ABOUT LAST NIGHT...: The Vancouver Canadians couldn't figure out the Spokane Indians (Rockies) Saturday night, as their Eastern Washington opponent took game five of the six-game set 5-2 behind six shutout innings from their starter Nick Bush and a three-run sixth that proved to be the difference.

Leading 2-0 after single runs in the first and fifth, Spokane put the game away for good in the sixth. In that inning, Isaac Collins took Brandon Eisert deep for his third home run of the series before an Aaron Schunk double set up Will MacIver's seventh home run of the year, a two-run shot that made it 5-0.

The C's didn't score until they put up lone runs in the seventh and eighth. In the seventh, Tanner Morris walked then went to third on a Luis De Los Santos double before Ronny Brito brought him in with a sacrifice fly to centerfield. Phil Clarke worked a one-out walk in the eighth, went to third on Cameron Eden's second double of the night and scored when Spencer Horwitz grounded out, but the Canadians couldn't muster any more offense in a 5-2 defeat.

Sam Ryan (L, 0-1) got the tough-luck loss in what was his first start since August of 2019. The right-hander allowed a run on two hits and a groundout to the first three batters of the first but proceeded to retire ten in a row and 11 of his last 12 over four innings pitched. He struck out one and issued no walks.

North Vancouver native Will MacAffer pitched a perfect eighth in his second outing since returning from a stint with Team Canada in the Olympic Qualifiers.

HASTA AVISTA: Vancouver arrives in Spokane this week for the first of two visits to Avista Stadium and the second of five meetings with the Indians. These two teams last met May 11-16 at Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro, when the C's took the last five games of the series after dropping the home-away-from-home opener. The Canadians have outscored the Rockies affiliate 56-41 in the season series.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

ON THIS DATE IN BASEBALL HISTORY: June 13, 2003 - On his fourth attempt, 40-year-old Roger Clemens becomes the 21st pitcher, the first since 1990, to record his 300th victory, tossing 6.2 innings in the Yankees' 5-2 interleague victory over the Cardinals. In the second inning, when Edgar Renteria swings through a full-count fastball, the 'Rocket' also joins Nolan Ryan (5,714) and Steve Carlton (4,136) as just the third hurler to record his 4,000th career strikeout.

DID YOU KNOW?: C's skipper Donnie Murphy made his pro debut for Spokane in 2002 after he was drafted by the Royals in the 5th round that year. 19-year-old Murph hit .303 with 10 doubles, two triples, 12 runs scored and 15 RBI in 28 games before he was promoted to Low-A Burlington. He made his MLB debut with Kansas City in 2004 and went on to play in parts of nine seasons with five different teams.

WALK ME LIKE A HURRI-CANADIAN: The C's lead the High-A West with 175 walks this year.

PRAISE BE: Vancouver is a perfect 5-0 on Sundays this season.

ON 'EM EARLY: The C's have outscored the Tribe 12-1 in the first inning this week and are 14-3 when drawing first blood this season.

ON THE HILL: Right-hander Paxton Schultz climbs the slope for Vancouver this evening looking to continue his sterling start to 2021 and lead the C's to a series win. In his last turn on June 6 against Eugene, Schultz earned the win with his third consecutive quality start when he tossed six innings in which he allowed one run on two hits with two walks and a season-high nine strikeouts. He's logged 18 innings across his last three turns and has surrendered just one run (0.50 ERA) on seven hits with four walks and 22 strikeouts in that span. Despite his recent success, today could be a text for the Orem, UT native; he faced Spokane on May 16 and gave up season highs in hits (5) and runs (3) through four innings pitched. Schultz, 23, was the Player To Be Named Later in the Toronto/Milwaukee deal that sent big leaguer Derek Fisher to the Brewers. He played collegiately at Utah Valley before the Brewers selected him in the 14th round of the 2019 draft.

#7 Rockies prospect (MLB.com) Helcris [hel-cree] Olivarez goes for Spokane in what will be his second start of the series. In game one on Tuesday night, the southpaw took the loss after allowing a season-high seven runs on six hits (also a season high) in four innings pitched. Olivarez, 20, is 0-2 against Vancouver this year and has allowed eleven runs on 12 hits through nine innings of work. His finest outing of the season came on June 2 against Tri-City, when he limited the Dust Devils to one run on two hits with two walks and seven strikeouts. He's from San Francisco De Macoris, DR.
