LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox snapped their six-game losing streak with a 3-2 victory over the Reading Fightin' Phils to pick up their first win of the second half. After falling behind by two runs in the first, **Silas Ardoin** singled in Bowie's first run and **Jud Fabian** homered to tie the game in the third. **Kyle Brnovich** threw five strong innings and struck out seven to pick up the win. **Frederick Bencosme** drove in the go-ahead run in the sixth with a sac fly to right. **Nick Richmond** collected a four-out save in the win.

BASALLO BITS

C/1B **Samuel Basallo** has reached base safely in 27 of his last 29 games dating back to May 21. After a pair of hits on Tuesday, Basallo now has 20 multi-hit games on the season, the most by a Baysox hitter this season. His 19-game on-base streak from May 21 to June 12 is the longest Baysox on-base streak this season and is tied for the sixth-longest in the Eastern League. Since May 21, the 19-year-old is slashing .321/.393/.953 with six homers and 18 RBI.

RHODES IS ROLLING

In the month of June, OF/1B **John Rhodes** is batting a team-high .317 with a team-leading 15 RBI. The Orioles No. 23 prospect has the 10th-best batting average in the league in the month of June.

BENCOSME BARRELS

After doubling yesterday, IF **Frederick Bencosme** now owns the longest hit streak by a Baysox player this season at 11 games, which is also tied for the second-longest active hit streak in the league. The Orioles No. 27 prospect is slashing .306/.422/.783 over this span.

THE FANTASTIC FABIAN

OF **Jud Fabian** is tied for the league lead among active Eastern League players with 13 home runs on the season. His solo home run last night snapped an 0-for-13 skid. Fabian hit a league-high six homers in the month of May and has five thus far in June.

WELCOME MR. ETZEL

OF/1B **Matthew Etzel** was the first Orioles '23 draft pick to be promoted to Double-A after being selected in the 10th round out of So. Miss. On Tuesday, the 22-year-old hit his first Double-A homer with an opposite field solo shot. His 36 steals on the season between High-A Aberdeen and Double-A Bowie is tied for fourth-most in all of MiLB.

ENJOY THE ROAD

Bowie begins the second half with a slew of games on the road. 21 of the first 27 games to start the second half will be played on the road. The Baysox ended the first half with a road record of 13-17.

BUILT BY THE BULLPEN

Bowie's bullpen leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings pitched (345.2) and strikeouts (400). The Baysox bullpen owns a 1.20 WHIP, which is the third-lowest in Double-A. In the 59 innings pitched in the series against Altoona, 37.1 innings came from the bullpen (63%).

WE'RE TALKING ABOUT THE FIGHTIN'S'

The Reading Fightin' Phils finished the first half in fifth in the Northeast Division with a record of 31-37. The Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies has won three in a row after securing a series win at New Hampshire. The Fightin' Phils have hit the second most homers in the league and have scored the fourth most runs. Due to injuries, Reading's active roster includes only three of the Phillies' top 30 prospects (per MLB Pipeline) - OF/1B Carlos De La Cruz (No. 12), C Caleb Ricketts (No. 20), IF Robert Moore (No. 25)

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Max Castillo makes his third start of the season for Reading and his ninth of the year between Double-A Reading and Triple-A Lehigh Valley. Castillo started the season in Triple-A before being optioned to FCL Phillies on May 7. The 25-year-old then arrived at Reading on June 15. Castillo has 21 games of MLB experience between Kansas City and Toronto and has a career ERA of 5.43 over 59.2 innings pitched. He was claimed off waivers from the Red Sox on February 7.

2024: Made shortest start of season after recording just two outs and allowing 2 R on 0 H over 4 BB in the loss on Fri. 6/21 vs ALT. Has allowed just 5 ER over last seven starts spanning 25.1 IP (1.78 ERA). Finished first half with a 3.07 ERA over 44.0 IP with 48 K/30 BB. Still looking for first Double-A win. Baysox are 6-7 when he starts but have won four of last seven. Owns a 3.54 ERA in six road starts. On Tue. 6/4 vs BNG, struck out season-high 8 batters over 4.0 scoreless innings. First game with 8+ K since 5/20/22 with High-A Bowling Green. Finished month of May with a 2.79 ERA in five starts after recording a 4.38 ERA in four April starts. On the BAL 40-man roster. Named to 40-man back in Nov. '22. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster.

2023: Placed on 60-day injured list to begin season by Triple-A Norfolk. Sent on rehab assignment to FCL Orioles on August 19. Made one start before being sent to Single-A Delmarva on August 22. Made one start with Shorebirds, then assigned to High-A Aberdeen on August 29. Made two starts with IronBirds. Struck out five in three shutout innings on Sept. 6 vs Greenville. Assigned to Double-A Bowie on Sept. 13. Struck out four in three innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on three hits and two walks in lone start of season against Harrisburg.

2022: Started season in High-A Bowling Green. Made seven starts and struck out 41 batters over 27 innings to an ERA of 3.00. Placed on injured list in late May with right forearm inflammation before discovering that he suffered a torn UCL and needed Tommy John surgery. Traded from TB to BAL in a three team deal on August 1 that sent Trey Mancini to Houston - just days before his operation in Texas.

2021: Entered first full season in minors with Single-A Charleston. Made 23 appearances (16 starts), pitched 93.2 innings and struck out 115 batters, good for fourth in the TB system. Posted an ERA of just 2.88 and allowed 33 walks.

2019: Debuted professionally with TB rookie ball affiliates in Princeton and GCL Rays.

College/Personal: Drafted by the Rays out of Campbell with the 40th overall selection in the 2019 Draft. At the time, was the highest-drafted player in Campbell history. A former two-way player at Louisburg (N.C) junior college as a shortstop before committing to pitching full time at Campbell. Was his first time pitching since age 12. Convinced his junior college coaches to let him pitch in games after clocking 92 mph on a teammate's Pocket Radar during an off day.

During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado on the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League.
