LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox lost their season-high sixth consecutive game in an 8-4 loss to Reading to open up the second-half. The Fightin' Phils hit three homers on the night and jumped out to a 5-0 lead through five innings courtesy of Carson Taylor's three RBI game.

Samuel Basallo recorded Bowie's first run of the night with a towering homer to right in the sixth. **Ryan Higgins** pulled Bowie within two with his second homer of the season. Reading hit two more homers late to pull away from the Baysox in the end.

BASALLO BITS

C/1B **Samuel Basallo** has reached base safely in 26 of his last 28 games dating back to May 21. After a pair of hits last night, Basallo now has 20 multi-hit games on the season, the most by a Baysox hitter this season. His 19-game on-base streak from May 21 to June 12 is the longest Baysox on-base streak this season and is tied for the sixth-longest in the Eastern League. Since May 21, the 19-year-old is slashing .324/.398/.969 with six homers and 18 RBI.

RHODES IS ROLLING

In the month of June, OF/1B **John Rhodes** is batting a team-high .317 with a team-leading 15 RBI. The Orioles No. 23 prospect has 13 hits and nine RBI over his last eight games.

BENCOSME BARRELS

IF **Frederick Bencosme** has collected a hit in 10 consecutive games, which is tied for the longest hit streak on the team and is tied for the third-longest active hit streak in the league. The Orioles No. 27 prospect is slashing .303/.439/.772 over this span.

THE FANTASTIC FABIAN

OF **Jud Fabian** is third among active Eastern League players in home runs (12). Fabian hit a league-high six homers in the month of May and has four thus far in June - including three on the last road trip in Harrisburg.

WELCOME MR. ETZEL

OF/1B **Matthew Etzel** was the first Orioles '23 draft pick to be promoted to Double-A after being selected in the 10th round out of So. Miss. Last night, the 22-year-old hit his first Double-A homer with an opposite field solo shot. His 36 steals on the season between High-A Aberdeen and Double-A Bowie is tied for third most in all of MiLB.

ENJOY THE ROAD

Bowie begins the second half with a slew of games on the road. 21 of the first 27 games to start the second half will be played on the road. The Baysox ended the first half with a road record of 13-17.

BUILT BY THE BULLPEN

Bowie's bullpen leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings pitched (341.2) and strikeouts (394). The Baysox bullpen owns a 1.20 WHIP, which is the third-lowest in Double-A. In the 59 innings pitched in the series against Altoona, 37.1 innings came from the bullpen (63%).

WE'RE TALKING ABOUT THE FIGHTIN'S

The Reading Fightin' Phils finished the first half in fifth in the Northeast Division with a record of 31-37. The Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies has won three in a row after securing a series win at New Hampshire. The Fightin' Phils have hit the second most homers in the league and have scored the fourth most runs. Due to injuries, Reading's active roster includes only three of the Phillies' top 30 prospects (per MLB Pipeline) - OF/1B Carlos De La Cruz (No. 12), C Caleb Ricketts (No. 20), IF Robert Moore (No. 25)

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Matt Osterberg makes his 13th start of the season for the Fightin' Phils. In his most recent start last Wednesday at New Hampshire, the 25-year-old threw five innings and gave up four runs on nine hits across two walks and two strikeouts in the loss. Osterberg has given up a league-high 87 hits across 57.2 innings pitched. Osterberg was Reading's Opening Night starter against Bowie back on April 5. In that game, he pitched 3.2 innings and gave up just one unearned run over two hits and four strikeouts in a no-decision.

Acquired from LAA in Dylan Bundy deal, which included BAL RHP Kyle Bradish and BOW RHP Zach Peek Returns for his third stint with Baysox. First full healthy season since 2021.

2024: Threw 4.2 IP and allowed just 1 R on 4 H across 2 K and 2 BB on a season-high 79 pitches in a no-decision in most recent start on Thu. 6/20 vs ALT. Has allowed 2 ER or less in seven of eight starts this season. Holds a 3.00 ERA as a starter in eight starts this season. Owns a 2.73 ERA in six outings on the road. Has eclipsed 50.0 IP for first time since '21 while recovering from Tommy John surgery in '22-'23. Baysox are 5-3 when he starts. Threw first 6.0 inning start by a Baysox pitcher this season with 6.0 shutout, no-hit innings and 6 K on 6/2 @ SOM. Began season in rotation for three starts before being bumped into long relief role for five straight outings. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster.

2023: Began season with FCL Orioles on a rehab assignment after recovering from Tommy John surgery. Made four rehab appearances between FCL Orioles, Single-A Delmarva and High-A Aberdeen before being sent to Double-A Bowie on July 25. Made four appearances (two starts) with Baysox and posted a 7.71 ERA in 14 innings, struck out 19 and gave up five homers.

2022: Began season with Triple-A Norfolk. Made two four-inning starts in April before suffering a right elbow injury. Underwent successful Tommy John surgery in May and missed rest of the season.

2021: Began first full season in Orioles system after trade. Started year in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 48 batters over 34.1 innings to an ERA of 2.36. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on June 22. Went five innings in six of his 11 starts and finished season with 75 K over 60.2 IP and an ERA of 3.86.

2019: Did not pitch a game while in LAA organization. Traded to BAL on Dec. 4, 2019, along with RHP Kyle Bradish, RHP Zach Peek, and RHP Isaac Mattson for RHP Dylan Bundy.

Personal: Drafted in the 8th round of the 2019 MLB Draft by the Los Angeles Angels out of Elon University. Pitched three seasons at Elon and was named a Consensus All-American in 2018. Struck out 360 batters in 281 career collegiate innings.

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s

Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado on the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League.
