The Round Rock Express and Oklahoma City Baseball Club get set for a Friday night showdown at Dell Diamond. Express RHP Jack Leiter is slated to start against Baseball Club RHP Nabil Crismatt in game four of the six-game series. First pitch is scheduled for 7:15 p.m.

NOT OUR NIGHT

The Express saw their three-game winning streak snapped yesterday as the Baseball Club took home a 4-2 win. Round Rock struck first with one run in the first inning. CF Derek Hill singled, found third base as LF Trevor Hauver singled and scored when DH Elier Hernandez hit into a double play. Oklahoma City made it a 2-1 game in the third when 2B Jonathan Araúz scored on a single from SS Trey Sweeney and a RF Ryan Ward sacrifice fly. The Baseball Club extended the lead to 3-1 in the fourth as Araúz scored on a single from CF Andy Pages. In the bottom of the sixth, Express C Sam Huff drove home Hill on a single to make it a 3-2 game. Oklahoma City increased its lead to 4-2 when C Hunter Feduccia scored on a single from Hoese in the eighth inning as the score stood final.

LEIT THEM UP

Express RHP Jack Leiter takes the mound in his third appearance and second start of the year. Leiter is 1-0 with a 3.24 ERA (3 ER/8.1 IP) with three walks and 15 strikeouts. Opponents are hitting .167 against Leiter. The right-hander was the second overall pick in the 2021 MLB Draft.

HILL ON THE HUNT FOR HITS

Express CF Derek Hill finished 2-for-4 with a double and a run scored yesterday. In his last three games, Hill is 7-for-11 with a double, RBI, four runs scored and a walk. He hasn't struck out in his last five games and is slashing .419/.486/.613/.1099 in his first nine games this year.

ALL HE DOES IS WINN

Round Rock RHP Cole Winn threw a scoreless inning yesterday with two strikeouts. Winn has not allowed a run in three of his first four outings this year and he has at least two strikeouts in each of his outings. Yesterday, Winn needed only 11 pitches to work through the ninth inning. He threw four fastballs with each one clocking in at 96.3 mph or higher. He threw his two hardest fastballs of the season last night at 97.7 and 97.8 mph.

ALL ABOARD THE .300 CLUB

Of the nine players who have appeared in at least nine games this year for the Express, eight of the nine have a batting average of .314 or better. Express OF Sandro Fabian leads the group with a .429 (15-35) batting average. Round Rock leads the Pacific Coast League and is tied for second in all of Triple-A with a .305 batting average (123-403) to start the season.

SHEDDING SOME MORE LEIT

Express starter RHP Jack Leiter was put on the Development List with Double-A Frisco from July 15-August 27 last year. Since he returned from that trip to the Development List, the righty has made seven appearances with six starts and has issued only nine walks in 28.0 innings. He issued 43 walks in his previous 65.1 innings before his trip to the Development List.

LIMITING THE STRIKEOUTS

Round Rock's offense struck out only seven times yesterday. The Express have struck out less than 10 times in 10 of 12 games this year and are averaging just 7.7 strikeouts per game.

ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.

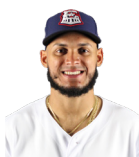
