**Pitchers Pace the Pack:** Despite posting the league's fourth-highest ERA in July (6.70), Nashville pitching still leads the International League in ERA (4.38) ahead of the Norfolk Tides (4.49). They also lead the circuit in fewest walks allowed (481), WHIP (1.41) and home runs allowed (91).

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipe $line's \ Top-30 \ Milwaukee \ prospects. \ Left-handed \ pitcher \ Robert \ Gasser \ is \ the \ No. \ 7 \ prospect, \ left-handed$ pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect and right-handed pitcher Justin Jarvis is the No. 30 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 652-560 record during an eight-season span.

**LAST OUTING:** Gasser worked 5.0 innings last time out in Louisville, dealing with a lot of traffic (9 H, 1 BB) but striking out eight in a no-decision. It was his sixth straight start with one or fewer walks. The Sounds dropped the contest in 10 innings.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** In three career starts against Jacksonville, Gasser is 1-1 with a 4.02 ERA (15.2 IP/7 ER) and 15 strikeouts. He threw his first career complete game in his last appearances against the Jumbo Shrimp, working all seven innings of a doubleheader win.
