LAST OUTING: Hall went 1.1 innings, allowing one hit, zero earned runs, two walks and had one strikeout. It was his fourth rehab appearance with the Sounds.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Hall has faced Jacksonville a whopping eight times (five in 2022, three in 2023). Four of the his eighth appearances have been starts and he holds a 3-2 overall record against the Jumbo Shrimp. His most recent appearances against Jacksonville came on August 11, 2023 where he allowed two earned runs across 1.2 innings in a loss. He set his career-high in strikeouts with 14 on July 6, 2022.
