SUNDAY: The Amarillo Sod Poodles (18-15, 54-47) defeated the San Antonio Missions (14-19, 45-57), 7-6, in 10 innings on Sunday afternoon at HODGETOWN. Jake Cunningham and Braedon Karpathios hit back-to-back solo home runs in the first to put the Missions up 2-0. The Soddies responded with a **Ben McLaughlin** RBI double and a **Drew Jones** sac fly. Jones collected another sac fly in the third. Luis Verdugo's sac fly for the Missions in the fourth tied the game. Amarillo went back in front in the fifth, utilizing a **Junior Franco** Little League home run that brought home three runs for the Soddies. Brendan Durfee hit a sac fly before a two-out RBI single by Tirso Ornelas made it a one-run game in the seventh. Down to their last strike, Ornelas drove in the tying run. In the 10th, Jones singled up the middle to walk off the Missions, 7-6.

EXTRA! EXTRA! After back-to-back extra innings games to close out the homestand, Amarillo has played 15 extra innings games this year, the most they have played in a single season in franchise history...their 10 wins in extras this year is a club record for most in a season, having passed the previous mark of 7 wins in extras (2022) on 6/24 vs. Frisco.

LAWLAR AND ORDER: Expected to begin a MLB rehab assignment with the Sod Poodles this evening is **Jordan Lawlar**...the former Soddie is coming back from a right hamstring strain and has played 111 games in an Amarillo uniform in his career, including a 2023 season in which he slashed .263/.366/.474 with 23 doubles, 3 triples, 15 homers, and 48 RBI...he made his MLB debut with the Diamondbacks on September 7, 2023 at the Chicago Cubs...has 54 MLB games under his belt, slashing .207/.289/.296 for his career.

DEADLINE DEALIN': The Arizona Diamondbacks swung a trade just before the 6:00 pm ET deadline on Monday evening with the St. Louis Cardinals in which the D-backs received OF Lars Nootbaar in exchange for a pair of Soddies pitchers, RHP Daniel Eagen (ARI no. 5) and Sandro Santana (ARI no. 26)

KEEPING UP WITH THE JONESES: Coming through with the walk-off single in the 10th inning Sunday was **Drew Jones**...he collected 3 RBI Sunday, using two sacrifice flies earlier in the afternoon which made him only the third Sod Poodle with multiple sac flies in a game in club history...since June 17, the outfielder is batting .372 (29x78) with an .865 OPS at home...Jones extended his team lead in stolen bases this season to 25 on Sunday, the 5th-most stolen bases in a single season by a Sod Poodle in franchise history.

LUIS YOURSELF: Since July 26, **Jansel Luis** is batting .281 (9x32) with 7 runs, 3 doubles, and 2 RBI...he leads Soddies this season in hits (96) which currently ranks 8th overall in the Texas League...he is pacing for 130 knocks by the end of the year which would rank as the 6th-most in a single season in Soddies history.

PITCH PERFECT: Since July 1, the Amarillo pitching staff ranks 2nd in the Texas League in ERA (4.03) behind Corpus Christi (4.02)...tonight's starter **Junior Sanchez** has logged the 6th-most IP (26.0) in the league over that span.

SETTING THE BAR-RIGA: Alberto Barriga has scored 6 runs in his most recent 6 games (7/26-c) and is riding an active 6-game hit streak where he is batting .348 (8x23) with an .814 OPS...with a two-out RBI double in the ninth Saturday night, he joined **Ben McLaughlin** (4/16 vs. FRI) as the only Soddies this season with a game-tying RBI when down to their final out.

DOWN IN THE DESERT: Jose Cabrera was named PCL Pitcher of the Week yesterday following a performance on August 2 where he tossed five shutout innings while allowing only one hit and striking out six Round Rock batters.

SUMMARY

- Signed as international free agent by the Diamondbacks in 2023...inked a \$50,000 bonus at 17 years old.
- Currently ranks No. 25 in Arizona's top-30 prospects list (MLB Pipeline).

LAST TIME OUT

- Sanchez looked on his way to a perfect first inning before Jake Cunningham worked a two-out walk, which set the table for Braedon Karpathios to drive in an extra run when he crushed a first-pitch fastball off the batter's eye for a two-run blast...Sanchez was unable to settle in to his start right away, instead being greeted by the second home run in as many games for Albert Fabian to open the top of the second.
- Sanchez found his groove from the third through fifth innings on just four days rest to complete his longest outing at HODGETOWN in 2026...after the Karpathios home run, only Luis Verdugo reached base against him with his doubles in the second and fourth inning as Sanchez retired 12 of 13 batters faced from Verdugo's first hit until the end of the fifth inning...he returned to the mound for a sixth inning of work, but a wild pitch and sac fly after allowing a single and double chased him from the game with the scoreboard reading 5-8.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME

- Sanchez has now recorded just two more outs on the road compared to his outing at HODGETOWN since his promotion to Double-A with a stark difference in his stats...his 2.18 ERA in four road starts is the fifth-best mark in the Texas League (min. 4 GS).

