SOMERSET PATRIOTS NOTES

- The Somerset Patriots defeated the Portland Sea Dogs by a score of 8-4 on Friday night at Hadlock Field in Portland, ME.
 - The win puts the Somerset Patriots 4.5 games back of the Sea Dogs for first place in the second half standings with 19 games remaining in the regular season.
 - Over the five games of the Patriots' series in Portland, Somerset's pitching staff has thrown to a 1.87 ERA, allowing 9 ER in 43.1 IP with 21 H and 57 K.
 - In 10 games since the beginning of Somerset's current road trip, the Patriots' bullpen is 4-2 with 7 ER allowed over 47.0 IP (1.34 ERA) on 20 H and 48 K.
 - Somerset used seven total pitchers in the game, a new season-high.
- **RHP Ben Shields** (2.2 IP, 2 H, 2 ER, BB, 2 K, HR) started the game and did not factor into a decision.
- **RHP Colby White** (1.1 IP, H, K) earned his second win of the season in relief of Shields.
 - In five appearances during August, White has posted a 1.29 ERA (1 ER / 7.0 IP) with 3 H, 1 BB and 8 K.
- **RHP Ian Hamilton** (1.0 IP, 3 K) struck out the side in the fifth inning of his first game of Major League rehab (right lat strain).
- **DH Jon Berti** (2-for-3, 3 RBI, R) got three at-bats in his first game of Major League rehab (left calf strain), providing Somerset with the game-deciding hit in the fourth inning with a two-out, three-run home run that gave the Patriots a 6-2 lead.
 - Berti's home run traveled an estimated 411.7 feet and was clocked at a 104 mph exit velocity.
- **CF Spencer Jones** (2-for-4, RBI, R, 2B, BB, K) reached base three times and accrued his 27th multi-hit game of the season.
- **2B Anthony Seigler** (2-for-3, RBI, 2 R, 2 BB, 2 SB) supplied the Patriots with their final run in the top of the ninth inning, while leading the charge with two of Somerset's five stolen bases on the night.
