LAST GAME OUT

(MOOSIC, PA - May 26) -TThe Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders lost to the Syracuse Mets 10-2 on Sunday afternoon at PNC Field. SWB scored late to avoid the shutout but could not overcome Syracuse's six-run third inning.

The RailRiders gave up an early run in the top of the first. Luisangel Acuña and Carlos Cortes led off the game with consecutive singles. With runners on the corners, Rylan Bannon scored Acuña on a sacrifice fly to give the Mets a 1-0 lead.

Syracuse batted through the order to take a seven-run lead in the top of the third. Acuña and Cortes worked back-to-back walks to open the inning. Bannon drove a homer to right field, giving the Mets a 4-0 advantage. After Ji-Man Choi and Mike Brosseau singled, Rhylan Thomas doubled to score Choi for a five-run Syracuse lead. Two more runs scored when Hayden Senger singled into right field, making it 7-0.

SWB put one on the board in the bottom of the seventh. After Jeter Downs was hit by a pitch and Brandon Lockridge worked a walk, Carlos Narvaez singled to load the bases. A Jose Rojas's sacrifice fly scored Downs to end Syracuse's shut-out bid.

In the top of the eighth, Cortes hit a 3-run 413-foot blast to right-center field to make it 10-1 Syracuse.

Luis Torrens answered in the bottom of the frame with a solo shot to right field for the RailRiders second run of the game.

#7 Yankees prospect, Will Warren, (L,3-4) pitched 3.0 innings, allowing seven runs on eight hits. Jose Butto (W,2-1) tossed 5.0 scoreless innings of two-hit ball to earn the victory.

NEWS & NOTES

SECOND PLACE: With a loss on Sunday, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders fall two and a half games behind the the Omaha Storm Chasers for second place in the International League. Omaha has played three less games this season and will only make up one of them. Toledo is five and a half games out behind the RailRiders.

AGAINST TOLEDO: The Yankees and Tigers Triple-A affiliates do not meet up often although they are both in the International League. The last time they faced off was in 2019 with three scheduled at each park. The RailRiders lead 160-141 games in all time match-ups. SWB bussed 468 miles from Moosic to Toledo on Monday for the six-game set.

BRANDON'S BEST: Brandon Lockridge made his professional debut at second base on Sunday. He has placed all three outfield positions in his time in the Yankees farm system. Lockridge was a second baseman at Troy University during his freshman and sophomore years where he made over 100 infield starts. In his junior year, he moved solely into center field. Lockridge looked sharp as a middle infielder, helping nab a runner stealing and recording four putouts. The righty also had a good week at the plate, appearing in six contests for a .429 average with three runs batted in.

ROAD WARRIORS: The RailRiders are 20-7 on the road this season, accounting for over half of their wins. The team has had two road series sweeps, one each against Norfolk and Jacksonville. SWB has knocked in 32 of their 50 homers outside of PNC Field.

THE M'S HAVE IT: SWB has five relievers with last names that begin with 'M' whom are all having solid seasons. Ron Marinaccio holds a 0.82 earned run average in eleven innings with 11 strikeouts. Alex Mauricio has been a fantastic edition in his first Triple-A season. As a longer reliever, he has made 13 appearances for 24 frames. He has a pair of wins with a 1.13 ERA and just eight walks to 26 strikeouts. Anthony Misiewicz has made 17 appearances for a 1.99 ERA. He has three saves and just seven free passes to 26 strikeouts. Oddanier Mosqueda leads the entire farm system with 19 outings. In his 24.1 innings, the lefty has four wins for a 3.40 ERA.

NIFTY FIFTY: Luis Torrens smacked the RailRiders 50th home run of the season on Sunday. Everson Pereira leads the team with ten, while Jose Rojas is not far behind with nine of his own. Thirteen players have scorched at least one this season. SWB has recorded 32 long balls on the road and 18 at PNC Field. There are only five teams in Triple-A with less homers than the RailRiders.

MAN ON THE RUN- The RailRiders added three more steals last night to lead the International League with 80 on the season. Brandon Lockridge leads all active players with 17, while Caleb Durbin has 20 but is currently on the Injured List. Fifteen players have at least one. The team is second overall in Triple-A baseball to Tacoma who has 108 steals

GROWING UP: A Hawaii native, Barclay grew up in Hilo and attended St. Joseph High School, which did not have a baseball program, instead playing in his local PONY league.

NESTOR COMPARISONS: Has drawn comparisons to Yankees All-Star LHP Nestor Cortes for his pitching style, which features funky leg kicks and spontaneous changes in his delivery and timing.

COLLEGE JOURNEY: Pitched one season each at Central Arizona College (2017), Gateway Community College (AZ, 2018) and Cal State-Bakersfield (2019). Was a 3x Western Athletic Conference Pitcher of the Week in his season at Cal State-Bakersfield, where he led the WAC with 111 strikeouts and also led the Roadrunners in shutouts (2) and complete games (2) en route to being named 2019 Academic All-WAC.

CAREER:

- **2023:** Began the season on the injured list and was activated on 5/30 with Double-A Somerset going 3-1 with a 1.32 ERA - all eleven appearances were out of the bullpen (34.0IP, 51K, 11BB)...Promoted to Triple-A SWB on 08/01 where he completed ten starts for a 5.89 ERA (44.1IP, 49K, 33BB)...Tied career-high eight strikeouts in a game twice during the season
- **2022:** Pitched to a 1.74 ERA in 67.1 IP for High-A Hudson Valley with 86 K. Made four starts and 24 relief appearances, while holding opponents to a .177 AVG without yielding a home run all season.
