

EXTRA! EXTRA!: The Cyclones moved to 4-1 in games that enter extra innings with a 5-4 win over Wilmington in 11 frames on Tuesday night...Brooklyn has gone to extra frames in 3 of 6 games against the Blue Rocks this year, holding a 2-1 record...No team in the South Atlantic League has played in more extra-inning contests so far in 2023...Throughout Minor League Baseball, only Triple-A Nashville (7), Double-A Erie (7), Triple-A Jacksonville (6), and Double-A Akron (6) have played in more this season...Last season, Brooklyn went 4-4 in extra-inning contests, including a 4-1 mark on the road.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Brooklyn plays their first doubleheader of the 2023 season on Wednesday evening...The twinbill makes up for a game postponed on Coney Island on Sunday, April 23, when the affair was washed out due to wet grounds...In 2022, the Cyclones played in 10 twinbills, registering a split record of 10-10...Wednesday marks Brooklyn's first double-dip since the final games of the 2022 season on September 11 at Winston-Salem...The Dash swept that twinbill, winning the opener, 5-4, and the nightcap in 8 innings, 4-3... The Cyclones swept their last doubleheader against Wilmington... Brooklyn won the opener, 1-0, in 8 frames, and the finale, 4-1, on June 18, 2022.

POWER OF PARADA: C **Kevin Parada** has reached base safely in 8-straight games dating back to April 27 at Jersey Shore...In that span, the 21-year-old is slashing .300/.382/.600 with a .982 OPS... Parada is 9-for-30 (.300) at the dish with 5 runs scored, 4 doubles, a triple, a home run, 3 RBI, and 3 walks...The Los Angeles native has also registered at least one base-knock in 7-of-those-8 games.

ESTEP UP: INF **Chase Estep** has broken out of a major slump in a big way...Over a 9-game span between April 12 and May 2, the Corbin, Ky. native was 0-for-32 at the plate with 3 runs scored, an RBI, 3 walks, and 14 strikeouts...Estep ended that stretch with a tow-ering 2-run home run to right field on Friday night...Over his last 3 games, the former Kentucky Wildcat is 5-for-11 (.455) at the dish with 3 runs scored, a double, a home run, 2 RBI and a walk.

ALEX SMACKS: OF Alex Ramírez had his team-season-long 12-game hitting streak halted last Tuesday, but the 20-year-old has reached in 19-straight games dating back to April 12...In that span, Ramírez is slashing .307/.388/.387 with a .775 OPS and a 114 wRC+... Alex is 23-for-75 at the dish with 9 runs scored, 4 extra-base hits, 1 home run, 14 RBI, 8 walks, and 4 stolen bases in 5 attempts...Since joining Brooklyn's roster on July 4 of last year, Ramírez leads the South Atlantic League in RBI (50), hits (89) and doubles (21)...He only trails teammate OF **Stanley Consuegra** in extra-base hits (28) and total bases (130) total bases (130)

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: Brooklyn pitching did nothing but post zeroes on the scoreboard in Sunday's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...It was the Cyclones' first shutout victory of the season...It was Brook-lyn's first shutout win since September 9, 2022, at Winston-Salem... RHP Jeffrey Colón (7.0 IP) and RHP Daison Acosta (2.0) combined on a 3-hit, 3-0 blanking of the Dash...It was the first for the Cyclones at Maimonides Park since August 5, 2022, also against Winston-Sa-lem...LHP Keyshawn Askew (4.1), RHP David Griffin (3.2), and RHP Dylan Hall (1.0) united on a 6-hit, 2-0 victory.

PUNCHING TICKETS: Cyclones pitchers matched a season-best with 17 strikeouts vs. Aberdeen on Saturday afternoon...RHP Joander Suárez struck out a season-high 8...RHP Benito García (4), RHP Jace Beck (2), and LHP Quinn Brodey (3) each sat down multi-ple hitters...Brooklyn previously whiffed 17 batters at Winston-Salem on April 14...The 17 K's were the most for the 'Clones are Maimon-ides Park since Brooklyn punched out 18 batters — also against Aberdeen — on July 23, 2016, when both were members of the Short-Season New York-Penn League...RHP Justin Dunn (5), LHP Kyle Regnault (2), and RHP Nabil Crismatt (11) combined for the 18 K's.

