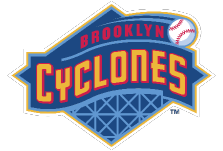

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** In a nail-biter of a game, the Brooklyn Cyclones outlasted Wilmington 7-6 in 12 innings to take a two games to one series lead. Fighting back from an early 3-0 deficit, INF **William Lugo** demolished his first High-A home run, giving Brooklyn a 5-4 lead in the top of the fifth. The lead held until two outs in the bottom of the ninth when Wilmington 3B **Jose Sanchez** doubled in a run against Brooklyn RHP **Dylan Hall** to tie the game 5-5. After trading zeros in the 10th and one run each in the 11th, C **Jose Mena's** RBI groundout in the top of the 12th gave the 'Clones a 7-6 lead and RHP **Daison Acosta** stranded the bases loaded in the bottom of the inning to earn the victory.

**DIVISION ON THE LINE:** Including today, the Cyclones have 27 games remaining and five series: three more at Wilmington, six vs. Hudson Valley, six at Jersey Shore, six vs. Wilmington, and six at Winston-Salem. Brooklyn is vying for a playoff spot with a second half division title in the North Division of the South Atlantic League, sitting a 1/2-game head of Hudson Valley for first place.

**FEELING BLUE:** Brooklyn has won just eight of 18 games against Wilmington this season with a run differential of -15. The Cyclones have only fared worse against Aberdeen (5-13) this season but in those games, Brooklyn has been outscored by 15.

**MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN:** The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league in the second half and overall. Brooklyn ranks first in the North Division with a +26 run differential head of Hudson Valley's +23. The Cyclones have allowed just 142 runs over 39 games (3.6 runs/game) in the second half. The next-closest team is Hudson Valley, allowing 4.1 runs per game in the second half.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** OF **Alex Ramirez** and OF **Stanley Consuegra** have done big damage away from Maimonides Park this summer. At home, the pair

have combined to hit just 28-139 (.201) with 12 doubles, a triple, and two home runs. On the road, the two have combined to hit 30-97 (.309) with four doubles, one triple, and six home runs.

**PEROZA PRODUCING:** Since July 9, INF **Jose Peroza** has a OPS of .820 over his past 25 games with a 12-game on-base streak. The Mets No. 29 prospect has been on base in 23 of the past 25 games, hitting .286 with a .380 OBP.

**RA-RA RAMIREZ:** No. 4 Mets prospect OF **Alex Ramirez** is ranks second behind Triple-A INF **Brett Baty** with 107 hits -- three behind Baty's 110. The 19-year-old Dominican leads the organization with seven triples.

**PROMOTIONS:** C/INF **Nic Gaddis** and OF **Rowley Jordan** were both promoted to Double-A Binghamton on Monday.

**HELP IS ON THE WAY, DEARY:** Three players were promoted from Low-A St. Lucie to High-A Brooklyn ahead of this week in Delaware. No. 25 Mets prospect RHP **Christian Scott**, INF **William Lugo**, and RHP **Jeffrey Colon** have all been added to the roster.

**SUOZZI SWATTING:** OF **Joe Suozzi** has hit three homers over his past 14 games, hitting .320 with a .953 OPS. In the stretch, Suozzi is 16-for-50 with 10 RBIs.

**SINCE JUNE 1:** After struggling to go deep into ballgames in April and May, Santos is now averaging 5.1 innings per start.

**INNINGS EATER:** Santos ranks fourth in the Mets organization with 89.2 innings pitched. Last year, Junior tossed 96 innings as a career high and has the possibility to pass that mark tonight, having gone seven innings twice since July 4.

**HIGH-RANKING MEMBER:** Santos ranks as the top pitching prospect on the staff, ranking No. 16 according to *MLB Pipeline* and No. 17 according to *Baseball America*.

**BREAKOUT:** The 20 year old pitched with Low-A St. Lucie in 2021, tossing 96 innings which doubles the workload he turned in in 2019 (40.2 IP) and 2018 (45). This season marks the second full season assignment for the righty.

**VALUED MEMBER:** Santos signed with the Mets in 2018 for \$275,000 out of Santiago in the Dominican Republic.

**WEIRD START:** Santos struggled in his first start of 2022, lasting just two innings in game one of a doubleheader and 5-1 loss to the Wilmington Blue Rocks on April 9. Santos' clunky start may have been affected by Friday night's postponement. Ready, warming up, and tossing in the outfield minutes before schedule first pitch on Friday, Santos had to shut it down and repeat the process on Saturday after the Cyclones-Blue Rocks game was postponed due to soft infield dirt and "wet grounds."

**OPENING DAY STARTER:** Junior Santos made Brooklyn's Opening Day start in Wilmington, Delaware on Saturday evening. It was Santos' fourth Opening Day and first Opening Day start since 2018 when he pitched for the DSL Mets
