CARDS RIDE EXTRA-BASE JUICE TO WIN OVER HOOKS: The Cardinals collected a season-high 7 extra base hits and got 4.2 scoreless innings from their bullpen as Springfield defeated the Corpus Christi Hooks 3-2 on Thursday night at Hammons Field. RJ Yeager hit a go-ahead solo homer for the Cards in the 6th inning to extend his hitting streak to 8 games and provide the final margin. Tommy Edman had two hits including a double in his 6th rehab game with Springfield and Matt Lloyd added a pair of doubles. Jacob Buchberger and Noah Mendlinger also drove in runs for Springfield as part of a two-run 4th inning.



**DPPOSING STARTER:** Right-hander **James Hicks** takes the ball for the Hooks making his 3rd start (5th appearance) this season for Corpus Christi... Took the loss in his last start allowing 5 ER on 4 H with 4 BB and a strikeout in 4.0 IP at home against Midland... Promoted to Corpus Christi in late June after making 9 appearances (5 starts) at High-A Asheville where he went 3-2 with a 3.63 ERA striking out 38 while walking just 9 in 39.2 IP... Began the season at Low-A Fayetteville where he allowed just 1 ER on 9 H with 25 K over 18.0 IP... Selected by the Astros in the 13th round of the 2023 draft out of South Carolina... Went 8-1 as a senior with the Gamecocks in 2023 with a 3.48 ERA, and opponents batted juist .234 against him... Selected by the Orioles in the 15th round after his junior season in 2022 but decided to return to school... Played two seasons at Crowder College in Neosho, MO in 2020 & 21...In 2021 helped Crowder College to a #3 ranking in NJCAA... First-team all-state as senior at Conway (AR) HS...23 years old

**CARDS HOST HODKS IN FINAL REGULAR-SEASON MATCHUP:** The Cardinals return to Hammons Field for a six-game series and their final regular season matchup with the Corpus Christi Hooks (Double-A, Houston Astros). Springfield won four of six against the Hooks at Whataburger Field in June, including a postseason-clinching win in the series finale on the final day of the first half on June 23.



#### **CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD**

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

HOME SWEET HOME: After struggling for a stretch and even after Wednesday night's loss, the Cardinals have turned things around at Hammons Field of late. Springfield is 10-3 over its last 13 games at home, lifting its home record to 24-25 (.489). The recent home hot stretch follows a down period over which the Birds dropped 11 of 12 had saw their home record drop to 14-22, at that point the worst home record in the Texas League.

Away from home, the Birds are 28-16 (.636) away from Hammons Field this season, the best road winning percentage in the Texas League. Springfield's road ERA sits at 3.72 which is good for 3rd-best in the Texas League behind Frisco and Midland. The Cards' ERA at Hammons Field this season is 5.53.

**POWER SURGE:** While the Cardinals have hovered near the bottom of the Texas League in home runs this season, the Birds have flexed their power muscles of late. Over its last 19 games since June 30 Springfield has clubbed 22 homers, tied for 2nd with Corpus Christi for in the circuit during that time behind only Midland (26). The Cardinals sport a SLG of .449 and .802 OPS during that time and have homered in 12 of their last 14 games. For the season the Cardinals are 8th in the Texas League with 64 homers.

EDMAN RETURNS TO HAMMONS FIELD: Rehabbing wrist and ankle injuies, Cardinals utilityman Tommy Edman returns to the Ozarks for his 2nd rehab stint with Springfield. Edman played in 4 games against Wichita going into the All-Star Break and went 4-for-14. The Stanford product has not played in the big leagues yet this season after offseason wrist surgery. The 2021 gold-glover at 2B signed a 2-year, \$16.5 million deal in January.

CROOKS CATCHING FIRE: Over his last 19 games dating back to June 23, Cardinals catcher Jimmy Crooks has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. During that time the former Oklahoma Sooner is 2nd in the league among gualified hitters with a .352 average while adding 5 HR and 16 RBIs with 3 doubles and a triple. Crooks during that stretch is slugging .634 and has a 1.071 OPS. Among active, qualifited Texas League hitters in 2024, Crooks' .869 OPS and .405 OBP tops in the circuit.

ANTICO NEARING MILESTONES: Cardinals OF Mike Antico is inching toward a pair of career milestones. Antico's next steal will give him 150 for his career, and with his 2-run shot on Tuesday is just 3 homers shy of 50 career bombs. Over his last 10 games, Antico is batting .351 with 2 HR, 7 RBIs and is 3-for-3 in SB.

SPRINGFIELD'S HOME RUN KING...: With his 3-run homer in the bottom of the 5th inning on Friday night, Chandler Redmond etched his name atop yet another Springfield Cardinal career category. Redmond's 60th home run in a Springfield uniform moved him past Xavier Scruggs (2010-13) on the alltime franchise list, giving him the most homers in franchise history. Redmond's historic blast came off Wichita right-hander John Stankoweicz. For good measure, Redmond added another three-run shot on Saturday night off Cory Lewis, giving him home runs in back-to-back games after not leaving the yard in his past 47 contests.

Redmond also holds the Springfield franchise record for RBIs with 225.

...IS HEATING UP: After breaking the record, Redmond has continued swinging a hot bat. During a current 6-game hitting streak, the Cardinals slugger is 12-for-23 with 2 2B, 2 HR and 8 RBI In 11 games in July, he is batting .395 (15-for-41) with a team-high 1.044 OPS.

YEAGER BOMBS: With home runs in back-to-back games, Cardinals INF RJ Yeager has regained his power stroke and run his hitting streak to 8 straight games, batting .306 with 2 2B, 3 HR and 7 RBIs since July 10. Yeager hit a team-high 5 homers in April before hitting just 2 longballs in May and June

**SLAM THE DOOR:** Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights-out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. Svanson is a perfect 16-for-16 and his 16 saves lead all of Double-A.

So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 12.0 IP (0.69 ERA) and is 6-for-6 in save opportunities.
