NOTES AND NUGGETS

SEASON 56

Omaha began the 56th season in franchise history Friday against the I-Cubs at Principal Park in Des Moines, Iowa ... this is the 14th season in the Storm Chasers era.

- Omaha is coming off a 2024 campaign in which they went 89-59 (.601 winning percentage) to finish 1st in the 20-team International League during the regular season, before going on to win the International League Championship Series.
- The 2024 Chasers set a franchise wins record for wins in a season, passing the 86-win 1990 Omaha Royals that won the Triple-A Classic (national championship).

WE ARE THE CHAMPIONS

Omaha enters 2024 as the defending champions of the International League.

- Winners of the 1st half (49-24 record), Omaha hosted the 2nd-half Champion Columbus Clippers (Cleveland Triple-A affiliate) in the International League Championship Series ... after dropping Game 1 to Columbus 3-2, Omaha came back to win Game 2 in 11 innings, 5-4, before winning Game 3 by a score of 7-3.
- 2024 marked Omaha's 8th league championship as a Triple-A Club, having won 4 American Association titles (1969, 1970, 1978, 1990), 3 Pacific Coast League championships (2011, 2013, 2014) and now an International League title ... Omaha is the first club to win a league championship in 3 different Triple-A leagues.

BE LIKE MIKE

Manager **Mike Jirschele** returns in 2025 for his 17th season managing the Triple-A Omaha franchise, in the 3rd year of his 3rd stint with the club, with an all-time record of 1153-1156 in Omaha ... this is his 34th season in the Royals organization.

- In 2024, "Jirschele" was named the International League Manager of the Year, his first such award with Omaha, leading the IL Champs to a league-best 89-59 record in the regular season, setting a franchise record with 89 wins.
- Jirschele previously led the Triple-A Omaha club from 1995 to 1997 and 2003 through 2013, winning the PCL league title in 2011 and a Triple-A National Championship in 2013 ... he was Kansas City's 3rd Base Coach from 2014 to 2019.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

Across the first three games of the season, the Storm Chasers have stolen 9 bases, the second-most steals of any Triple-A team, trailing Jacksonville (11).

- Omaha has gone 9-for-9 on the basepaths, the only Triple-A team with more than 4 steals without being caught thus far.
- On Friday night, Omaha stole 5 bases, before adding three more in Saturday's win ... there was only one time last year the Chasers stole more than 4 bases in a game, when the team swiped 7 on September 15 vs. Toledo.

THAT'S A RELIEF

On Saturday, four Omaha relievers combined for 6.0 scoreless innings, allowing just 3 hits and 1 walk in the process.

- Last year, Omaha had three games where the bullpen combined for 6.0 innings or more of scoreless relief ... ironically, one of those games was exactly a year ago, on Opening Night ... on March 29, 2024 vs. Iowa, Omaha relievers combined for 6.0 scoreless innings, with 2 hits and 2 walks.

IT'S TOLY TIME

Yesterday, Storm Chasers utility player **Tyler Tolbert** had his contract selected by the Royals, and went on to make his Major League debut Monday afternoon.

- Tolbert joined the Royals in Milwaukee for their series opener against the Brewers and entered the game Monday as a pinch-hitter for Michael Massey in the eighth inning, struck out and finished the game in center field.
- He is the 337th player in franchise history that has made their MLB debut after playing for the Triple-A Omaha club ... RHP **Noah Murodock** was the 336th when he made his debut on Saturday with the Athletics, tossing 1.2 scoreless innings.

PITCH, PLEASE!

Omaha starting pitcher **Luinder Avila** opened yesterday's Home Opener with 4.0 perfect innings and carried a shutout into the 6th inning, while striking out 11.

