Welcome to the Gunnar Show: 2023 Lugnuts starting pitcher **Gunnar Hoglund** is getting called up to the Athletics, Jeff Passan reported this afternoon. When he make his MLB debut, Hoglund will become the 195th all-time Lugnut to go from Lansing to the Majors and the second this season (joining **Max Muncy**).

Candidates for 200: Who will be the 200th all-time Lugnut to reach MLB? Triple-A Las Vegas has Colby Thomas, Daniel Susac and Denzel Clarke (celebrating his 25th birthday today) as worthy candidates, not to mention reliever Jake Walkinshaw, while Henry Bolte and Luis Morales are off to strong starts for Double-A Midland. But keep an eye out for Jack Winkler, selected in the Rule 5 Draft Triple-A phase last December by Miami, who is batting .339 with an .863 OPS in Jacksonville, as well as Seth Shuman, who just tossed five one-hit scoreless innings in his second start for Rochester.

Prospecting: The Nuts boast the Athletics' second, third, fourth and fifth selections in the 2024 draft: slugging third baseman **Tommy White** (40th overall), southpaw starter **Gage Jump** (73rd), shortstop **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** (75th) and outfielder **Rodney Green, Jr.** (104th). White is rated the A's No. 7 prospect, Kuroda-Grauer is No. 10, Jump is No. 13 and Green is No. 18. The Lugnuts also have 19-year-old **Steven Echavarria**, rated No. 12, and outfielder **Nate Nankil**, who is No. 28.

Atop the League: The Lugnuts' offense leads the Midwest League in batting average (.280), base hits (215), fewest strikeouts (149), on-base percentage (.387) and OPS (.791). The Nuts also rank second in slugging percentage (.404).

3-2-1 Contact: In fact, the Lugnuts are the toughest team to strike out in Minor League Baseball, as seen in both total strikeouts (149 in 23 games) and strikeouts per game (6.48).

Streaking: Clark Elliott (2-for-4 yesterday) enters today on a 17-game on-base streak; Tommy White (1-for-4) has hit safely in 14 straight games and reached base in his last 16 straight games; and T.J. Schofield-Sam (idle) has reached base in his last 14 games.

APRIL 30TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: In front of an electric Saturday night crowd of 8,212, Chris Hopkins lined a one-out game-winning RBI single in the bottom of the ninth, driving in Oliver Dominguez, to defeat the Fort Wayne TinCaps, 3-2, and capture the Lugnuts' 1,000th all-time victory. The win came 5,138 days after the Lugnuts' first victory as a franchise.

2014: Aroldis Chapman made a rehab start for Dayton, striking out D.J. Davis and Jason Leblebijian and retiring Mitch Nay on a flyout to left. The game turned into a pitcher's duel before L.B. Dantzler's grand slam highlighted a six-run seventh, and the Lugnuts won, 9-6.

2018: With Roger Clemens in attendance, son Kacy Clemens drilled an oppo grand slam onto Home Run Hill in left, but the Lugnuts lost to the Kane County Cougars, 6-5.

Gage Jump joined Trystan Magnuson as the only Lugnuts in franchise history to make their pro debut as the Opening Day starter. The 6-foot-7 Canadian southpaw was drafted 56th overall in 2007 from Louisville. Pitching in Fort Wayne on Opening Day, April 3, 2008, Magnuson allowed a two-run homer in the first inning to Angel Mercado, allowed three runs total in 1 2/3 innings and took the L in a 7-1 Nuts loss to the Wizards. He finished the season 0-9 with a 5.40 ERA in 81 2/3 innings, was traded by Toronto to Oakland with Danny Farquhar for Rajai Davis on November 17, 2010, and made nine appearances for the A's in the Major Leagues in 2011. According to his wikipedia page, Magnuson "now works as a mechanical engineer in the automotive industry."

Background: Jump starred at JSerra Catholic H.S., which also produced Royce Lewis and former TinCaps catcher Austin Hedges... he was rated California's No. 1 LHP and No. 5 prospect, the nation's No. 5 LHP, and No. 41 draft prospect... drafted in the 18th round by San Diego, but declined Padres' offer... began his college track at UCLA, making seven appearances as a freshman 2022 before he was shut down due to injury; missed all of 2023 after undergoing Tommy John surgery... transferred to LSU, saying "I just wanted to be in the SEC"... his older brother Hunter, an outfielder, had played SEC ball in 2022 for Kentucky after transferring from Arizona State... spent one season with Bayou Bengals: 6-2, 3.47, 17 G/15 GS, 83 IP, 22 BB, 101 K, .218 avg. ... No. 8 in SEC in ERA and opp. avg. ... named to SEC All-Tournament Team after shutting down Georgia on four hits and one run in seven innings, whiffing seven... 7-IP CG at Missouri, April 19: 3 H, 1 R, 14 K.
