THIS IS FUN: After winning a season-best seven games in a row, including the first four of this split series with the Delmarva Shorebirds, the FredNats play their 11th game in a row tonight against Delmarva having already won their third straight series. FXBG has relied on dominant starting pitching and clutch hitting in this recent stretch which has been the best of the season. Tonight, RHP Travis Sthele goes for his second win in a row after he beat the Salem Red Sox last week allowing just one earned run in five innings. He faces lefty Juan Rojas, who has not faced the FredNats this year.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The FredNats got two homers in the first three innings from John McHenry, and got another strong start from Marc Davis to cruise to a 7-2 win on the 4th of July. McHenry hit a leadoff homer in the first, and then smacked one off the right field foul pole in the 3rd for a two-run shot. Davis pitched five innings of one-run ball with four strikeouts, and the FredNat bullpen allowed just one run in the final four innings to cruise to their 7th straight win.

UTTER DOMINATION: The FredNats have totally and completely dominated the season series with the Delmarva Shorebirds through the first 13 matchups. Fredericksburg is 12-1 against Delmarva, outscoring the Shorebirds 81-32. FredNat pitching has a 2.01 ERA this year against the 'Birds as well. The FredNats have not hit for much power this year against Delmarva, clubbing just five home runs in the 13 games, but FXBG has been nearly perfect on the base paths, going 41-for-45 stealing bases against Delmarva. Brandon Pimentel has 18 RBIs this year against the Shorebirds as well, hitting .320 with an .831 OPS.

LEADING OFF FOR AMERICA: John McHenry's leadoff homer last night was the first time all season the FredNats got a leadoff bomb, and his multi-homer game was the second of the year for FXBG, the first one coming less than a week ago during this current winning streak last Saturday in Salem. On the 4th of July last year in Delmarva, McHenry drove in the go-ahead run in the 8th inning.

DOMINANT ARMS: After heavily relying on the bullpen for the first two months of the season, the FredNat starting rotation has majorly improved over the last three series. Since June 11, FredNat starters have logged 102 2/3 innings and allowed just 19 earned runs for a group ERA of 1.67. In the three weeks prior to that, the starting rotation's ERA was 5.70. In this series alone, FredNat starting pitching has allowed just five hits and two runs in 19 innings against Delmarva.

THIRTY FIVE AND OH: The FredNats remain perfect when leading after seven innings this season, with last night's win getting them to 35-0 when leading after seven, and also a perfect 37-0 when leading after eight innings. The winning formula all season has been the offense taking a lead in the middle innings, and the bullpen holding onto that lead each time.

OH SYKORA: After making his professional debut on May 1 with Fredericksburg, 2023 Nationals third round pick Travis Sykora has taken the Carolina League by storm in the first two months of his professional career. Including last night, he's pitched five complete innings in each of his last four starts, and has allowed just four runs in that time frame with 33 strikeouts and seven walks, and he set his new career-high with nine punchouts in last night's start.

FORMULA FOR SUCCESS: The FredNats are 34-5 this season when scoring first, including 30 out of the last 31 wins. FXBG did not score first in any of its losses the last two weeks, but did score first in each of the four wins last week in Salem, plus every game of this series so far.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 186-154 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI).

TODAY'S START: Travis Sthele makes his 12th start of the year this evening, against the Delmarva Shorebirds. A 12th round pick by the Nats in 2023, Sthele joined the FredNat rotation late in the 2023 campaign. Sthele has been mainly a starter, but has worked in the piggyback role twice in the last month.

A YEAR AGO: Sthele took his lumps after joining Fredericksburg last season. He posted a 7.36 ERA over four starts, to go along with a 1.82 WHIP. Travis struck out six hitters over 11.0 IP but showcased strong command, walking just three men.

HOOK 'EM: Travis spent two years at the University of Texas, working mainly as a relief pitcher. 23 of his 36 appearances came out of the Longhorns bullpen, where he worked to a 5.85 ERA across 95.1 innings of work. Sthele 98 batters in that span, while opponents hit just .265 against the righty.

AGAINST THE 'BIRDS: Sthele has started twice against the Shorebirds this year, with differing results. His first outing was solid, as he allowed three earned runs over five frames. But in his second start, Sthele blanked Delmarva through five innings, and walked just one man.

LAST TIME OUT: Sthele enjoyed one of his best starts of the season last week against Salem. Travis completed five frames for the first time in June, and allowed just one earned run (two total) on four base hits.
