YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox split the first two games of the series last night, losing the first game 6-4 but winning the second game 3-0. Tuesday's game was completed in its entirety after it was suspended due to rain. Reed Trimble fell a triple shy of the cycle for his first three hit game of the season. In the second game, Trey Gibson threw the first complete game shutout of his career with seven shutout innings and six strikeouts. Enrique Bradfield collected two hits in his first game back in seven games.

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR

OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. and RHP Keagan Gillies were both selected by MLB to participate in the 2025 MLB All-Star Futures Game in Atlanta on Saturday, July 12. Bradfield and Gillies are the 15th and 16th Baysox players and the first duo in franchise history to be selected to baseball's top prospect showcase. Bradfield, the Orioles No. 2 prospect, stole the second-most bases last season (74) and won an MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove in the outfield. Gillies held a 1.15 ERA in 31.1 innings pitched out of the bullpen before earning promotion to Triple-A Norfolk on Wednesday.

SILAS OF SWAT

C Silas Ardoin is swinging the bat at an exceptional clip as of late. The 24-year-old is batting .393 (11-for-28) over his last eight games, which is his best stretch of the season. Ardoin has collected a hit in five straight contests and has driven in a run in four straight and in seven of the last eight.

REED CAN RAKE

OF Reed Trimble is batting .343 (12-for-35) over his last nine games and has delivered multi-hit efforts in four of his last nine played. Trimble is also on a nine-game on-base streak, which is the longest active streak on the team. On Friday, the 25-yearold collected his second walk-off hit of his career and his first at Double-A. His last walk-off hit came on August 27, 2022 with Single-A Delmarva.

LET IT RIP LEVI

RHP Levi Wells is set to make his 10th start of the season for the Baysox. The Orioles No. 11 prospect (via Baseball America) has recorded a 1.89 ERA over his last five starts spanning 19 innings. The 23-year-old pitched his first career five inning scoreless start on Friday vs Altoona, allowing just one hit and one walk with four strikeouts. The Orioles drafted Wells in the 4th round of the 2023 Draft out of Texas State.

CLOSE GAMES AND FREE BASEBALL

Chesapeake has won 17 one-run games this season - tied for the most in the Eastern League. The Baysox have played 30 one-run games this season, which is the most in all of Double-A. Chesapeake has won nine extra-inning games this season, which is the second-most amongst full-season MiLB clubs (Quad Cities - High-A KC).

BULLPEN BEASTS

Chesapeake's bullpen holds a 3.04 ERA, which is third-best in Double-A and sixthbest in full-season MiLB. Baysox relievers have punched out 376 hitters, which is third-most in all of Double-A and the most in the Eastern League.

SIZING UP THE SQUIRRELS

The Richmond Flying Squirrels - Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants - finished the first half with a 21-46 record, which was last in the league. Richmond started the second half with a home series loss to Reading. Richmond's roster includes five of the Giants' top 30 prospects, per MLB.com - LHP Joe Whitman (No. 6), IF Diego Velasquez (No. 15), IF Aeverson Arteaga (No. 16), IF Sabin Ceballos (No. 23) and LHP Jack Choate (No. 27)

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Joe Whitman makes his 15th start of the regular season for the Flying Squirrels. The Giants No. 6 prospect is coming off a rough month of June where he recorded a 10.90 ERA in 17.1 innings. Whitman faced the Baysox on April 16 and lasted just 2.2 innings before allowing four runs on two hits and three walks with five strikeouts in the loss. Whitman was drafted in the 2nd round by the Giants in 2022 out of Kent St.

Lasted only one inning on 5/17 vs AKR due to left abdomen discomfort. Pitched first career quality start with career-high 6.0 innings of two-run ball on 5/10 @ POR. Pitched 5.0 IP with 5 K in first Double-A start on 4/26 vs ALT. Started season as a tandem reliever before being inserted into starting rotation on 4/26. Notched first Double-A save on 4/15 @ RIC. 2024: Spent first full season in Minors in High-A Aberdeen exclusively as a starter. Threw 60.1 IP and struck out 74 over 30 BB to a 6.71 ERA. ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. The 17th manager in franchise history, he led the Baysox to a 62-75 overall record, oversaw 18 player promotions to Triple-A and coached two former Baysox who would go on to make their Major League debuts in the same season. The New Britain, CT native also managed the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League this past offseason, where he led them to a league-best 18-10 record and a Fall League Championship Game appearance.

Before the Baysox, Mercado spent two seasons as manager of the Aberdeen IronBirds - the Orioles' High-A affiliate. Mercado received the Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award in 2022 by the Orioles.

Prior to joining the O's, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut and served as Dean of Students for over 18 years.

JORDIE HENRY

Pitching Coach

Jordie Henry enters his first season as Baysox Pitching Coach in 2025 and his third season as a member of the Orioles' system. Previously, Henry served as the pitching coach at High-A Aberdeen where his staff recorded 1,357 strikeouts last season – 2nd-most in the South Atlantic League and 2nd-most in IronBirds franchise history. Before joining the Orioles, Henry was the Director of Pitching at Prime Sports Performance in Baltimore – a private athletic development training facility. He also worked as a pitching coach and instructor at the high school and summer collegiate levels. Henry pitched collegiately for four seasons at Wayland Baptist University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la DiversiónTM" or "Fun CupTM"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League BaseballTM teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
