**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Fightin Phils, 6-5. **Charlie Szykowny** opened the scoring with a solo homer and **Jean Carlos Sió** added a two-run single later in the inning for a 3-0 Richmond lead. Reading closed the score to 3-1 in the fifth with an RBI single by Raider Tello. In the eighth, Bryan Rincon scored on a wild pitch to pull the Fightin Phils within a run. In the top of the eighth, **Jancel Villarroel** hit a solo homer to center, **Jack Payton** hit an RBI single and Sió brought in a run with a groundout to open a 6-2 lead. Reading scored three runs in the ninth to pull within a run before **Ryan Vanderhei** worked a strikeout to end the game. **Greg Farone** set a season high with 10 strikeouts over 5.2 innings to pick up his fifth win of the season.

**POSTSEASON BOUND:** The June 12 win clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division title for the Flying Squirrels, locking in a postseason berth. The Flying Squirrels will play the second-half division champion in the Division Series. Game 1 will be at the home of the second-half champion on Tues., Sept. 15. Game 2 and, if necessary, Game 3 will be at CarMax Park on Thurs., Sept. 17 and Sat., Sept. 18. If Richmond advances to the EL Championship Series, Game 1 will be at CarMax Park on Sun., Sept. 20. This year marks the fifth postseason appearance in franchise history and the first since 2023.

**TODAY'S GAMES:** The Flying Squirrels face the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies, in the second and third of a six-game series. This is the first and only series between the two teams this year. It is also the second of three consecutive home series for Richmond against Northeast Division opponents and the third of three straight series against that division overall. Richmond has split all four doubleheaders it has played this season.

**RECORD YEAR:** The Flying Squirrels' 10-game win streak from April 4-15 was the longest in franchise history, surpassing an eight-game win streak from May 5-13, 2021, also beginning with the second game of the season. The 61-40 record the best in team history through 101 games, ahead of a 60-41 record in 2014. Richmond has won seven series, split eight and lost three so far this year. After opening the season with a 27-7 record through May 13, the Flying Squirrels are 34-33 in their last 67 games since.

**RELENTLESS:** In their 61 wins this year, the Flying Squirrels have come from behind in 29 of them. In 18 of the wins, Richmond has taken the lead in the eighth inning or later. The Flying Squirrels have 10 walk-off wins at CarMax Park this season, including at least one in each home series. **Diego Velasquez** has three walk-off hits this year, all in 10th innings. **Drew Cavanaugh**, **Parks Harber** and **Dayson Croes** each have two walk-off winners this year. Richmond has three wins after trailing by five-or-more runs this season. The Flying Squirrels are batting .284 in the ninth inning this year, which leads the EL and is seventh in MiLB.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** won the Southwest Division first-half title by seven games over second-place Erie and has the Eastern League's best overall record this season. For the year, Richmond leads all 30 Double-A teams in batting average (.269), tied for second in doubles (195), second in sacrifice flies (40) and fourth in hits (906). The team has combined for 105 homers this year, surpassing 11 of the franchise's previous 15 season totals. The Flying Squirrels are on pace to set offensive single-season franchise records for batting average, runs, total bases, doubles, RBIs, stolen bases, OBP, SLG, OPS and sacrifice flies. The Richmond pitching staff has thrown nine shutouts this season, which is the most in the Eastern League and tied for second in Double-A. At 35-16, the Flying Squirrels have the second-best home record in MiLB this season, trailing only High-A Bowling Green (37-12). Richmond's No. 9 batters have combined to hit .334 this year, which leads the minors. The Flying Squirrels have scored 10-or-more runs 11 times this year, tied with 2023 for the most in a season in franchise history.

**THE FIGHTIN PHILS** are leading the Northeast Division second-half standings by a 0.5 games over Portland. They went 30-39 in the first half and finished fifth in the division. Reading's roster features five players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Phillies prospects, including 2B Aaron Escobar (No. 4), RHP Gage Wood (No. 5), SS Carson DeMartini (No. 15), RHP Jean Cabrera (No. 23) and RHP Saul Teran (No. 27). MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospects list features six Reading players, including Wood (No. 1), Escobar (No. 4), RHP Wen-Hui Pan (No. 12), SS Bryan Rincon (No. 14), LHP Mavin Graves (No. 24) and OF Raylin Heredia (No. 28).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Trystan Vrieling** makes his 20th start of the season and the fifth of his career against the Fightin Phils in Game 1. He last pitched last Wednesday in the first game of a doubleheader at Somerset against his former team and allowed three runs over 4.2 innings in a no-decision. In his last five starts since June 30, he is 3-0 with a 3.04 ERA (9 ER/26.2 IP). On June 12, he threw a five-inning, complete-game shutout in a rain-shortened win over the Senators as the Flying Squirrels clinched the first-half title. Last year, he missed the start of the season before joining Double-A Somerset in May. After going 1-2 with a 4.50 ERA in 12 outings, he was traded at the deadline on August 1 to the Giants from the Yankees as part of the deal for reliever Camilo Doval. The trade happened in the middle of a Richmond series at Somerset. In 2024, he made professional debut against the Flying Squirrels on April 7 at TD Bank Ballpark to close opening weekend and threw five scoreless innings, allowing two hits with six strikeouts. Vrieling was selected by the Yankees in the third round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Gonzaga. **For more on Vrieling, see page two.**

