- Dunedin snapped a three-game losing streak with a 6-3 win over Bradenton on Saturday night.
- Alexis Hernandez had a career night, going 4-5 with a solo homer and two-RBI double in the 7th inning.
- Juanmi Vasquez relieved starter Nolan Perry with 3.2 innings of hitless work, walking three and striking out five. Bo Bonds earned the win by stranding two runners inherited from Vasquez in the sixth.
- The Jays scored twice in the sixth to tie the game, and then got RBIs from Cristian Feliz and Hernandez to pull into the lead in the 8th
- Irv Carter worked two scoreless innings in the seventh and eighth before JJ Sanchez nailed down the save in the ninth.

JAYS JUICE

The Blue Jays have homered in 11 of their last 13 games. Across that stretch, eight different players have gone deep. Dunedin is second in the Florida State League with 30 homers. Dunedin's 19 homers this month are the most in the FSL in May. In five games this week, the Jays have gone deep five times.

HOW ABOUT HERNANDEZ?

Alexis Hernandez had his best game of the season last night, going 4-5 with a homer, double and 3 RBIs. Hernandez becomes the second D-Jay this season to collect four hits in a game, after Yhoangel Aponte collected two. After going homerless in his first 27 games, Hernandez has gone deep in back-to-back contests. With the four-hit night, Hernandez boosted his batting average from .169 to .205

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

31 of the Blue Jays 44 games this season (70%) have been decided by four or fewer runs. Dunedin has an 14-16 record in those games. Dunedin has played 14 one-run games (6-8). Each of the Blue Jays' last five wins have required saves.

RELYING ON RELIEF

The Blue Jays success this season has largely hinged on its bullpen, with distinct differences in relief performance in wins and losses. In wins, Jays relievers have pitched to a 2.61 ERA with a 1.15 WHIP. In losses, the bullpen has accumulated a 5.79 ERA with a 1.72 WHIP. Last night, the Jays 'pen delivered seven shutout innings.

FREE RIDES

Last night's game featured a combined 16 walks between the two pitching staffs. The Blue Jays' nine walks issued marks the seventh time this season the pitching staff has walked nine or more in a single game. Dunedin leads the league in walks with 227.

LATE MAGIC

After being held scoreless in the final three innings of the game on back-to-back nights, Dunedin rallied for three runs in the seventh to win last night. The Blue Jays hold a +10 run differential in the final three innings this season (77 runs scored, 67 runs allowed). The Jays have tallied a run in the seventh or later in 15 of their last 17 contests.

NIGHT AND DAY DIFFERENCE

Blue Jays have hit significantly better in day games (.254 in 8 games) than night games (.208 in 36 games). Manuel Beltre is hitting .324 (11-34) in eight day contests. On the other side of the scorebook, Dunedin pitching has struggled during the day, surrendering a 6.21 ERA, compared to a 3.70 mark in night games.

FANTASTIC MR. FELIZ

Blue Jays slugger Cristian Feliz hit his team-leading eighth homer of the season Thursday. After a slow April, Feliz is batting .230 with a .824 OPS with a team-high 15 RBIs. The 6-foot, 4-inch first baseman's eight longballs are second in the Florida State League, two behind Daytona's Ariel Almonte.
