THE LAST TIME OUT: Altoona first baseman Mason Martin knocked his tenth, eleventh, and twelfth home runs of the season over two games of a doubleheader at Dunkin' Donuts Park. However, the Curve were unable to overcome the Yard Goats in a Hartford sweep, 7-5, 2-1, on Saturday night. Willie MacIver hit three home runs in game one of the doubleheader to lead the Goats to victory. Altoona managed just one hit in game two, the solo shot by Martin in the 5th inning, falling, 2-1.

TODAY'S GAME: The Curve go for a series victory after being swept in a doubleheader yesterday.

WELL THAT'S NEW: The Curve's 11-2 loss to Harrisburg on Sunday was their largest margin of defeat this season. Prior to Sunday's game they hadn't lost a game by more than 4 runs all season.

LOVE TO SEE IT: 2021 Curve RHP Max Kranick made his major league debut on Sunday for the Pitsburgh Pirates becoming the 173rd player in franchise history to reach MLB after playing for the Curve. Kranick sat down all 15 batters he faced before a 1:04 rain delay chased the team's from the field in St. Louis. He recorded the first debut start in MLB history that ended with five or moré perfect innings since 1893, per the Elias Sports Bureau. Kranick batted in the first inning béfore he took the mound, making him the second starting pitcher in Pirates history to hit before he threw the first pitch of his MLB debut. Paul Maholm did the same on Aug. 30, 2005, in Milwaukee.

THE FUTURE: Curve RHP Roansy Contreras has been named to the National League roster for SiriusXM Futures Game taking place on Sunday, July 11 at 3:00 p.m. at Coors Field in Denver, CO. Contreras is the 20th player in franchise history to be selected from the active roster to the game, first since Ke'Bryan Hayes in 2018. Contreras along with Greensboro RHP Quinn Priester give the Pirates two participants in the game for the first time since 2012 when Gerrit Cole and Jameson Taillon

LET'S PLAYOFF: Major League Baseball announced on Wednesday that all leagues at Double-A, High-A and Low-A will play postseason baseball. The top two teams in each league as determined by win percentage, regardless of division, will play a best-of-five series beginning on Tuesday, September 21 playing two games at the #2 seed with an off-day slated for Thursday, September 23 then the series finishing at the #1 seed.

THAT BALL IS FLYING: Cal Mitchell recorded his first career multi-home run game on Thursday night at Hartford. His tworun shot in the third inning gave Altoona a 5-2 lead and his solo shot to lead off the fifth inning was one of three homers hit by the Curve in the inning. The Curve hit 3 home runs in the 5th inning, matching the franchise record for most home runs in an inning. Mitchell, Oneil Cruz and Rodolfo Castro each homered in the inning.

THAT BALL IS STILL FLYING: Mason Martin swatted three home runs across Saturday's doubleheader at Hartford, jumping him into the team lead with 12 on the season. He is tied for 3rd in the Double-A Northeast League and has the 2nd highest total among Pirates minor leaguers behind Aaron Schakleford of Greensboro who has hit 13.

THE YARD GOATS: Hartford is managed by former Major League infielder and Connecticut native, Chris Denorfia. Denorfia, who grew up in Southington, came to the Rockies organization after spending the 2019 season with the Chicago Cubs as Quality Assurance Coach. Denorfia played 10 years in the Major Leagues with Cincinnati (2005-06), Oakland (2008-09), San Diego (2010-14), Seattle (2014) and the Cubs (2015). The former outfielder finished his playing career in the Rockies system at Triple-A Albuquerque in 2017. After his playing career, Denorfia joined the Cubs front office as a Special Assistant to the President/GM in 2018. The Yard Goats have three players on the Rockies 40-man MLB Roster (LHP Yoan Aybar, RHP Tommy Dayle and INE Fleburic Monters). Dovle and INF Elehuris Montero).

FOR ALTOONA: RHP Brad Cast makes his first start of the season. Case has worked out of the bullpen this season after spending the 2019 season as a starter with Single-A Greensboro...For more on Case, see page three.

FOR HARTFORD: RHP Nate Harris will make the spot start for Hartford today. The 26-year-old hails from San Antonio, TX and played his college ball at Louisiana Tech, he was picked in the 21st round in 2017 by the Rockies. Harris has made 5 career starts in 103 appearances as a Rockies minor leaguer, he holds a career record of 7-8 with a 4.73 ERA. A starter in college, Harris was named one of 25 finalists for the Golden Spikes Award after he was named the 2017 Conference USA Pitcher of the Year, he was one of six finalists that played for a non-power five school.

Miguel Perez was named the 12th manager in franchise history after Dave Turgeon was tabbed to lead the team for the 2020 season.

Perez is the first former Curve to serve as the team's Manager and enters his 14th season as a member of the Pirates organization in 2021. Perez served as the Curve's Third Base Coach in 2015 under Manager Tom Prince and played 92 games for the Curve combined between the 2008, 2009, 2012, and 2013 seasons,batting .271 with four home runs and 36 RBI. Perez made two appearances for the Cincinnati Reds as a 21-year-old in September of 2005, going 0-for-3 with a strikeout. Perez also spent time with Akron Aeros (44 games in 2010, batted .280), and the Harrisburg Senators (3 games in 2011, went 0-for-9)

Drew Benes Pitching Coach

1st season 5th overall

Drew Benes was slated to be the Pitching Coach for a second consecutive season with the Bradenton Mauraders in 2020 before the COVID-19 pandemic.

Born in Evansville, IN, Drew is the son of former Born in Evansville, IN, Drew is the son of former major league pitcher Andy Benes and the nephew of former big leaguer Alan Benes and minor leaguer Adam Benes. Originally selected as a third baseman by the Cincinnati Reds in the 47th round of the 2007 draft, but did not sign, Benes converted to the mound when at Arkansas State University. Benes was selected by the St. Louis Cardinals in the 35th round of the 2010 draft and spent three seasons in their system accumulating a 9-11 record with a 4.57 ERA in 66 appearances.

David Newhan Hitting Coach

1st season 10th overall

Newhan comes to the Curve for his first year in the Pirates organization and 10th season as a coach in professional baseball. He managed the Double-A Mobile BayBears during their final season and spent the previous two years as the Infield Coordinator for the Los Angeles Angels. Newhan's coaching career started in 2011 as a hitting coach in the Padres system. His first managing experience came in the Athletics organization in 2014. In 2015-16, he was on the Detroit Tigers' major league coaching staff as the Assistant Hitting Coach. Newhan played parts of eight seasons in the big leagues and 14 seasons overall as an infielder and outfielder with the Padres (1999-2000), Phillies (2000-01), Orioles (2004-06), Mets (2007) and Astros (2008).

Gary Green Bench Coach

1st season 16th overall

Gary Green is in his first season with the Curve and 16th season as a minor league instructor for the Pirates. He has served as the Minor League Infield Coordinator/Roving Infield Instructor for the Pirates since the 2011 season and joins an affiliate coaching staff for the first time since 2010. staff for the first time since 2010.

Green was selected 27th overall by the San Diego Padres in the 1984 amateur draft and earned a silver medal for Team USA in the '84 Olympics in Los Angeles. He batted .222 with nine doubles and 11 RBI in 106 major league games across four seasons with the Padres, Rangers and Reds. Green spent 11 seasons as a manager in the Pirates and Detroit Tigers organizations, amassing a 588-713 record (.488).
