**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn tossed the first nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history, shutting out Aberdeen, 3-0...RHP **Dakota Hawkins** tossed 5.0 innings of scoreless ball in his second professional start...Allowed one baserunner on a leadoff walk to SS **Jalen Vasquez** in the third...RHP **Joey Lancellotti** pitched a scoreless sixth, walking Vasquez to start the inning and stranding him on third...RHP **Joshua Cornielly** plunked a batter in the seventh and walked a man in the ninth, but tossed 3.0 spotless frames to earn his league-high-tying sixth save and secure the no-hitter...Retired LF **Elio Prado** for the final out on a ground ball to SS **William Lugo**...C **Francisco Alvarez** caught all 9.0 innings in a Major League rehab appearance, going 1-for-3 at the plate with a single and a walk...RF **Stanley Consuegra** made a pair of leaping catches in right to preserve the no-hit bid and added an RBI single in the third...DH **Jeffrey De Los Santos** picked up two hits, including a solo home run in the fourth.

**YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT:** RHPs **Dakota Hawkins** (5.0 IP), **Joey Lancellotti** (1.0), and **Joshua Cornielly** (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history in Tuesday's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...The only previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP **Brandon Moore** tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen...It is just the third no-hitter in Minor League Baseball in 2024...LHP **Chayce McDermott**, RHP **Nolan Hoffman**, and RHP **Kaleb Ort** combined on a 2-0 no-hitter for Baltimore's Triple-A Norfolk on May 3 vs. Nashville...RHP **Dylan Cumming**, RHP **Nick Sinacola**, and LHP **Seth Corry** of San Francisco's High-A Eugene combined on a 4-0 no-no on April 17 vs. Vancouver...Tuesday's effort was the first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP **Joander Suárez** hurled a seven-inning one on September 7 at Hartford.

**SHUT OUT THE LIGHTS:** The Cyclones' pitching staff earned its seventh shutout victory in Tuesday's 3-0 no-hit win vs. Aberdeen...On Sunday, Brooklyn earned its sixth of the season in a 7-0 triumph at Jersey Shore...The Cyclones have thrown a season-high 21 consecutive scoreless innings since two out in the fifth inning on Saturday and shut out opponents in back-to-back games twice now in 2024...Brooklyn's blanking of the BlueClaws on Sunday marked the team's first shutout since May 4's 4-0 and May 3's 2-0 wins vs. Aberdeen...The seven shutouts are tied for the most in the South Atlantic League and tied for the third-most in Minor League Baseball...In 2023, the Cyclones set a franchise record with 11 shutouts.

**NECK AND NECK DOWN THE STRETCH:** Including Wednesday, 14 games remain in the First Half of the South Atlantic League season...The Cyclones are tied with Jersey Shore for second in the North Division...Brooklyn is 2.5 games back of first-place Greensboro...The Grasshoppers hold the lead in the division even though they did not play an in-division opponent until this week, as the Jersey Shore BlueClaws travel to North Carolina...So far, Greensboro has played just seven games against teams with a record of .500 or better, holding a 3-4 mark.

**EL TROLL RETURNS:** C **Francisco Alvarez** joined Brooklyn on Tuesday to continue his Major League rehab assignment...The 22-year-old went 1-for-3 with a single and a walk, catching all 9.0 innings of a combined no-hitter on Tuesday...He joined Double-A Binghamton last week and appeared in three contests for the Rumble Ponies, going 2-for-8 at the plate with two runs scored, a home run, and three RBI...Alvarez has been on the New York Mets' 10-day injured list since April 20 with a left thumb sprain...As a member of the Cyclones in 2021, he set a then-franchise record with 22 home runs in 84 games...That mark is second-most in a single season in Brooklyn franchise history behind OF **Stanley Consuegra's** 23 in 2023...His 58 RBI in 2021 is the third-most in a single season behind Consuegra (63) in 2023 and INF **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021...Alvarez's .538 slugging percentage and .889 OPS rank fourth and sixth in Cyclones' single-season history...C **Austin Allen** has also joined Brooklyn from the Florida Complex League on a minor league rehab assignment...The 30-year-old signed with New York as a minor league free agent on January 16 and has appeared in 57 Major League games between the San Diego Padres and Oakland Athletics, hitting .195 (23-118) with two home runs.

