YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Harrisburg Senators, 3-1, at FNB Field. Shane Matheny gave Richmond a 1-0 lead in the fifth inning with a solo homer. Harrisburg tied the score in the bottom of the fifth when Jecksson Flores scored on a passed ball. In the seventh, Mike Gigliotti gave Richmond a 2-1 lead with an RBI single. In the top of the ninth, Richmond added an insurance run with a bases-loaded walk by Brandon Martorano. Richmond starter Kyle Harrison earned his first Double-A win, striking out eight and allowing one unearned run in six innings. Trenton Toplikar and Chris Wright worked through the seventh and eighth innings. Cole Waites pitched a scoreless ninth for his first Double-A save.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. The two teams met for a six-game series in Harrisburg from May 10-15, with Richmond winning four of those games. The Flying Squirrels and Senators meet for one more series this year, a six-game set at The Diamond from August 30-September 4.

**PLAYOFF HUNT:** Richmond is tied for first place in the Southwest Division, even with Akron and two games ahead of Erie. The Flying Squirrels hold the tiebreaker against both teams with a winning head-to-head record. Nine games remain before the Eastern League's first half closes on June 26. The first-half and second-half division champions will meet in a best-of-three series in the Eastern League Postseason, followed by a best-of-three championship series.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have won 11-of-15 games since May 29 after losing nine of their previous 12. Last week, they won five-of-six at home against the SeaWolves, moving into first place in the Southwest Division. The Flying Squirrels have won six series, lost three and split one this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 644 strikeouts and 50 HBPs. Richmond pitchers lead the league with 249 walks issued. The Richmond bullpen has posted a 0.93 ERA (5 ER/48.2 IP) over the last 14 games since May 31.

THE SENATORS are 6-1 over their last seven games after going 1-7 in their previous eight games. Last week, Harrisburg won five-of-seven against the Baysox at home. The Senators have allowed one run in four of their last five games. Harrisburg's roster includes three of MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects, including C Drew Millas (19), SS Jackson Cluff (21) and RHP Jake Irvin (30)

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Jake Dahlberg makes his 11th start of the season and second against the Senators. Dahlberg last pitched last Friday at The Diamond against the SeaWolves and allowed three runs over 3.2 innings in a loss. In his previous start, his first since being reinstated from the IL, he held Akron scoreless over five innings in a win on June 4 at Canal Park. Dahlberg last faced the Senators on May 13 at FNB Field and allowed four runs over 51 innings on a season-high 10 hits, including two homers. Dahlberg spent parts of three seasons with the independent Chicago Dogs before signing with the Giants during the 2021 season. He joined the High-A Eugene Emeralds in July and made 10 starts, going 2-5 with a 6.60 ERA. He closed the year with two outings with Triple-A Sacramento and tossed 9.0 scoreless innings. After being named Horizon League Pitcher of the Year twice at the University of Illinois-Chicago, he was selected in the 21st round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Luis Reyes makes his sixth Double-A appearance and fifth start with the Senators this year. Last time out, he worked six scoreless, one-hit innings against the Baysox on Friday at FNB Field in a win. Reyes began the season with Triple-A Rochester, going 0-1 with a 14.18 ERA in five games. He was assigned to Double-A Harrisburg on May 17. Reyes was originally signed by the Nationals in 2012 out of the Dominican Republic. Reyes first reached Double-A in 2021, going 7-6 with a 4.76 ERA in 16 games (15 starts). He finished the 2021 season tied for fifth in the Double-A Northeast with seven wins.

**#WINNING:** The Flying Squirrels have tied their best record in franchise history through 59 games at 34-25, even with the team's start in 2014, the last year the team made the playoffs. The Flying Squirrels' best start through 60 games is 35-25, which was set in 2014 and can be matched with a win tonight.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,061) and total attendance (181,817). Richmond is 11th of the 120 Mil.B teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

**POWER SURGE:** The Richmond offense has hit 77 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (79), **Sean Roby** is second in the league with 16 homers on the season, with 13 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 180 home runs.

