## Sacramento River Cats (16-12) at Salt Lake Bees (12-18)

**THAT STINGS:** The River Cats dropped last night's game at Salt Lake, 2-4, ending their four-game winning streak against the Bees...Spencer Bivens made his first start since September 8, 2024 with San Francisco and was dealt his first loss of the season...allowed three runs on three hits, with one walk and two strikeouts in 2.0 innings of work...Victor Bericoto went 2-for-4 with a double, batting in both of Sacramento's runs...the Cats are now 1-4 when scoring two-or-less runs...two hours and 15 minutes marked the shortest game of the year.

► The Cats did not homer, ending their season-long seven-game home run streak (April 23-29).

**QUEEN BEES:** Sacramento won Wednesday's game, 17-7...Carson Seymour was the starter and earned his first win of the season...allowed two runs on six hits (1 HR) with no walks and a season-high-tying five strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...the Cats totaled four home runs on the evening, their most this year...they had four-plus-homer nights five times in 2025...the team recorded 55 plate appearances and 28 total bases, both their most since August 28, 2025 when they had 59 plate appearances and 41 total bases at Reno...3:21 was the longest game this season not including delays (3:30 game with a :17 delay at Salt Lake on April 1)...17 runs were their most scored in a game this season...they had four games in 2025 with 17-or-more runs scored...Grant McCray knocked the Kitties' second grand slam of the year in the fourth inning...marked the fifth grand slam of Grant's career and first at the Triple-A level...his last was May 4, 2024 with Double-A Richmond...Victor Bericoto also had a two-run shot in the fifth, his third longball on the season...see more on Bryce Eldridge's two-homer night below vvv.

**BYRCE'S BIG NIGHT:** On Wednesday, Giants' top prospect Bryce Eldridge recorded a multi-homer night with a two-run shot in the second and a three-run shot in the eighth...marked the first time a River Cat had a multi-homer night since Thomas Gavello on August 28...his first home run travelled 434 feet, the longest by a River Cat this year...the ball also had an exit velocity of 110.1mph, his highest this season...he has 10 total swings in his career above 110mph, three of those being home runs...Bryce recorded five runs scored, the first player to accomplish this at any level this season...also the first River Cat to do so since Michael Dubón on August 23, 2019...was the second Cat to have a six-RBI night this season (Osleivis Basabe, April 23).

**DOUBLE DOUBLES:** The River Cats recorded their first multi-double play game on Thursday...they were the last team at the Triple-A level to do so...through April 28 last year, they had already had seven multi-double play games, including one game with four DPs...every other Triple-A team has at least two multi-double play games...their total double plays sit at 19.

► They are ranked 9th in the PCL and T-21st in Triple-A in DPs...in 2025, Sac ranked third in Triple-A in DPs with 145, behind Reno (151) and Albuquerque (149).

► Bryce Eldridge ranks first on the team with 16 double plays, followed by Nate Furman (10), Osleivis Basabe (10) and Thomas Gavello (6).

**SPRING INTO ACTION:** The River Cats batted .282 over 24 games in the month of April...they hit 42 doubles, three triples, 24 home runs, 136 RBI, drew 96 walks, and struck out 175 times...they had a .367 on-base percentage and a .434 slugging percentage, totaling an .801 OPS...last season, the Cats batted .241 in the month of April with a .338 OBP and .363 SLG for a total .701 OPS...below are players who batted particularly well this month:

**A LITTLE GOES A LONSWAY:** Southpaw Seth Lonsway will take the mound tonight at Salt Lake...last pitched on April 25 in Game 1 of Sacramento's doubleheader against Albuquerque...allowed one run on three hits, with four walks, three strikeouts and one hit batsman in a season-high 5.0 innings of work...over four starts this season, Lonsway has posted a 4.50 ERA (16.0 IP, 8 ER) with eight walks, five strikeouts and a .271 opponent batting average...in 2025, Lonsway played 19 games with the Double-A Richmond Flying Squirrels where he posted a 3.52 ERA (92.0 IP, 36 ER) with 42 walks, 84 strikeouts and a .264 opponent batting average...was called up to Sacramento on July 29 and made his Triple-A debut on August 1...in nine games with the River Cats last season, Lonsway had a 4.29 ERA (42. IP, 20 ER), 25 walks, 38 strikeouts and a .281 opponent batting average.

**TOMORROW'S PROBABLE: LHP John Michael Bertrand #40 (1-0, 4.57)**



Southpaw John Michael Bertrand is set to start tomorrow's game at Salt Lake...last pitched on April 25 in Game 2 of Sacramento's doubleheader against Albuquerque where he earned the win in the River Cats' 9-2 victory...allowed one run (0 earned) on nine hits, with two walks and five strikeouts in 6.0 quality innings...was the first quality start for Sac this year...through five games (4 starts) this season, Bertrand has posted a 4.57 ERA (21.2 IP, 11 ER) with 11 walks, 15 strikeouts and a .323 opponent batting average...spent a majority of the 2025 season with the Double-A Richmond Flying Squirrels...in 25 starts with the Squirrels he posted a 2.87 ERA (131.2 IP, 42 ER) with 15 walks, 91 strikeouts and a .249 opponent batting average...was promoted to the River Cats on September 19...played two games with the Cats (1 start) where he had a 2.25 ERA (12.0 IP, 3 ER), one walk, 10 strikeouts and a .273 opponent batting average...Bertrand pitched three innings of relief in the River Cats' season-opener on March 27 where he allowed three runs on five hits (1 HR), one walk, and two strikeouts.
