#### JUMBO SHRIMP DROP THIRD STRAIGHT GAME

The Jumbo Shrimp fell 7-2 on Thursday to the Tides. Norfolk jumped out to an early advantage. TT Bowens smacked a two-run double and Jakson Reetz lifted a sacrifice fly in the first to make it 3-0. Reed Trimble launched a two-run homer. in the fourth and Vimael Machin added an RBI double in the sixth. The Tides made it 7-0 in the seventh on a Dylan Beavers RBI single. In the bottom of the seventh, Nathan Martorella and Deyvison De Los Santos hit back-to-back home runs for Jacksonville's only runs of the game. Norfolk has taken the first three games of the series.

#### THE MORE. THE MERRIER

In 2024, Jacksonville shattered the city's previous Double-A/ Triple-A era (1962-present) record of 20 different starting pitchers over the course of the season and used 28 different starters in 149 games. Meanwhile, through 116 games this season, the Jumbo Shrimp have already tied that record by using 28 different starting pitchers. Perhaps unsurprisingly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have totaled just 456.0 innings (3.9 per start) this season, the fourth-fewest in Triple-A. That said, their 3.63 starters' ERA ranks second at the level.

#### IT GETS LATE EARLY

Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have worked 557.1, or 55.0 percent, of the club's 1,013.1 innings this season. Despite the huge workload, which marks the third-most innings of any bullpen in Triple-A, Jacksonville relievers have posted the level's best ERA (3.58) and BAA (.208). Over the last 21 games, the club's bullpen has worked 102.1 innings (4.9 per game), yielding only 33 runs, 30 earned, on 58 hits (5.1 H/9) for a 2.59 ERA (121 K, 10.6 K/9, 36 BB, 3.2 BB/9).

#### MEN OF STEAL

Over the last three seasons, Jacksonville ranked 23rd, 21st and 29th, respectively, in Triple-A in stolen bases. The club's 231 this season not only lead the entire level, but they rank eighth in all of Minor League Baseball. Of the top 23 MiLB teams in steals, only two are Triple-A or Double-A teams (Jacksonville & Nashville, 224, T-9th). The Jumbo Shrimp's 231 steals are the most in a campaign for any Jacksonville team in the club's Double-A/Triple-A era (1962-present). No Jacksonville club has finished in the top five in their respective level in steals since at least 2005.

#### **GUNS AND SHIPS, AND SO THE BALANCE SHIFTS**

Dating back to their July 27 contest at Durham, Jacksonville has won 12 of the last 16 games in mostly dominant fashion. During this stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp have out-hit their opponents 131-104, out-homered them 18-15 and earned 78 walks and hit-by-pitches compared to 50 for their opponents. It has added up to a massive 85-54 advantage in run differential over these 16 games.

#### THE CHICKS DIG IT

Over the first 63 games of the season, Jacksonville cracked only 52 home runs, tied for the 26th-most in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp have blasted 74 round-trippers over the last 53 games since June 10, tied for the sixth-most in Triple-A during this span. Jacksonville has plated at least four runs in 36 of these 53 games, a rate of 67.9 percent. In comparison, the Jumbo Shrimp had plated four runs or more in just 30 of their first 63 games (47.6 percent).

#### SO, BABY, PULL ME CLOSER

The Jumbo Shrimp are a remarkable 46-22 (.672) in games decided by three runs or fewer this season, by far the most such wins in Triple-A. Thus, of the club's Triple-A-leading 71 victories, 64.8 percent have come by no more than three runs. In one-run affairs in particular, Jacksonville has excelled, going 24-9, tied for the most such wins in Triple-A and just one behind Montgomery's 25 for the most in MiLB.

#### WIEMER SCHNITZEL

Joey Wiemer began his season with Triple-A Omaha, but struggled with the Storm Chasers, batting just .182 with a .603 OPS in 72 games. After being claimed off waivers from Kansas City by Miami, Wiemer has excelled. Over his first eight games, the Temperance, Mich., native is 11-for-29, slashing .379/.486/.759/1.245 with five doubles, two home runs, 10 RBIs and six runs scored. Wiemer became the first Jumbo Shrimp to earn International League Player of the Week honors this season.

#### SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has lost three games in a row for the first time since getting swept at Durham from April 29-May 4... The Jumbo Shrimp's 115 strikeouts in their last 11 games since August 5 rank fourth in Triple-A.

#### ABOUT ADAM

-Laskey was originally selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 31st round in the 2016 MLB Draft. He ultimately didn't sign with the Giants and committed to play baseball at Duke. He had scholarship offers from Notre Dame, Wake Forest and Duke. He also drew heavy recruiting interest from Virginia Tech, Boston College, the University of Miami, Stanford, St. Johns and Michigan.

-Didn't garner attention until his summer in the Cape Cod League. Pitched for Falmouth, posted a 1.18 ERA in 30.1 innings and won Whitehouse Outstanding Pitcher Award.

-Pitched three seasons at Duke, had ERAs over five during his first two seasons. His last year, he made only six appearances but was selected in the 19th round by the Chicago Cubs.

-After reaching as high as Double-A Tennessee, Laskey was selected by the Marlins in the minor league phase of the 2023 Rule 5 draft.

#### 2025 SEASON

-Tossed immaculate inning on April 11, 2025 for the Blue Wahoos.

-Made 11 appearances, 10 starts with Double-A Pensacola. Totaled 50 strikeouts in 52.2 innings. Allowed 26 R, 22 ER for a 3.76 ERA, while posting a 2-5 record.

-Posted a 12.0 scoreless innings streak back in April.

#### 2024 SEASON

-Spent his first full season in the Marlins organization. Went 6-2 in 31 appearances, six starts.

-Totaled 81.1 innings, allowing  $28\,R$ ,  $28\,ER$  for a  $3.10\,ERA$ . Laskey held opponents to a .217 batting average against (63 hits allowed) and striking out 76 against 20 walks.

#### 2023 SEASON

-Laskey started the season with High-A South Bend. In 33 appearances out of the bullpen, he allowed 22 runs, 17 earned runs for a 3.14 ERA. He posted a 4-1 record and held opponents to a .242 batting average against.