Right-hander **Yunior Marte** makes his 11th Double-A start and his first against the Fightin Phils in Game 1. He last pitched last Thursday at Somerset and allowed three runs over five innings with six strikeouts in a loss. In his last three starts since July 17, he has combined for a 2.12 ERA (4 ER/17.0 IP). Marte was promoted from High-A Eugene on June 2, where he went 6-1 with a 3.74 ERA in nine outings (seven starts). With the Emeralds, he led the Northwest League in BAA (.215) and ranked tied for first in wins, third in WHIP (1.22), third in ERA and sixth in innings pitched (43.1). Marte was originally signed by the Kansas City Royals in 2022 as an international free agent. At last year's trade deadline on July 31, Marte was traded from the Royals to the Giants for OF Mike Yastrzemski and finished the season with Low-A Jose. Entering 2026, he was rated by Baseball America as the No. 29 Giants prospect. **For more on Marte, see page three.**

**FOR READING:** Right-hander Luke Russo makes his 17th start of the season and his first against the Flying Squirrels in Game 1. He last pitched last Thursday against Binghamton and allowed one run over four innings in a no-decision. In his previous start on July 23 at Harrisburg, he allowed seven unearned runs in the second innings before being removed with two outs. In the Eastern League this season, Russo is ranked fourth in WHIP (1.31), tied for third in wins (8) and tied for ninth in strikeouts (93). Russo was selected by the Phillies in the 16th round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Eastern Michigan.

Left-hander Adam Seminaris makes his 20th start of the season in Game 2 and the first of his career against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Saturday against Binghamton and allowed a season-high seven runs over three innings in a loss. Seminaris was selected by the Los Angeles Angels in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Long Beach State. He was traded to the Milwaukee Brewers after the 2022 along with two other pitchers for Hunter Renfroe, signed as a free agent with the Seattle Mariners before the 2025 season and signed with the Phillies last offseason. He has pitched parts of five seasons at Double-A with Rocket City, Biloxi, Arkansas and Reading, going 22-31 with a 4.20 ERA in 88 outings (70 starts).

**NICE GOIN', COHEN:** **Trevor Cohen** has picked up multiple hits in eight consecutive games dating back to July 26, batting .500 (19-for-38) with a homer, three doubles, six RBIs and nine stolen bases, raising his Double-A batting average from .212 to .366. Last week in his return to his home state, he hit .486 (14-for-29) in six game and stole eight bases. In the second game of a doubleheader on July 29, he had four steals. Last Friday night, he went 4-for-5 to tie his career high for hits. Cohen hit his first Double-A homer on Saturday, part of a two-hit first inning. He had three hits in the series opener on Wednesday.

**KILEN IT:** In his first 15 Double-A games, **Gavin Kilen** is batting .321 (18-for-56) with seven doubles, a triple and nine RBIs. For the season, he is tied for first among all MiLB hitters with 34 doubles. He is also tied for first among all Giants minor league hitters with 74 RBIs this year. After playing in the All-Star Futures Game in Philadelphia, Kilen was promoted to Double-A on July 17. He has at least one hit in 12 of his 15 games in the Eastern League. Kilen was selected by the Giants last year out of the University of Tennessee with the 13th overall pick in the MLB Draft. He is tied for the third-highest pick in the MLB Draft in Flying Squirrels franchise history with Patrick Bailey (2020) and trailing only Joey Bart (2, 2018) and Hunter Bishop (10, 2019).

**JACK ATTACK:** In his last 37 games since June 5, **Jack Payton** is batting .338 (44-for-130) with two homers, seven doubles, a triple, 17 RBIs, 12 walks and 15 runs scored. He has 12 multi-hit performances in that span, including nine two-hit games and three three-hit games. On Saturday, he hit the first grand slam of the season for the Flying Squirrels and the second of his professional career.

**TOP SKIPPER:** Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 321 wins in his career, which is a franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23, 2025. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship. Of Richmond managers since 1954, Pelfrey is second in wins behind Eddie Haas (1968, 1981-84), who had 351 wins.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** In the Eastern League, **Diego Velasquez** is sixth in batting average (.295) and seventh in OBP (.384). **Charlie Szykowny** is tied for second in triples (4). **Bo Davidson** is tied for third in homers (19) and seventh in SLG (.521). **Parks Harber** is ninth in batting average (.284), eighth in OPS (.879) and 10th in SLG (.510). **Jonah Cox** is first in triples (5) and seventh in stolen bases (27). **Tyler Vogel** is first in saves (13) and tied for eighth in wins (7). **Trystan Vrieling** is first in shutouts (1), tied for first in complete games (1), seventh in ERA (4.22) and fifth in BAA (.238).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Richmond's roster features four players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Dakota Jordan** (No. 8), **Gavin Kilen** (No. 9), **Trevor Cohen** (No. 11) and RHP **Yunior Marte** (No. 23). Jordan is rated as the organization's best athlete. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including Kilen (No. 4), Jordan (No. 5), Cohen (No. 11), **Jancel Villarroel** (No. 25), Marte (No. 27).

### THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

**1954:** The Richmond Virginians beat the Syracuse Chiefs, 11-10, at Parker Field. Allen Barbee hit a two-run homer in the eighth against Jim "The Bear" Owens to pull the score to 10-9. Ed Mierkowicz tied the score with a double in the bottom of the ninth and Damon Phillips on the game with a walk-off single off the left-field fence. **1966:** The Richmond Braves beat the Syracuse Chiefs, 1-0, at Parker Field. With two outs in the bottom of the ninth, Gil Garrido hit a solo homer off Leo Marenette to win the game. Ron Reed threw a complete-game shutout for Richmond. **2016:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Bowie Baysox, 8-2, in the second game of a doubleheader. Steven Dugger singled in his last at-bat to extend his hit to 19 games, a franchise record that still stands today. During the streak, Dugger hit .430.
