Friday: Spearheaded by strong pitching performances from Alex Valverde, Joe Zanghi and Manny Alvarez, the Binghamton Rumble Ponies defeated the Reading Fightin Phils 3-1 at FirstEnergy Stadium on Friday night. Binghamton has now taken three out of the first four games of the series. Ponies starter Alex Valverde pitched five and two thirds scoreless innings giving up four hits and four walks while striking out two. Binghamton opened the scoring on a fielder's choice from Jeremy Vasquez, scoring Brandon McIlwain in the fourth and the Ponies grabbed a 1-0 lead. Carlos Cortes added two more runs in the fifth on an opposite field homer and Binghamton increased its lead to 3-0. Reading scored its lone run of the night in the seventh on a long home run from Carlos De La Cruz over the scoreboard in left centerfield which made it a 3-1 ballgame.

Strong Pitching Effort: In back-to-back nights, the Ponies pitchers kept the Reading bats in check. Alex Valverde, Joe Zanghi and Manny Alvarez gave up just six total hits on the night. Valverde went five and two thirds scoreless innings giving up four hits. Joe Zanghi and Manny Alvarez pitched the final three and a third innings as Zanghi gave up a hit and a run with one walk and three strikeouts. Alvarez closed the game out with a six out save giving up a hit while striking out three.

Packing a Punch: Ronny Mauricio and Carlos Cortes have been hot as of late with both players holding eight-game hit streaks. Mauricio has five multi-hit games with a homerun and five RBI with an OPS of .851 during the current stretch. He also has a hit in 11 of his last 12 games. Cortes has four multi-hit games, two homers and seven RBI with a staggering 1.183 OPS. Like Mauricio, he too has a hit in 11 of his last 12 games.

Double Play Show: During Friday's game, the Ponies turned four double plays. Three of the 4-6-3 variety and one 1-6-3. The biggest double play of the night came in the second as Alex Valverde was able to get Herbert Iser to hit a grounder to Wyatt Young then Mauricio completed the play to get out of a bases loaded jam.

Coming Up: The Ponies will conclude their 12-game road trip against Reading. Sunday's finale is set for 5:15 PM. Tony Dibrell will get the start on the mound for Binghamton.

Reid Brignac - Manager - 1st season with Binghamton - 3rd year in the Mets organization. Brignac comes to Binghamton after serving as the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021. He appeared in parts of nine years in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

Jerome Williams - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - Williams also held the same position on Brignac's staff with St. Lucie and is entering his fourth season in the Mets organization following a 20-year playing career. He pitched for 11 years in the major leagues with the Giants, Angels, Cubs, Cardinals, Rangers, Phillies, Nationals and Astros compiling a 52-66 record with a 4.59 ERA in 236 career games.

Tommy Joseph - Hitting Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Joseph joins Brignac and Williams in being promoted from the same position in St. Lucie to Double-A Binghamton. He is entering his second season with the Mets organization after retiring from his playing career following the 2020 season. He spent two seasons in the major leagues with the Phillies in 2016-17 hitting .247 with 43 home runs and 116 RBI in 249 major league games.

Mariano Duncan - Bench Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - arrives in the Southern Tier after serving as the bench coach for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) in 2020. He is entering his fourth year in the Mets organization. The former infielder played 12 major league seasons with the Dodgers, Reds, Phillies, Yankees, and Blue Jays. He was a member of two World Series champions (1990 Cincinnati Reds, 1996 New York Yankees) and was inducted into the Dominican Republic Baseball Hall of Fame in 2008.