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn heads south for a 6-game set against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks boast 5 of Washington's top 30 prospects per Baseball America...OF James Wood (1), OF Jeremy De La Rosa (8), OF T.J. White (10), RHP Andry Lara (15), and INF Trey Lipscomb (24)...The Cyclones went 13-14 in 27 matchups against Wilmington in 2022...Brooklyn held a 8-9 record at Frawley Stadium last year...The Blue Rocks captured 3-of-5 games from the Cyclones at Maimonides Park from April 18-22.

starting pitcher in the SAL in 2023...The 23-year-old punched out a career-high 9 batters over 5 innings in a no-decision last Tuesday vs. Aberdeen, adding 2.0 more shutout frames on Sunday...Entering Wednesday, Stuart trails only Wilmington's RHP **Kyle Luckham** (1.29) for the league lead in ERA (1.74)...He is also 6th in batting average against (.200), and 10th in strikeouts (30)...The right-hander is also 3rd in xFIP (3.21) and 4th in strikeout rate (35.3%) plus strikeouts per nine innings (13.06).

TIDWELL'S SHARP BLADE: RHP Blade Tidwell set a career-high and a team-season-best with 10 strikeouts over 5.1 innings vs. Aberdeen on Thursday night...The 21-year-old is the first Cyclone pitcher to reg-ister 10-plus punch outs in a single game since RHP Carson Seymour struck out 10 hitters on July 22, 2022, at Jersey Shore...Tidwell was the first Brooklyn arm to whiff 10 at home since RHP Dominic Hamel accomplished the feat with 10 K's on July 16, 2022, vs. Greensboro.

OMNIPRESENT OMAR: In addition to his 13 stolen bases in 14 attempts in 2023, OF **Omar De Los Santos** remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 83 stolen bases in that span, which is 4th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (90), Athletics OF **Esteury Ruíz** (85), and Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (84) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 49 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time... Fellow Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 34...Omar is already 19 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin's** franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

DANIEL'S DOMINANCE: LHP Daniel Juárez has been as dominant as can be out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2023...In his first 9 outings of the campaign, the southpaw holds a 2-0 record with 1 save...He has not permitted a run on 3 hits and 3 walks, striking out 13...In 14 regular season appearances with the 'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez has yielded only 1 unearned run in 13.2 innings... The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 22 straight appearances dating back to last year...Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie at Palm Beach...Since then, he is 4-0 with 8 hits allowed, 12 walks, and 28 strikeouts in 24.0 innings. innings.

ATOP THE WONDER WHEEL: Prior to Opening Day, Baseball Amer-ica ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball...The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the Ione South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

MEET THE 'NEW' BOSS: Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloom-field Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18).

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts 3 of the Mets Top 10 prospects, ac-cording to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 5 of the Top 30... They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramírez** (4/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7/9)...INF **William Lugo** (27/26) and RHP **Christian Scott** (30/26) also appears on both lists...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.



LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his second loss of the year last Thursday vs. Aberdeen...Permitted 3 runs on 2 hits over a career-high 5.1 innings...Walked 3 and punched out a career-best 10...Yielded solo home runs to 3B **Isaac De León** in the 2nd and 1B **Max Costes** in the 4th...Hurled 2 wild pitches...Tossed 82 pitches (51 strikes)...Relieved by RHP **Robert Colina** with the bases empty and 1 out in the top of the 6th and Brooklyn behind, 3-0...IronBirds went on to shutout the Cyclones, 9-0.

SIT DOWN: Tidwell whiffed a career-high 10 batters on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...The 21-year-old became the first Brooklyn pitcher to strike out 10+ batters in a single game since RHP **Carson Seymour** punched out 10 hitters on July 22, 2022, at Jersey Shore...Tidwell was the first Cyclone to do it at home since RHP **Dominic Hamel** accomplished the feat with 10 K's on July 16, 2022, vs. Greensboro.

