TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a six-game road series at Pensacola on Friday. These two teams split the first series of the season 3-3 at Trustmark Park. The M-Braves lead the 2022 season-series 5-4. They will play a total of 30 times, with 18 games at Trustmark Park and 12 games at Blue Wahoos Stadium.
VINES SHINES AGAIN: Darius Vines earned his third win last night in the 13-9 win over the Blue Wahoos. His eight strikeouts over 5.0 innings places him alone in first place in the Southern League with 58 on the season. He also passes teammate Jared Shuster with 46.1 innings pitched, also leading the league.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP: Every M-Braves batter recorded a hit, and scored a run Thursday night, logging a season-high 13 runs, and six doubles in the 13-9 win. The Braves scored six runs in the sixth, and four runs in the eighth, while staving off a seven-run ninth inning by Pensacola. Michael Harris II reached base four times while going 2 -for- 4 with two RBI. The outfielder ranks fifth in the Southern League with 31 RBI. Andrew Moritz went 2-for-4 with two doubles and three runs scored, extending his hitting streak to six games.
BABA $O^{\prime}$ RILEY: Infielder Riley Delgado is riding an 11-game hitting streak and has propelled himself into 3rd in the Southern League with a . 340 batting average and 6th with a .402 OBP. The streak is the team's third longest this season (Waddell, $12 / \mathrm{M}$. Harris, 15), and he is hitting .462 with six RBI and eight runs in that stretch
DOUBLE THE FUN: The M-Braves lead the league, are T-2nd in Double-A baseball, and T-4th in MiLB with 84 doubles this season. The 53 doubles in May are T-1st in Double-A baseball, and T-2nd in all of minor league baseball, just one behind Salem. Michael Harris leads the Southern League, and ranks T-4th in MiLB with 15 doubles.

EVERYBODY LOVES MIKE: The Atlanta Braves' top prospect OF Michael Harris II has reached base safely in 40 of 42 M -Braves games. The 21 -year-old had his minor-league best 31-game on-base streak snapped on Saturday, May 14 in Chattanooga. In the first 31 games of the season, Harris II reached base safely - the only Double-A player to do so and one of two in minor league baseball, (Esteury Ruiz, SAM). The 21-year-old has played in all 41 Mississippi Braves games this season.

- Harris II had his 15-game hit streak come to an end on May 11, which began on April 23. He recorded hits in 10 straight games to start the season - just one of three players in minor league baseball to do so.
- On May 18, Harris II momentarily defied gravity on a diving catch in left center to save two potential runs from scoring. The play made No. 5 on Sportscenter's Top 10.

He ranks among the Southern League leaders in doubles (15, 1st), hits (51, 2nd), XBH (22, 3rd), runs (4th, 31), total bases ( $85,3 \mathrm{rd}$ ), RBI ( 31,5 th), stolen bases ( 11, T- 6 th) , and triples ( $2, ~ \mathrm{~T}-4$ th).
THE SLUGBAUER HAS POWER: 1B Drew Lugbauer is T-7th in the Southern League with nine home runs, including a 431-foot blast to the top of the Farm Bureau Grill in right field on May 3. His ninth homer came on May 21, which was 18 days after his eighth. He is top ten in XBH (21, T-4th), walks ( 25,4 th ), doubles (12, 6th) and runs scored (30,5th).

THE COMEBACK KIDS: In Tuesday's series opener, the M-Braves won their fifth game when trailing after six innings. The five wins are one win shy of last season's total in 111 games, and the three wins when trailing after eight have exceeded last year's total of two. On May 18, the M-Braves overcame a two-run deficit with four runs in the seventh inning to win 6-4. On May 19, the M-Braves trailed 4-0 before scoring five runs in the seventh and four runs in the eighth to win 9-4. On May 21, Biloxi led 2-0 before five unanswered in what ultimately ended in a $5-4$ win for the M -Braves.

MILLER TIME: INF Jalen Miller recorded his first four-hit game on May 10 at Chattanooga, logging a pair of doubles. In 14 games in May, the Atlanta native is batting .327 with three home runs, six doubles, nine walks, 15 RBI, 12 runs, and a . 426 OBP. In his third career game in left field, Miller made an incredible running catch on the wall of the left field bullpen to save multiple runs on Friday, May 20.
ALEXANDER THE GREAT: INF CJ Alexander recorded his third career multi-homer game on Friday, May 13, at Chattanooga, matching an M-Braves record with six RBI. It was the first six-RBI game for a Mississippi hitter since Jaime Pedroza had six RBI at Huntsville on August 2, 2013. He has all four of his home runs and 11 RBI in May.

MAESE SAVES THE DAY: After logging a save in Pensacola on Tuesday, RHP Justin Maese leads the Southern League, and is 2 nd in Double going 8 -for- 8 in save chances this season. He posts 29 strikeouts to just four walks in 18.1 innings. He's also T-1st in appearances with 17.

LUUUUUUUUUUUKE: INF Luke Waddell had his 12-game hit streak snapped on Sunday, May 15 and his 15-game on-base streak snapped on Friday, May 20. He has hits in 20 of his last 24 games and 20 RBI in his last 25 games. Over the on-base streak, Wadell hit . 386 with two homers, five doubles 15 RBI, 12 walks and . 500 OBP. He is ninth in the Southern League with 24 RBI and 10th with 38 hits.
THE M-BRAVES WENT TO JARED: M-Braves starter LHP Jared Shuster has a 2.14 ERA with 43 strikeouts to 10 walks. The 2020 first-round pick is second the Southern League in innings pitched (42.0), WHIP (0.86), and batting average against (.174) while ranking top five in ERA (2.14, 2nd), and strikeouts (43, T-4th).
