SEVEN-RUN SIXTH SINKS JACKSONVILLE

After five strong innings, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp surrendered seven runs on seven hits in the top of the sixth en route to a 7-1 win for the Durham Bulls Friday night. Locked in a scoreless draw, the Bulls used 11 batters and smacked seven hits, plating seven runs to jump on Jacksonville 7-0. That hole would prove to be too big to dig out of as the Jumbo Shrimp mustered just one run in the bottom of the eighth on a two-out RBI double from **Matt Mervis**.

BULL-Y PULPIT

Jacksonville is a woeful 2-7 against Durham this year, getting outscored by a 68-32 margin. Jumbo Shrimp pitching has really struggled during this run, posting a 6.96 ERA with the Bulls hitting .272/.353/.470/.823 in those 10 games. In comparison, Jacksonville is hitting just .239/.285/.366/.651 against Durham pitching. The Jumbo Shrimp have scored three runs or fewer in six of the 10 games of this season series so far.

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the season opener, Jacksonville has recorded a stolen base in 49 of their last 60 games, with multiple steals in 37 contests. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have eight games with at least five stolen bases, including a club record (2005-present) seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte; Jacksonville notched five stolen bases in a game just twice over the 2022-24 seasons combined. With four stolen bases Thursday night Jumbo Shrimp lead Triple-A and are fifth in the minors with 138 steals.

EXIT (VELOCITY) STRATEGY

Jacksonville's biggest strength in 2025, along with stealing bases, has been its pitching and defense. The club ranks second in Triple-A with a 3.63 ERA, and their 247 runs allowed are the third-fewest at the level. Interestingly, Jacksonville's staff ranks only 20th in Triple-A in strikeouts (519), but their 425 hits allowed are the level's fewest, meaning the club has suppressed quite a few balls put in play. Opponents have mustered an average exit velocity of 87.1 against the Jumbo Shrimp pitching staff, the fourth-lowest such mark in Triple-A.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD

Jacksonville's bullpen went nearly a week between earned runs, yielding three runs in the ninth inning of their May 24 contest against Memphis before a ninth-inning tally on Friday for Gwinnett. Over their last 11 games dating back to May 25, Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have combined to surrender 19 runs, 15 earned, on 33 hits in 48.1 innings for a 2.79 ERA. Jacksonville relievers have combined for 42 strikeouts against 24 walks during this stretch.

WALK IT OUT

Through 61 games thus far in 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp have totaled 223 free passes (3.7 BB/G). **Jakob Marsee** ranks second in walks in the International League (41). Among the 109 qualified players in the circuit, Marsee ranks 11th in walk rate (16.4%). Including Marsee, Jacksonville has six other players scattered among the 111 other qualified players in walk rate in the IL (**Maximo Acosta**, 11.3%; ; **Jacob Berry**, 8.6%; **Troy Johnston**, 7.9%; **Andrew Pinter**, 6.9%).

PITCH PERFECT

Jacksonville's 36 wins in 2025 can be attributed to the strength of their pitching staff. Not only does the staff own the second-best ERA in Triple-A (3.63), they've coupled that with the 11th-fewest strikeouts and tied for the sixth-fewest walks. The low strikeout number isn't necessarily troubling because the staff have thrown the second-fewest pitches per inning (16.24). Meaning, that opposing hitters don't draw a ton of three-ball counts, but they also don't drive up the pitch counts of Jacksonville hurlers. Jumbo Shrimp starters average 4.0 IP per contest and own a Triple-A-best 15.80 pitches per inning. In addition, the bullpen averages 4.2 IP per game and is second in Triple-A in pitches/inning (16.60) behind Durham (16.33).

SHRIMP BITES

Of the 369 pitchers in the IL with a minimum 10 IP, Jacksonville has five pitchers in the top 100 of runners left on base percentage. **Valente Bellozo** (20th, 87.5%; **Christian Roa** 40th, 84.0%; **Adam Mazur** 50th, 83.0%; **John Rooney** 51th, 82.8% and **Eury Pérez** 76th, 79.4%). **Brian Navarreto's** stolen base on Thursday was his first stolen base since 2022 where he tallied one stolen base for the Nashville Sounds.

ABOUT FREDDY

-A two-way player at Riverview High School (Fla.), Tarnok went 7-0 with a 0.66 ERA while also batting .393. He was selected by the Braves in the third round, signing with Atlanta to bypass a commitment to the University of Tampa.

-Tarnok made his major league debut for the Braves on August 17, 2022, pitching 0.2 scoreless innings in a 9-7 loss to the New York Mets in Atlanta. His first big league strikeout came at the expense of Tyler Naquin.

-On December 12, 2022, the Oakland Athletics acquired Tarnok from the Braves in a three-team trade in which the Atlanta Braves received Sean Murphy, the Milwaukee Brewers acquired William Contreras, Joel Payamps, and Justin Yeager, and the Athletics also acquired Manny Piña, Kyle Muller, Esteury Ruiz, and Royber Salinas.

-The Philadelphia Phillies claimed Tarnok off waivers on June 1, 2024. Following the 2024 season, he signed a minor league contract with the Miami Marlins.

-In seven starts, Tarnok was 0-2 with a 3.65 ERA (12.1 IP, 13 H, 3 BB, 15 K, .283 BAA). However, over 16 relief appearances, he posted an 0-3 record and 9.78 ERA (19.1 IP, 21 H, 17 BB, 21 K, .280 BAA).

2023 SEASON

-Tarnok held left-handed batters to a .192/.276/.269/.545 line in 58 plate appearances compared to a .184/.333/.447/.780 line for right-handed hitters over 93 plate appearances.

-Tarnok's parents are Jeff and Neung. He has a brother, Christopher, and a half-brother, Nick. Through his mother, Freddy is of Thai descent.