**MARVELOUS MORABITO:** OF **Nick Morabito** has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Morabito is fifth in Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.468)...He is also tied for eighth in batting average (.348) and tied for 11th in stolen bases (25)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is third in the league lead in steals (14) and tied for third in runs scored (20).

**CROWN HIM!** In last Wednesday's win over Jersey Shore, OF **Stanley Consuegra's** RBI double in the fourth inning made him the new Cyclones all-time hits leader (172), breaking a tie with OF **Alex Ramirez**...The 23-year-old is atop the Cyclones' ranks in numerous other offensive categories as well, including extra-base hits (78), home runs (35), and RBI (114)...He is also one double (37) from matching Ramirez's franchise mark (38)...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

**vs. ABERDEEN:** Brooklyn returns home for a six-game series against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...Aberdeen possess six of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** (5), INF **Mac Horvath** (11), LHP **Luis De León** (17), RHP **Jackson Baumeister** (18), RHP **Carter Baumler** (28), and C **Creed Willems** (29)...The Cyclones captured the first meeting at Maimonides Park, winning 4-of-6...In 2023, Brooklyn went 7-5 against Aberdeen on Coney Island and 3-3 at Leidos Field...Dating back to 2002, Brooklyn leads the all-time series since 2021, 131-115 (.533).

**SUPER STANLEY:** Not only did OF **Stanley Consuegra** set the franchise hit record last Wednesday afternoon, the 23-year-old is in the midst of his best offensive stretch of the season...Consuegra is on a seven-game hitting streak and has a hit in 14 of his last 15 games since May 17 at Bowling Green...During that time, he's hitting .321/.429/.755 with a 1.184 OPS during that time...The Dominican native has scored 12 runs and added five doubles, six home runs, and 13 RBI...Consuegra has raised his batting average by 51 points (.171 to .222) and his OPS by 224 points (.519 to .743) during the stretch.

**START ME UP:** The Cyclones' starting rotation has been one of the best in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Brooklyn holds the best ERA for starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League at 2.81...The Cyclones have the only starting staff with a sub-3.00 ERA in the circuit and hold a mark 0.59 runs better than the next team (Aberdeen; 3.40)...That ERA is also second at the High-A level and fifth among full-season MiLB squads...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro holds the best mark in the minors and the level (2.33).

**HOME COOKING:** The Cyclones enter play on Saturday with a 17-8 record at Maimonides Park, but a 11-16 record in opposing ballparks...So far in 2024, Brooklyn is a perfect 4-0 in home series...The 'Clones haven't lost a home series since Hudson Valley took four of six from August 15-20, 2023...Brooklyn holds the sixth-best home ERA (2.51) in Minor League Baseball...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro (2.27) has the lowest mark at the High-A level, while Texas' Single-A Down East leads MiLB (2.16)...In visiting parks, the Cyclones' ERA is 4.80.

**BUZZIN' ON THE BOARDWALK:** INF **Wilfredo Lara** and INF **Junior Tilién** are heating up over the last few weeks...In his last 14 games since May 19, Lara is hitting .286/.375/.469 with an .844 OPS, adding a double, a triple, two home runs, and seven RBI...Tilién enters Wednesday on a team-season-long 15-game on-base streak since Game 2 of May 16's doubleheader at Bowling Green...The 20-year-old has posted a .259/.379/.333 line with a .712 OPS, adding four runs scored, two doubles, a triple, four RBI, and 10 walks...The 15-game streak is Brooklyn's longest since INF **William Lugo** reached in 18-straight from August 23, 2023, until April 6, 2024.