A LITTLE RELIEF: The Richmond bullpen has posted a 0.93 ERA (5 ER/48.2 IP) over the last 14 games since May 31. In that stretch, **Blake Rivera** has made three scoreless outings with 6.0 scoreless innings. **John Russell** has worked four straight scoreless outings in that span, totaling 4.2 innings. **Chris Wright, R.J. Dabovich** and **Cole Waites** have combined to convert five of the team's six save opportunities in that stretch.

MARTY PARTY: Over his last 25 games played since May 11, Brandon Martorano has hit .294 (27-for-92) with five homers, four doubles, three triples and 17 RBIs. On May 11 at Harrisburg, he clubbed the second grand slam of his career. He returned to the lineup two days later and lifted the Flying Squirrels to a 6-5 win in extras with a sac fly in the 10th inning. On May 14 at Harrisburg, he homered twice for the first time in his career, knocking a go-ahead, three-run homer in the sixth and a solo shot for an insurance run in the ninth inning. Martorano hit a go-ahead, solo homer on May 7 at Akron in a 3-2 win and drove in the go-ahead run in the 8-4 win over the 'Ducks on May 9. On Saturday, he lifted a walk-off sac fly in the bottom of the ninth for a 6-5 win over Erie.

SHANE TRAIN: Since May 1, Shane Matheny is batting .333 (29-for-87) with six homers, four doubles, a triple and 18 RBIs. He has picked up a pair of two-homer games, one on May 1 at The Diamond against Bowie and another on May 12 at Harrisburg. They were the second and third multi-homer games of his professional career and his first since 2019. From May 14-June 10, he posted a 13-game hitting streak, tied for the longest in the EL this season, even with a 13-game streak for Portland's Pedro Castellanos from May 6-22. He was placed on the 7-day IL on May 29 and reinstated on June 7. In his return, he picked up a pair of RBI singles. From May 1-June 11, Matheny posted a 24-game on-base streak, which was the second-longest in the league this season. His on-base streak was snapped with an 0-for-3 game on Tuesday, but he responded two a homer on Wednesday.

**TOASTY: Frankie Tostado** is hitless over his last five games, going 0-for-19 in that span with six strikeouts. From April 22-June 8, Tostado hit .342 (51-for-149) with seven homers, nine doubles, a triple and 26 RBIs in 39 games. In the Eastern League, Tostado is ranked sixth in batting average (.296) and fourth in hits (61).

ROBUST: Sean Roby hit his 16th homer of the season on Friday night, his third straight game with a homer. He is second in the EL in home runs this year, trailing Erie's Kerry Carpenter (20). He has hit 13 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by Adam Duvall in 2013. With two homers on May 29 against Hartford, he set a new Flying Squirrels record with his third multi-homer game of the season. Roby hit eight homers over a 15-game stretch from April 10-29. He had hit just one homer over a 16-game stretch from April 30-May 25 prior to knocking seven in his last 15 games since May 26.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: Frankie Tostado is ranked sixth in batting average (,296) and fourth in hits (61). Sean Roby is second in home runs (16) and ninth in SLG (,500). Mike Gigliotti is ninth in OBP (,394), tied for ninth in walks (29) and tied for seventh in stolen bases (15). Ryan Walker is tied for first in wins (6). Chris Wright is tied for fifth in saves (6). Taylor Rashi is tied for fifth in games pitched (20).

WHERE THE SENATORS RANK: In the Eastern League, Wilson Garcia is 10th in batting average (.284) and tied for fifth in hits (57). Jake Alu is tied for third in doubles (16). Jack Connell is fifth in runs scored (37). Matt Brill is second in saves (9).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Kyle Harrison (2), R.J. Dabovich (17), Ricardo Genoves (24) and Chris Wright (27). Franklin Labour is rated by Baseball America as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Simon Whiteman is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by Baseball America as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Dabovich (16), Brett Auerbach (27), Genoves (29) and Kai-Wei Teng (30). Harrison is Baseball America's No. 64 overall prospect and MLB. RICHMOND
