### FROM THE CROWS NEST

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Bradenton Marauders dropped both games of a doubleheader on Saturday night to the Tampa Tarpons. The Tarpons walked-off the Marauders 2-1 in 10-innings in game one, a continuation of a suspended contest before shutting out the Marauders 7-0 in seven-innings in game two. **Shalin Polanco** plated the lone run of the day, a game-tying solo-home run in the ninth inning. **Hunter Stratton** tossed a scoreless inning on Major League rehab.

**ESCAPING THE ROAD:** On Sunday, the Bradenton Marauders look to snap their eight-game road losing streak at George M. Steinbrenner Field. Since dropping three straight in Clearwater from June 28-30, the Marauders hold just a .155 batting average with a team ERA of 4.11. The .155 average is the lowest road average in Single-A during this time frame and have scored just 11 runs in eight games during this losing skid. On the year, Bradenton owns the worst road win% in Minor League Baseball at .244.

**BLANKED:** The Bradenton Marauders were shutout for the fourth time this season after falling 7-0 in a shortened seven-inning affair on Saturday. Bradenton was held without a run last Saturday in a 1-0 defeat in 10-innings by the Jupiter Hammerheads with the Tarpons also blanking Bradenton on May 15 4-0.

**NO MORE DELAYS:** Between Friday and Saturday night, the Marauders and Tarpons have sat through a combined 4 hours and 11 minutes of lightning and rain delays.

**TWO FOR ONE SPECIAL:** After last night's contests was suspended in the fifth inning, Bradenton and Tampa will play two today at George M. Steinbrenner Field. It's the second suspended game Bradenton will pick up the next day, having done so on June 13 in Dunedin in another scoreless game in the sixth inning. The Marauders ended up scoring six runs in the seventh to shut out the Blue Jays 6-0.

**THROUGH THICK AND THIN:** Marauders C/INF Garret Forrester was activated off the 7-day injured list before Friday's contest. Last year's 3rd round pick by the Pirates has been on the injured list since May 11. Forrester was on rehab with the FCL Pirates over their last seven games.

**YOUTH MOVEMENT:** Among players in Minor League Baseball this season aged 19 years old or younger, no player has more home runs than **Axiel Plaz**, who hit his 12th home run of the season last Friday night against Jupiter. Plaz holds the third-highest SLG (.533) among players 20 years old or younger as well. Current New York Yankees slugger Giancarlo Stanton holds the record for most HR hit in a season as a teen when he mashed 39 in 2008 as a member of the Greensboro Grasshoppers in the South Atlantic League (now the current Pirates High-A affiliate).

**HOME RUNS SHOULD COME IN PAIRS:** Esmerlyn Valdez hit his second multi-home run game of the season on Wednesday. Last season, Termarr Johnson and Rodolfo Nolasco each recorded a pair of multi-home run games. There has never been a three-home run game by a Marauder in franchise history.

**BOMBS AWAY:** Since May 1st, the Bradenton Marauders have clubbed 67 home runs in 67 games which is the most by any team in Single-A. Bradenton led Single-A with 31 longballs in the month of June and were just three shy of tying their franchise record. In July, Bradenton has 16 in their first 14 games with Axiel Plaz accounting for five of the 10. Esmerlyn Valdez has three as well. The 16 home runs are the third-most in Single-A this month, trailing the Inland Empire 66ers who have 22.

**PROSPECTS, PROSPECTS, PROSPECTS:** With the graduation of 2023 Marauder Paul Skenes from the prospect ranks, **RHP Kristian Curtis** entered the Top 30 rankings at No. 30. The Bradenton Marauders now hold eight of the Pittsburgh Pirates' Top 30 prospects according to MLB Pipeline, which is the most of any Minor League team in the Pirates system.

**CLOSE QUARTERS:** Saturday's walk-off loss against Tampa marked the Marauders' 32nd one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own an 17-15 record in those games.

**Last Time Out:** Threw a career-high 89 pitches in 5.0 innings against Jupiter last Friday night. Kemp Alderman drove in five of the six runs allowed by Oliver, beginning with a two-RBI double in the first two score two walks issued. An RBI double by Shane Sasaki in the third before Alderman clubbed a three-run home run to centerfield to give Jupiter a 6-3 lead at the halfway mark.

- Tied career-high with six strikeouts in four innings @ Tampa (5/19)
- Had a 10.2 scoreless innings streak snapped on 5/12 vs St. Lucie
