LAST GAME

The Baysox saw their 2022 close in Akron with a disappointing evening loss. After spending the final month of the regular season in a dogfight with the Erie SeaWolves for the Southwest Division's playoff spot for the second half, Bowie entered the final day of the season in a tie for first place. While Erie held the tiebreaker, they had also lost their game earlier in the day, giving Bowie a "win-and-in" path to the playoffs. After pouncing for three runs in the first inning, Akron turned the tables on Bowie starter Cade Povich, sending across six-consecutive runs against Povich and the Bowie bullpen, ultimately handing Bowie an 8-5 loss, and their ticket home for the winter.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Last season, the Yard Goats finished with the second-best record overall in the Northeast Division at 77-60. Despite setting a franchise-record in wins, Hartford missed out on the postseason, finishing just a game behind Somerset in the first half, before ending 10.5 games behind second-half champion Portland. Entering 2023, Hartford's roster is led by three top-10 prospects in the Rockies system, per MLB Pipeline – OF Zac Veen (No. 2 COL, No. 27 overall), C Drew Romo (No. 4 COL, No. 84 overall) and INF Warming Bernabel (No. 7 COL). INF Hunter Goodman is also a potent bat, as his 36 HR across three levels were the third-most in MiLB in 2022, while his 106 RBI were tied for ninth-most.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Hartford sends right-hander Case Williams out for his first career Opening Day start. Williams currently ranks as the No. 25 overall prospect in the Rockies system, per MLB Pipeline. The Colorado-native, out of Douglas County High School, only has one Double-A start to his name. He went six innings and allowed four earned runs but tied a franchise record with 12 strikeouts in Binghamton against the Rumble Ponies in the penultimate game of last season for the Yard Goats. Williams was originally drafted by the Rockies in the fourth round of the 2020 draft, before he was dealt to the Reds prior to his professional debut, then re-acquired by the Rockies at the 2021 deadline. His 135 strikeouts across three levels in 2022 was third in the Rockies system and his 11 wins led the way.

NEW BEGINNINGS

Thursday's opener marks the first time in franchise history the Baysox will open against the Yard Goats, along with it being the team's first opener in the state of Connecticut. Hartford also marks the first opener outside of the division for Bowie since it took on the former Yankee-affiliate Trenton Thunder on April 5, 2007. Opening Day has not been kind to Bowie in recent seasons, as the Baysox have dropped five of their last seven Opening Day contests, dating back to 2014. During this rough skid, Bowie has allowed nearly six runs per game in its opening games.

MEET THE CREW

The Baysox 2023 opening roster is a balanced mix of old and new. Bowie welcomes back seven arms with at least 45 innings in a Baysox uniform (RHP Garrett Stallings, Justin Armbruster, Connor Loeprich, Jensen Elliot, Tyler Burch and LHP Antonio Velez, Easton Lucas) in 2022, along with RHP Chayce McDermott and Nolan Hoffman in addition to LHP Cade Povich, who all made significant contributions to Bowie in the second half of last season. The Baysox also roster four position players (INF Coby Mayo, César Prieto and OF Zach Watson, Shayne Fontana) with over 140 plate appearances for the Baysox last season. Highlighting the newcomers is 2020 No. 2 overall pick Heston Kjerstad. The outfielder led the Orioles with four home runs and 34 total bases in Spring Training, along with a 1.219 OPS. In total, six of the Orioles' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline (OF Heston Kjerstad – No. 6 BAL/No. 80 overall, INF Coby Mayo – No. 10 BAL, LHP Cade Povich – No. 13 BAL, INF César Prieto – No. 18 BAL, RHP Chayce McDermott – No. 19 BAL, OF John Rhodes – No. 21 BAL) will begin 2023 with Bowie.

SLIM MARGINS

Bowie had a love-hate relationship with one-run games in 2022. One-run games were one of the most common outcomes for Bowie, as their 50 one-run games lead the Eastern League. Their .429 winning percentage in one-run games (21-29) was the second-lowest in the Eastern League, trailing only Binghamton. The 29 one-run losses was the most in all of Minor League Baseball.

WELL-WORN TRAVELERS

Bowie was forced to get used to heartbreak on the road in 2022. The Baysox were dealt 12 walk-off losses in 2022, tied for the most in MiLB (St. Paul)