- Prior to yesterday, Avila's career-high for strikeouts in a game was 9, a total he had accomplished twice.
- Avila is the first Chasers pitcher to strike out more than 10 batters in a game since **Jakob Junis** punched out 12 on May 26, 2017 @ Nashville ... since that 12-strikeout game, 12 Omaha pitchers have struck out 10 opposing hitters, but none have made it past 10 ... today's starter, **Noah Cameron**, had a pair of 10-strikeout games for Omaha last season: July 31 @ Rochester and August 31 vs. St. Paul.
- Since 2010, Avila is the 10th Omaha pitcher to strike out 10+ hitters in less than 6.0 innings ... he is the first to do so since **Onelki Garcia** struck out 10 over 5.2 innings on July 20, 2017 vs. Colorado Springs.

NOAH CAMERON SCOUTING REPORT

MLB Pipeline

Scouting grades: Fastball: 50 | Curveball: 55 | Changeup: 60 | Cutter: 50 | Control: 55 | Overall: 50

Somewhat of a local product from nearby St. Joseph, Mo., Cameron was selected by his favorite team in the seventh round of the 2021 Draft out of Central Arkansas. He had undergone Tommy John surgery that year, so his pro debut was delayed until 2022. The lefty has had a steady progression through the Minors since, and 2024 was his best year yet, when he put together a 3.08 ERA across 25 starts (128 2/3 innings) between Double-A and Triple-A. His run in Triple-A nearly had him in the big leagues by year's end, with a 2.32 ERA in nine starts, a 1.01 WHIP and 62 strikeouts to just 11 walks in 54 1/3 innings.

What stands out about Cameron is his command. He's a strikethrower, and he doesn't walk batters: He had just a 6.7% walk rate in the Minors in '24. There was an uptick in his fastball, averaging 92 mph but with flashes of the mid-to-upper 90s. Although it can be susceptible to hard contact at times, it also grades better because of its command and how well it plays with his other pitches. Cameron's bread and butter pitch is his plus changeup, a low-80s offering that tumbles and misses a ton of bats. He mixes in a plus upper-70s curveball that has a tight break and tunnels well with his fastball. He also brought back an upper-80s cutter, an effective pitch that helps his fastball play better by adding another dimension for the hitter to think about. Cameron is beginning to tinker with a slider too, potentially giving him a fourth pitch. With a clean over-the-top delivery, Cameron understands how to use his pitches -- and how they play off each other -- to keep hitters off balance.

Cameron's mix, in addition to his command and makeup give him a starter's projection, and now he's on the cusp of Kansas City as one. The Royals added him to the 40-man roster last November and see him as a future part of their rotation. Cameron will likely return to Triple-A aiming for more sustained success with his debut coming at some point this year.

Baseball America

Scouting Grades: Fastball: 50 | Curveball: 55 | Changeup: 60 | Cutter: 50 | Control: 55

Track Record: Cameron continues to defy projections that say he doesn't have enough power on his fastball to consistently retire more advanced hitters. He has maintained his advance through the Royals' system without hitting that imaginary wall. The Missouri native, who missed his junior season at Central Arkansas to Tommy John surgery, has performed consistently well at every level since first getting into minor league games in 2022, one year after being drafted in the seventh round. His nine starts at Triple-A Omaha to end 2024 represents the best run of his career, with a 2.32 ERA and 62 strikeouts to just 11 walks in 54.1 innings.

Scouting Report: A finesse lefthander with a sneaky four-seam fastball averaging 92 mph, Cameron excels because of the deceptive life on the pitch and its good vertical carry, helping to compensate for lower velocity. He added an extra tick of zip in 2024 and now touches 96 mph, and he may still have more in the tank. Cameron's best secondary pitch is a plus low-80s changeup with good vertical separation off his fastball. It's a deceptive pitch with big tumble, depth and command. Cameron has good feel for an above-average 78-83 mph curveball with 11-to-5 shape and tight break that he throws for strikes and tunnels well with the fastball. His fourth pitch is an 88-91 mph cutter with average horizontal movement. Cameron gets swings and misses from both his changeup and curve, and he's a savvy hurler who mixes his pitches well. His arm action and repeatable over-the-top delivery work well.

