs. the Arizona Diamondbacks, allowing two runs over six innings pitched.

-On July 16, 2020, Bolaños and outfielder Francy Cordero were traded to the Kansas City Royals in exchange for LHP Tim Hill.

-On April 16, 2023, Bolaños signed a minor league deal with the Miami Marlins.

-Entering the 2023 season, Bolaños has pitched in 18 major league games, including five starts with Kansas City and San Diego. In those games, he is 0-4 with a 5.25 ERA. Over 48.0 innings, he has yielded 49 hits and struck out 43 against 29 walks.

-When he was signed by San Diego, the then-19-year-old was ranked by MLB.com as the No. 20 international prospect in the 2016 class and ranked by Baseball America as the fourth-best Cuban pitcher available.

-In 2014, he played in the COPABE 18U Pan American Championship in Mexico.

-The Cuban-native came up as an outfielder before converting to a pitcher.

#### 2023 SEASON

#### 2022 SEASON

-With Triple-A Omaha, went 0-1 with a 3.52 ERA in four starts. Over 15.1 innings, yielding 17 hits and struck out 16 against four walks. However, over 24 relief apperences with the Storm Chasers, he posted an 0-3 record with a 7.63 ERA. In those relief apperences, he allowed 42 hits in 26.2 innings and struck out 18 against 14 walks.

#### 2021 SEASON

-Bolaños began the year with Triple-A Omaha and made four starts before joining the Royals on June 4th. He closed the season with the Storm Chasers.

#### 2020 SEASON

- Made a pair of starts, July 26 at Cleveland and Aug. 1 vs. the White Sox... Took the loss in his first start, allowing two unearned runs on three hits and a walk over 2.0 innings.

-Became the third Cuban-born pitcher to start a game for the Royals, joining Onelki García (2017) and Zip Sánchez (1988).

# JUMBO SHRIMP IN THE BULLPEN
