**DFFENSE STALLS AS CARDS FALL TO HODKS 4-2:** The Corpus Christi Hooks scored 3 times in the bottom of the 4th inning and Springfield managed just 2 hits from the 5th inning on as the Cardinals dropped game four this week at Whataburger Field 4-2 on Friday night. **Bryan Torres** had 3 hits for Springfield and **Jeremy Rivas** added 2 knocks, accounting for 5 of the Cardinals' 6 hits. Springfield's struggles with runners in scoring position continued as the Cards went just 1-for-8 and are now 4-for-28 in the series in those situations and have left 32 runners on base.



**DPPOSING STARTER:** Right-hander **Aaron Brown** makes his 8th start (12th appearance) of the season for Corpus Christi...Last pitched on Sunday, June 23 at San Antonio and took the loss allowing 4 ER on a season-high 11 H over 5.0 IP...Over 3 starts in June is 1-1 with a 6.60 ERA...Spent all of last season with the Hooks and went 5-2 with a 4.30 ERA over 26 apperances (14 starts)...Pitched on August 24 at Hammons Field against the Cardinals and surrendered 6 ER on 6 H (2 HR) over just 2.0 IP...First full season came with High-A Fayetteville where he went 4-9 with a 5.28 ERA in 25 appearances (14 starts)... Selected by the Astros in the 9th round of the 2021 draft out of Middle Tennessee...Went 7-5 with a 3.99 ERA in with 3 complete games 14 starts in his final season at MTSU...113 K was the 6th most in a single season for a Blue Raiders pitcher...Played his freshman season at Vanderbilt in 2018 and spent the 2019 season at the State College of Florida...25 years old

**CARDINALS VISIT CORPUS CHRISTI TO CONCLUDE FIRST HALF:** The Cardinals make their only trip to the Gulf of Texas this season for their first of two matchups with the Corpus Christi Hooks (Double-A, Houston Astros). The Cards have not visited Corpus Christi since 2022 when they lost 4 of 6. In the only series between the two clubs in 2024, the Cardinals went 4-2 at Hammons Field from August 22-27.

### **CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD**



The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

## CARDS' RADIO HOME

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals! **FIRST HALF PENNANT RACE:** With just 2 games to play, the Cardinals are in desparation mode in the race for the North Division 1st half title. Spring-field is in 2nd place in the North Division, 1.5 games back of the Arkansas Travelers, who have a magic number of just 1 to clinch a postseason berth, meaning any combination of a Travs win or Cardinal loss will eliminate the Birds from the 1st half race. The Cards' last 1st half title came in 2016 when they went 41-29 and won the division by 3.5 games over Tulsa. Springfield won the 2nd half title last season and lost in the Division Series to the Travelers.

**CARDS MAKE FRANCHISE HISTORY:** In game one of their doubleheader on Thursday night at Whataburger Field in Corpus Christi, the **Cooper Hjerpe** and **Andrew Marrero** combined to throw the first no-hitter in Springfield Cardinals history in a 5-0 (7 innings) win over the Hooks. The Cardinals carried a no-hitter through 7 innings in the season opener on April 5 against Arkansas in a 6-1 win. Cardinals history dates back to 2005 when the franchise moved to Springfield from El Paso.

**HOME vs ROAD:** For a majority of the 2024 season, the Cardinals have had much more success on the road than at Hammons Field. After winning their first 8 games of the season at home, the Cardinals have dropped 18 of their last 23 games at Hammons Field, a stretch that includes a franchise record-tying 8-game home skid. Overall the Cardinals are 13-18 with a team ERA of 6.05 at home.

Road games, however, have been a much different story. The Cardinals are 22-14, the 2nd-best road record in the league, with a 3.77 ERA which is the 3rd best in the Texas League and tops in the North Division.

**GRINDIN':** Despite striking out a season-high 15 times on Friday night in Corpous Christi, simply put, the Cardinals don't strike out very much. The Cards have struck out the 2nd-fewest times in all of full-season Minor League Baseball with 476 whiffs in 66 games. The only team with fewer strikeouts than Springfield is the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (451 K in 67 games). The Cards are averaging just 7.1 K's per game.

**POWER OUTAGE:** While the Cardinals are at the top of the Texas League in several important categories, such as batting average, hits, and OBP, the Cardinals have had a difficult time generating extra base juice. Springfield has 131 extra base hits this season, fewest in the Texas League. The San Antonio have the 2nd-fewest with 139 total. Despite having the most hits in the league, the Cardinals are 8th in SLG at .357 and 6th in OPS (.706) despite having the highest OBP. Springfield has the fewest doubles (90) and HR (33) in 2024. Over their last 11 games the Cards have just 11 extra base hits, and have hit just 8 HR since May 18 (31 games) and 2 HR over their last 22. The last time the Cardinals hit more than one HR in a game was May 21 when **Matt Lloyd** and **Nathan Church** both went deep in a 7-6 win over the Tulsa Drillers. Over their first 36 games the Cards hit 25 homers, good for 7th in the league.

The Cardinals are on pace to hit 68 home runs, which would be the fewest in the Texas League since the 2015 Arkansas Travelers who hit 60. Springfield has also allowed 72 longballs, 2nd most in the league behind Amarillo (74).

**BIG INNINGS COSTLY:** Big innings have proven to be an issue for the Cardinals' pitching staff this season. The Cards have surrendered 48 innings of 3+ runs. All together, "big innings" have accounted for 189 of the 350 runs Springfield has allowed this season (54%). The Cardinals are 26-6 in games while they don't allow a "big inning", and 9-26 when their opponent scores 3+ runs in an inning.

**REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY:** With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 215.

Since tying the record, however,  $\ensuremath{\textbf{Redmond}}$  has gone 35 straight games without a home run.