The Future: Cameron's next big test will be to see if he can repeat the success he had in Triple-A, leading to a determination on if he's got enough stuff to face big league hitters. The Royals added him to the 40-man roster in November, and he could make his MLB debut in 2025.

2024

- ▶ Started 26 games between Omaha and Northwest Arkansas (AA), including 1 postseason start for Omaha ... opened the year at Double-A and made 17 starts for the Naturals before being promoted to Triple-A July 28, ending the season in Omaha.
- ▶ Led Royals minor league pitchers with 149 strikeouts and had the 3rd-best ERA (3.08) ... ranked 2nd in innings (128.2) and tied 2nd in starts (25) ... 5th among qualified arms in the system in WHIP (1.21) and 6th in opponents' average (.243).
- ▶ Threw 9 quality starts: 2 for NW Arkansas (AA) and 7 with Omaha (AAA) ... 6 of 7 quality starts with Omaha came in his first 6 starts at the Triple-A level (July 31 to August 31) ... over those 6 starts, went 2-1 with a 1.64 ERA (7 ER in 38.1 IP).
- ▶ In Triple-A debut July 31 @ Rochester (WSH), pitched into the 7th inning with 1 run, 0 walks and 10 strikeouts.
- ▶ Compiled a streak of 29.1 inning without issuing a walk, between July 11 (3rd inning) and August 13 (3rd inning) ... streak spanned parts of 6 starts (last 3 in AA and first 3 in AAA).
- ▶ Named International League Pitcher of the Month for August, going 2-1 with a 1.71 ERA (6 ER in 31.2 IP) and 36 strikeouts in 5 starts (all quality starts), in his first full month in Triple-A.

2023

- ▶ Split the season between Quad Cities (A+) and NW Arkansas (AA) and combined to go 5-12 over 24 starts between the two levels, with a 5.28 ERA (63 ER in 107.1 IP).
- ▶ Ranked 3rd among Royals Minor League pitchers in strikeouts and tied 4th in starts ... among those in the system with at least 100.0 innings, ranked 1st in K/9 (11.07) and K/BB (3.77).
- ▶ In High-A, walked just 9 to 58 strikeouts (6.44 K/BB), but after being promoted to Double-A on May 19, walked 26 compared to 74 strikeouts (2.85 K/BB) with NWA.
- ▶ In his Double-A debut on May 24 at Tulsa (LAD), threw a career-high 7.0 shutout innings with 3 hits and 6 strikeouts ... lost his next seven starts, between May 30 and July 20.

2022

- ▶ Made his professional debut and largely split the season between Columbia (A) and Quad Cities (A+), with a rehab stint with the ACL Royals (R) as well ... between the three levels, combined to go 2-3 across 19 starts, with a 3.56 ERA (26 ER in 65.2 IP) with 16 walks to 99 strikeouts (6.19 K/BB).
- ▶ Named a Royals MiLB.com Organization All-Star as a left-handed starting pitcher ... among Royals Minor League pitchers with at least 60.0 innings, ranked 1st in K/9 (13.57), K/BB and K% (36.7%).
- ▶ In High-A debut on May 22 @ Dayton (CIN), set a career-high with 12 strikeouts over 4.0 innings, around 3 hits.

2021

- ▶ Did not pitch professionally in the months after being drafted by the Royals (or during the college season), after undergoing Tommy John surgery in August 2020.

COLLEGE (UNIVERSITY OF CENTRAL ARKANSAS, 2019-2021)

- ▶ Pitched two seasons at Central Arkansas, combined for a 2.86 ERA (39 ER in 122.2 IP) with 122 strikeouts in 18 starts for the Bears (Southland Conference) ... named a Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball in 2019.
- ▶ Made 3 starts for the Northwest League's Willmar Stingers during the summer of 2020 then underwent Tommy John surgery in August 2020, keeping him out of action in 2021.
