The Frisco RoughRiders downed the Arkansas Travelers 2-1 on Thursday from Dickey-Stephens Park. With the game scoreless into the fourth inning, the Riders (14-22, 52-52) found the scoreboard when lan Moller laced an RBI single up the middle, scoring Luis Mieses. David Davaillo burned through the Travelers (19-17, 54-51) in his start for the Riders, not allowing a hit through 4.0 innings while striking out six and walking two. The score remained 1-0 until the seventh, when Travs catcher Nick Raposo grounded an RBI single through the left side to tie the game at 1-1. In the top of the eighth, Frisco took the decisive lead on a pickoff attempt throwing error, allowing Aaron Zavala to score from third to make it 2-1. Larson Kindreich then recorded a six-out save for his second save of the season in Frisco. Joey Danielson (1-0) took home his first Double-A win on the mound while Nick Davila (1-4) was saddled with the

POP, POP, FIZZ, FIZZ, OH WHAT A RELIEF IT IS:

Frisco's bullpen has struggled this season, but has been great to start August. In six games, the Riders bullpen is second in the Texas League with a 1.86 ERA and they are 3-for-4 in save opportunities.

With the RoughRiders' recent promotions of **Trey Supak** and **Ben Anderson** and the trade of **Mitch Bratt**, Frisco only has one remaining starter from the opening rotation of the year (**Josh Stephan**). Frisco's starting ERA of 4.11 in the second half is third in the Texas League, while it is 3.83 since the start of July, which is also third in the league. In the last nine games, Frisco has a 2.56 ERA for starters which is second in the league.

BROKEN BATS:

For the first time since midseason 2023, the RoughRiders were blanked in back-to-back games on offense on Sunday and Tuesday. Frisco ended their scoreless streak with Aaron Zavala's two-run double in the 10th on Wednesday, stopping the streak at 29 consecutive innings without a run. In the first six games in August, Frisco has scored just nine total runs while hitting .154/.254/.202/.456 at the plate as a team without a home run. On the mound, Frisco is first the league with a 2.00 ERA despite being 3-3.

THE BOYS ARE PICKIN' IT:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on defense this season, owning the best fielding percentage (.982) in the Texas League while committing the fewest errors (67). After committing 20 errors in the first month of the season, Frisco owns a .984 fielding percentage since May 1st, which is the second-best in Double-A.

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

Aaron Zavala walked twice on July 18th, collecting his 207th career walk in a RoughRiders uniform to break the all-time franchise record, previously held by **Guilder Rodriguez**. Making it much more impressive, Zavala accomplished the feat in 312 games with a 15.1 percent walk rate over four seasons (2022-2025) while Rodriguez needed 524 RoughRiders games from 2009-2015 and a 9.8 percent walk rate.

HOLD ME CLOSE AND DON'T LET GO:

In their last 23 games, the RoughRiders have had the lead or a tie game in the eighth inning in 16 of the 23 games, but they are 10-13. The Riders have blown seven saves during that span. Their bullpen ERA of 4.99 in July is last in all of Double-A and while they allowed 54 earned runs, they also surrendered 12 unearned runs.

CAULEY! CAULEY, CAULEY ANYTIME:

Cam Cauley has been solid for the RoughRiders on offense in 2025. In his last 71 games since May 7th, he is batting .266/.329/.449/.778 with 20 doubles, eight home runs, 29 RBIs and 17 stolen bases. In his last 35 games, he is slashing .276/.329/.476/.805 with 10 doubles, five home runs, 18 RBIs, 23 runs scored and 10 steals. In his first five games in August, he is just hitting .056 (1-for-18).

WALLY'S WORLD:

Rangers top prospect Sebastian Walcott has showed off incredible consistency this season. In April, he hit .244 with a .766 OPS, in May, produced a .257 average and .811 OPS, but struggled with extra-base hits in June, hitting .239, but just a .640 OPS. This season, his walk rate of 12.0 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.4 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 34 steals over 124 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22). Walcott participated in the Futures Game for the second season in a row over the All-Star Break, going 0-for-1 with a sacrifice fly and a groundout to shortstop while playing third base defensively.
