- Tampa raced away from Dunedin to take a 10-4 victory on Thursday night at TD Ballpark.
- Grant Rogers opened the game in sterling fashion for Dunedin, retiring the first nine batters he faced, racking up six strikeouts. Tarpons hurler Cade Smith followed, striking out seven without allowing a base runner in the first three innings.
- Tampa got to Rogers in the fourth, loading the bases with no outs. Rogers retired the next two, before Willy Montero unloaded the bases with a 3-RBI double.
- In the fifth, Tampa tossed up another three spot, chasing Rogers from the game.
- Smith cruised through six scoreless innings, striking out 11 Jays in the process.
- The Tarpons pushed the lead to 9-0 with three more runs in the seventh, scoring on doubles from Coby Morales and Dylan Jasso.
- Yhoangel Aponte got the Jays on the board in the bottom of the inning, ripping a solo homer. Dunedin rallied for three runs in the eighth, highlighted by RBI knocks from Victor Arias and Aponte.
- Tampa reached double digits with a solo homer from Jasso in the 9th.

#### **ON THE SCHNEID**

After opening the season 9-3, Dunedin has lost 12 of its last 14 games to fall to 10-14. Across the 14 game stretch, the Blue Jays are averaging 2.5 runs per game, hitting .184 with an OPS of .533. In the first 12 games of the season, Dunedin scored 6.5 runs per game.

#### **SLIMMEST OF MARGINS**

Last night's 6-run win by the Tarpons marked Dunedin's first game decided by more than four runs in over two weeks (April 17 vs Clearwater - 12 games ago). Eight of the team's first 11 games were decided by four or more runs.

#### OH. K

The Blue Jays set new single-game highs for strikeouts as a pitching staff (15) and at the plate (16) last night. Yhoangel Aponte was the only D-Jay to not strikeout. Two D-Jays, Cristian Feliz (36) and Arjun Nimmala (32), rank top five in the league in strikeouts.

#### FOUR. BUT NO MORE

Dunedin's offense has been held to four or fewer runs in 11 consecutive games. In the first 12 games of the year, the Jays were held held to four or fewer just three times.

#### A+ APONTE

Across the last two games, Yhoangel Aponte has racked up seven hard-hit balls (measured at 95 MPH or higher exit velocity), including four last night in four at-bats. However, just three have resulted in hits. Aponte's 47% hard-hit rate leads Dunedin.

#### IN THE ARIAS TONIGHT

Victor Arias ranks among the league's leading hitters in nearly every major rate stat. Arias is top five in average (2nd - .368), OBP (4th - .463), SLG (3rd - .544), and OPS (2nd - 1.007). Arias has more multi-hit games (7) than hitless games (3).

#### NO SUCH THING AS A FREE PASS

Dunedin hitters have struggled to draw walks this week against a Tampa pitching staff that ranks among the league leaders in walks issued (118 - T-3rd, with Dunedin), walking just seven times in three games. However, the Jays' pitching staff's command has matched the Tarpons' effort, issuing just seven free passes.

#### BULLISH ON THE 'PEN

Blue Jays relievers have been strong in the last nine games, posting a 2.45 ERA (10 ER) in 36.2 innings of work. Three of those runs came in last night's loss. Dunedin's 3.34 bullpen ERA ranks third in the FSL.

#### **LOOKING FOR SAVINGS**

Tuesday night's save from Yondrei Rojas marked just the third save by the Blue Jays this season - tied for the fewest in the Florida State League.

#### YOUNG GUN

Dunedin shortstop Arjun Nimmala is the second-youngest player in the Florida State league to open the season, at 18.5 years old (behind Daytona's Alfredo Duno at 18.2). Maykel Minoso joins Nimmala as the second 18 year old on the Blue Jays' roster.

- Arsenal features a mid-90s fastball, changeup, curveball, and slider.
