SATURDAY: The Ponies defeated the Yard Goats 6-0 Saturday night behind a combined one hit effort between Cole Gordon, Tommy Wilson, and Eric Orze. The Ponies had a no-hitter intact through 8.1 IP before Casey Golden hit a clean single to left. The game was scoreless through six before Carlos Cortes hit a sac fly to plate the game's first run in the seventh. Carlos Rincon added a two-run homer in the seventh to make it 3-0. In the ninth, Brett Baty belted a two-run home run to make it 5-0 and Rincon added an RBI triple to make it 6-0. With a win today, Binghamton would win the series.

A NEAR NO-NO!The Rumble Ponies were two outs away from their second no-hitter this season! That would have been the first time that ever happened in franchise history. On Saturday, RHP Cole Gordon pitched five no-hit frames in the start, allowing one walk and striking out a career-high eight. RHP Tommy Wilson pitched two hitless frames in relief, followed by Eric Orze who allowed just one hit over two scoreless frames to close out the game.

LIGHTS OUT PITCHING: Over the last two nights, Rumble Ponies pitchers have allowed only one run and have not surrendered a run in the last 17 innings. In addition, they have struck out 26 Yard Goats and issued only 3 walks. Friday night's starter Adam Oller is now second in the Northeast League with 83 strikeouts.

RINCON RAKING: Rumble Ponies OF Carlos Rincon was 3-5 with 3 RBI Saturday night. Rincon hit a two-run homer in the 7th and an RBI triple in the ninth. Over his last three games, Rincon is hitting .500 (7-14) with 2 HR, 5 RBI, 1 double, 1 triple, and 3 runs scored. Since being assigned to the Ponies after being traded from the Dodgers, Rincon is hitting .286 with 3 HR and 6 RBI.

BATY BLASTS ONE: Brett Baty hit his second home run with Binghamton Saturday, a two-run homer to right in the ninth inning. According to Statcast, it went 426 feet. Baty is the #4 prospect in the Mets system according to MLB Pipeline.

CLOSE GAMES THIS WEEK: Outside of Saturday night's 6-0 Ponies win, the four other games in this series have been decided by two runs or less. The Ponies won on Wednesday and Friday night 3-2 and 3-1, Hartford won Tuesday and Thursday night's games by a 6-5 tally.

COMING UP: Tonight is the final game of a 6-game series in Hartford. The Rumble Ponies will return home for a season-long 13-game home stand starting on August 3rd with a 7 game series against the Portland Sea Dogs. Then The Yard Goats will make their first trip to Mirabito Stadium this season for a six-game series from August 10 - August 15.
