JUMBO SHRIMP FALL ON WALKOFF HOMER...AGAIN

Jakob Marsee homered but the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp fell short 4-3 to the Louisville Bats on a second consecutive walkoff home run Friday night. For the second-straight night, the game entered the bottom of the ninth in a tie game. Louisville's (61-74, 23-38) Edwin Ríos (18) blasted his second walkoff homer in as many days off Jacksonville (64-70, 29-30) reliever Austin Roberts (L, 0-1) sealing a 4-3 win. The Bats opened the scoring in the bottom of the third on a two-run double from Jacob Hurtubise

SLIP 'N SLIDE

Despite owning a 5.89 ERA through the first 15 games in August (third-worst in the International League). Jacksonville balanced that with the second-best batting average (.283) while going 8-7. On Monday, August 19, the Jumbo Shrimp were just 5.5 games behind first-place Columbus for the top spot in the IL. Since then, Jacksonville has been free falling in the standings, falling to 12th in the International League. In their last 16 games, the Jumbo Shrimp are slashing .224/.290/.324/.614, which ranks 18th, 19th, 19th and 19th respectively. On the flip side, despite posting a 6-10 record, the pitching staff's ERA ranks fourth (4.30) and they're holding opponents to the second-lowest batting average against (.225).

ONE RUN TO RULE THEM ALL

After last night's 4-3 loss, Jacksonville has now played in 48 one-run contests in 2024 and their seventh in their last 16 games. The Jumbo Shrimp are 3-4 in one-run games during this stretch. Jacksonville is being outscored by their opponents 21-20.

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled this season at 121 Financial Ballpark, mustering a meager 31-37 (.456) record. Jacksonville has scored only 281 runs at home (4.1 per game), the secondfewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are scoring about a halfrun more per game on the road, totaling 309 (4.7 per game). Meanwhile, also on the road, Jacksonville has surrendered only 300 runs (4.5 per game), the fourth-fewest in Triple-A. They've yielded tied for the 12th-fewest runs of any team at home (331, 4.9 per game). Thus, their run differential is +9 on the road, but -50 at home.

STRAIGHT AND NARROW

Of Jacksonville's 12 wins during the month of August, nine came by three runs or fewer, including six by just one run. The Jumbo Shrimp have played in 48 games this season. decided by one run (22-26) the most in the International League. Jacksonville registered 85 contests (57.0 percent of total games, 39-46, .459) contests decided by three runs or fewer during the 2023 season. In 2024, their 86 games this season determined by these narrow margins represents 64.2 percent of the club's 134 games played thus far in 2024. The Jumbo Shrimp are 44-42 (.512) in those tightlydecided contests.

LADIES FIRST

When Norfolk scored the game's first run on Sunday against Jacksonville, it marked the 17th consecutive home game for the Jumbo Shrimp in which the visiting team scored first. This streak, which dates back to July 30, has surprisingly seen Jacksonville go .529 in its contests at 121 Financial Ballpark, with a 9-8 record. Over the Jumbo Shrimp's 68 home games thus far in 2024, their opponent has scored first in 46 contests (67.6 percent). Jacksonville is 16-30 (.348) in those affairs.

IT GETS LATE EARLY OUT HERE

Over the last 16 games, Jacksonville's offense has really struggled against opposing bullpens. The relief corps of Nashville, Norfolk and Louisville have combined to surrender only 19 runs, 16 earned, on 41 hits (5.8 H/9) in 63.2 innings (2.26 ERA, 67 K, 25 BB) against the Jumbo Shrimp over this 16-game run. From the sixth inning on during this stretch, Jacksonville is a woeful 38-for-217 (.175) at the plate, scratching across only 16 runs in 57 innings.

SHRIMP BITES

With Louisville scoring first Wednesday night, opponents have opened the scoring against Jacksonville in eight of the last nine games. In seven of those contests, opponents have scored in the first inning. With his solo homer Thursday night, Deyvison De Los Santos has extended his Minor League home run total to 37 across multiple levels. De Los Santos has clubbed 14 homers in the Texas League, Pacific Coast League and nine in the International League. He leads all of MiLB in HR (37), RBIs (109) and total bases (283).

ABOUT PATRICK

-Monteverde is the youngest child from a massive family. He is the youngest of 27 grandchildren on his dad's side and the youngest of 18 grandchildren on his mom's side. Both of Monteverde's parents are the youngest of twelve.

-A native of Pittsburgh, Monteverde started his collegiate baseball career at Division III Virginia Wesleyan (Norfolk, Va.) for a season, posting a 1.96 ERA in 82 2/3 innings. In 2018, he moved up a rung, transferring to Division II Seton Hill in Greensburg, Pennsylvania, about 45 minutes from Monteverde's home. He had a solid first year there in 2018 (3.04 ERA), but three starts into his second season with the Griffins, he heard a pop in his elbow and underwent Tommy John surgery. Monteverde made just one more start for Seton Hill in 2020 before the COVID pandemic then shut down the season for him.

-Monteverde completed his collegiate career by transferring to Texas Tech University for the 2021 season. He went 7-4 with a 3.75 ERA, leading the Red Raiders in wins, starts (16), innings pitched (86.1) and strikeouts (101).

2024 SEASON

-Missed 26 games with an injury from May 22-June 21.

-Transferred to Double-A Pensacola on July 10 before returning to Jacksonville on September 1.

2023 SEASON

-Monteverde was promoted to Jacksonville on July 25 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, he led the Southern League in wins (8), ERA (2.44) and WHIP (1.11) while ranking second in both innings pitched (84.2) and batting average against (.207), tied for eighth in strikeouts (90) and tied for 14th in games started (14).

-Made 21 total starts with Pensacola in 2022. Led team in wins (10), innings pitched (114.0), strikeouts (114), double plays (T-1st, 11).

-Led qualified pitchers in ERA (3.32),

-Among the 119 Southern League pitchers with at least 30 IP, Monteverde ranked 40th in stranded runners (71.3%).

2022 SEASON

-Monteverde was promoted to Double-A Pensacola on August 2 from High-A Beloit.

-Over his final 13 starts in High-A, Monteverde went 3-4 with a 2.30 ERA. He pitched 70.1 innings, yielding only 54 hits (.211 batting average against) and striking out 75 against 21 walks.

2021 SEASON

-Six of his seven outings were in a relief role. Prior to that, he had not pitched in relief since 2017, his freshman year at Virginia Wesleyan. Even during that 2017 campaign, 11 of his 15 appearances were starts.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Monteverde's favorite pitcher growing up was Clayton Kershaw.

-His favorite book is "To Kill a Mockingbird" and favorite movie is "American Pie."