TOP PROSPECT: Tidwell enters the 2023 season ranked as the Mets' top pitching prospect per MLB Pipeline...Comes at No. 7 overall on the Top 30 list...The 21-year-old is considered the organization's No. 9 overall farmhand by *Baseball America*...Only RHP **Kodai Senga** is a higher-ranked pitcher on their list...Selected as having the "Best Fastball" and "Best Secondary Pitch" in the Mets' 2022 draft class.

2022: Selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft...Signed for \$1.85 million on July 27...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 9...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning vs. FCL Astros Blue before joining Single-A St. Lucie on August 16...Made 4 starts, registering an 0-1 record with a 2.16 ERA (2 ER in 8.1 IP) and 9 strikeouts... Hurled 9.2-scoreless innings for St. Lucie in the Florida State League playoffs, helping the Mets to their first league title since 2006...Earned his first professional win in the decisive Game 2 of the Championship Series on September 20 vs. Dunedin (5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 BB, 7 SO).

VOLUNTEER SERVICE: Tidwell joined the New York system after an incredible career at Tennessee...As a draft-eligible sophomore in 2022, The Volunteer State native accrued a 3-2 record with a 3.00 ERA (13 ER in 39.0 IP) and 51 punch outs in 13 appearances (9 starts)...Missed the first two months of the season with shoulder soreness...Named to the 2022 Knoxville Regional All-Tournament team...As a freshman in 2021, Tidwell was recognized on the SEC All-Freshman Team and named a Freshman All-American by D1Baseball. com and Perfect Game.

LORETTO LIGHTNING: Tidwell is no stranger to being around talent...At Loretto (Tenn.) High School, the former second-round selection was teammates with 2018 firstround pick (No. 7 overall) and current San Diego Padres LHP **Ryan Weathers**...Ryan's father, **David**, who pitched for the Mets (2002-04) is also a Loretto High School alum.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not receive a decision last Wednesday vs. Aberdeen...Permitted 1 run on 6 hits over a season-high 6.2 innings...Walked 1 and punched out a season-best 7... ⁴/₄ Tossed 92 pitches (64 strikes)...Relieved by RHP Jace Beck ⁴/₄ with a man at second and 2 out in the top of the 7th and ⁵ the Cyclones leading 2-0...Bequeathed runner scored on a 2-run home run by 3B Max Wagner...C Kevin Parada and DH Drake Osborn provided RBI doubles in the bottom of the 7th for Brooklyn...Cyclones went on to win, 4-2.

PROSPECT RADAR: Entering the 2023 season, *Baseball America* deemed Colón one of the Mets' "14 Prospects to Watch Beyond The Top 30"

JEFE JEFFREY: Colón became the first Cyclone pitcher to work into the 7th inning in 2023 on May 3 vs. Aberdeen... The 23-year-old is the first Brooklyn pitcher to work into the 7th inning since he did it himself in a win at Winston-Salem on September 9, 2022.

2022: Assigned to Single-A St. Lucie from extended spring training on June 1...Registered a 3-0 record with a 3.23 ERA (17 ER in 47.1 IP), 2 saves, and 57 strikeouts in 13 appearances (4 starts) with the Mets...Transferred to High-A Brooklyn on August 8...Composed a 1-0 mark with a 1.07 ERA (3 ER in 25.1 IP), 2 saves, and 27 strikeouts in 6 appearances (3 starts) for the Cyclones.

FINISHING STRONG: After joining the Cyclones on August 8, Colón was one of the most dominant pitchers in the South Atlantic League through the remainder of the season... Among pitchers with at least 25.0 innings pitched, the right-hander was 2nd in the circuit in ERA (1.07)...He also yielded the fewest hits (13), tied for the fewest runs allowed (3), and ranked 3rd in WHIP (0.79) and batting average against (.153).

FLORIDA'S FINEST: During his stint with St. Lucie, Colón was among the elite producing arms in the Florida State League...From June 1 until the time of his promotion to Brooklyn, the Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native was 2nd in the circuit in ERA (3.23) and tied for 3rd in strikeouts (57)... He was also 3rd in WHIP (1.10), 4th in innings pitched (47.1), and 5th in batting average against (.227).