HILLSBORO REVIEW

- Over nine games (six starts), he went 2-3 with a 2.61 ERA at High-A Hillsboro in 2026.
- Fanned a career-high 10 batters in his first winning decision of the year on April 28 at Vancouver.
- Opened the season with 10.1 consecutive scoreless innings...was broken up by a Walker Martin solo homer to lead off the third inning for the Emeralds in Sanchez's April 22 start at home against Eugene.
- Had 56 strikeouts against 10 walks, good for a 5.60 K/BB rate, ranking 4th in the NWL among pitchers with at least 30.0 innings pitched this season at the time of his last game at the level on June 3...that mark increased to a 10.33 K/BB in five away games, the best rate in the NWL among pitchers with at least 20.0 IP on the road as of June 10.
- Was recognized by the Diamondbacks as part of Arizona's monthly minor league awards for April as the best pitcher with High-A Hillsboro...had a 1.96 ERA (4 ER/18.1 IP) in four appearances with an 0.82 WHIP and .156 batting average against...Sanchez struck out 30 batters and walked just five.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Began the year at Single-A Visalia, pitching the first two games of the season out of the bullpen before transitioning to the starting rotation.
- Called up to High-A Hillsboro after the All-Star Break, making his debut for the Hops on July 20 where he allowed three runs on four hits over five innings of work.
- His 2.40 ERA for the year ranked first among Diamondbacks farmhands (min. 100.0 IP) and ranked 10th among MiLB pitchers under the same parameters.

SCOUTING REPORT

- Sits in the low 90's on his four-seam fastball...has cut-ride action on the fastball with enough induced vertical break to stay above bats.
- Strong horizontal break on a mid-80's slider...forces batters to expand the zone.

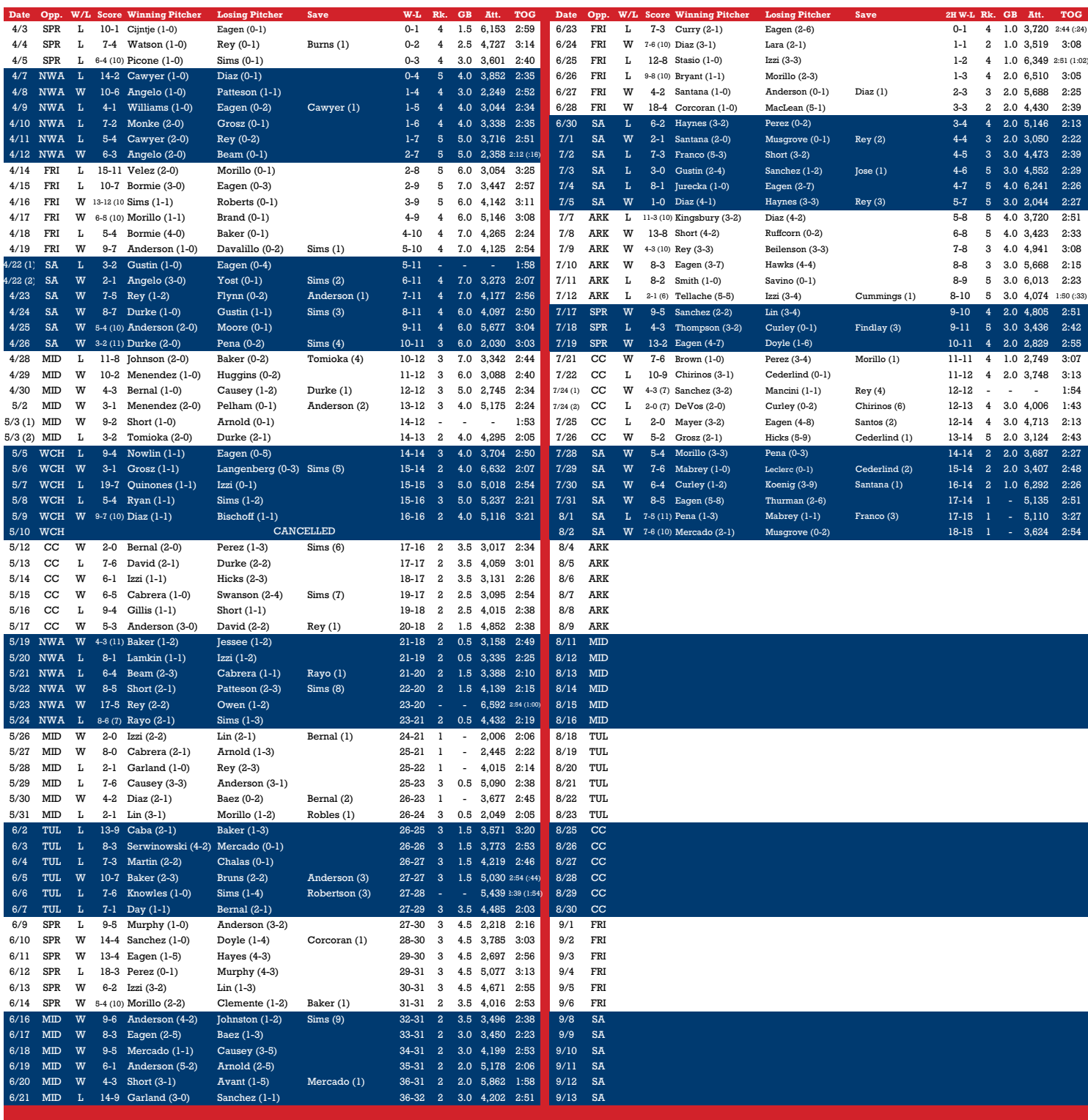