**LARRUPIN' LORUSSO:** INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...Amongst South Atlantic League batters, Lorusso tied for third in triples (3), tied for seventh in slugging (.500), eighth in RBI (27), tied for ninth in extra-base hits (19), and 10th in OPS (.868)...The Connecticut native saw his season high 11-game hitting streak come to an end in last Friday's loss...During the streak the ninth-round selection slashed .318/.423/.659/1.082...In that time, Lorusso added a double, a triple, four home runs, and eight RBI...The 11-game hit streak was the longest for a Cyclone in 2024 and the best since INF **Jett Williams** hit in 12-straight contests from August 12-25, 2023.

**A THOUSAND VICTORIES:** Brooklyn's 2-1 victory at Rome on May 11 marked the 1,000th in Cyclones' franchise history...Brooklyn has recorded a mark of 1,010-852 (.542) in 1,862 games since 2001...May 7's 6-2 victory in Rome marked the franchise's 200th since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021...The Cyclones are 212-221 (.490) in 433 games...Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown.

**ATOP THE HEJ-ES:** RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 56 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.46 ERA (25 ER in 91.1 IP) and 5 saves, walking just 22 and striking out 79.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Picked up his third victory of the season in his second start last Thursday night at Jersey Shore...Allowed one run on a season-high seven hits over a season-long 5.0 innings...Walked one and struck out one...Tossed a season-high 61 pitches and 43 strikes (70.49%)...Relieved by RHP **Joey Lancellotti** to start the bottom of the sixth inning with Brooklyn leading 8-1...Cyclones held on to defeat the BlueClaws, 9-5.

**2024:** Joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on Monday...Posted a 1-1 record with a 2.81 ERA (5 ER in 16.0 IP), 10 walks, and 16 strikeouts in eight relief appearances for the Mets...Earned the win out of the bullpen on Opening Day, April 5 vs. Daytona, striking out a season-best six over three frames...Among Florida State League relievers with 16.0+ innings pitched at the time of his promotion, Ramirez was sixth in batting average against (.182) and opposing OPS (.573).

**THE WHOLE NINE YARDS:** Ramirez's Cyclones debut was one to remember...The 22-year-old was the only Brooklyn pitcher in 2023 to work into the ninth inning, ultimately tossing a career-high 8.0 innings of three-run ball...Ramirez allowed six hits, did not walk a batter, and struck out four...The Dominican native was the first Brooklyn pitcher to complete eight-full innings and work into the 9th since RHP **Conner Grey** carried a no-hit bid into the 9th inning vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...Grey ultimately tossed 8.1 innings that day...No Cyclone pitcher has tossed a nine-inning complete game since RHP **John Gant** posted a one-hit shutout on August 28, 2013, at Maimonides Park vs. Tri-City.

**2023:** Ramirez split the season between Single-A St. Lucie and Brooklyn...In 18 appearances (six starts) in the Florida State League, he registered a 4-8 record with a 4.91 ERA (42 ER in 77.0 IP)...Issued 23 walks and struck out 61...Thrived in a starting role, tallying a 2-2 record with a 2.89 ERA (9 ER in 28.0 IP) with six walks and 11 strikeouts in six starts...In 12 appearances out of the bullpen, Ramirez composed a 2-6 record with a 6.06 ERA (33 ER in 49.0 IP), 17 walks, and 50 strikeouts...Joined Brooklyn from Single-A St. Lucie on July 31...Made six starts down the stretch, collecting a 1-1 record with a 5.52 ERA (18 ER in 29.1 IP).

**2022:** Started the campaign with the Florida Complex League Mets...Named FCL Pitcher of the Year and a FCL Post-Season All-Star...Composed a 1-0 record with a 0.84 ERA (4 ER in 43.0 IP), one save, six walks (3.8 BB%), and 40 strikeouts (25.3 K%) in 11 appearances (six starts)...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on September 1...Made two relief appearances and accrued a 1-0 record...Did not allow a run on two hits over 3.1 innings, striking out three and walking four.
