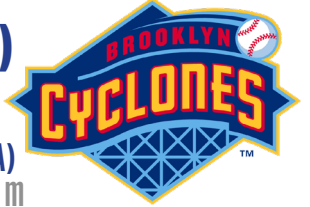

LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones shut out the IronBirds, 2-0, to even the series at two wins apiece on Friday night...RHP **Brandon Sproat** matched a career-best with five innings of one-hit shutout ball, setting a career-high with eight strikeouts...RHP **Jeffrey Colón** tossed 2.2 innings of scoreless relief before RHP **Joey Lancellotti** entered to record the final four outs for the save...Brooklyn came up with the shutout win despite issuing a season-high eight walks...CF **Stanley Consuegra** registered his 100th career RBI for Brooklyn on an RBI double in the first...RF **Douglas Hodo III** collected Aberdeen's only hit on a third-inning single.

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: RHPs **Brandon Sproat**, **Jeffrey Colón**, and **Joey Lancellotti** combined on Brooklyn's second one-hit shutout of the homestand in Friday's 2-0 win vs. Aberdeen...RHPs **Jordan Geber**, **Brett Banks**, and **Justin Lawson** also united on a one-hit shutout of Wilmington in last Friday's 3-0 victory...The one-hitters marked the first time the Cyclones held an opponent to one or fewer hits since May 22, 2022...Brooklyn bested Hudson Valley, 3-1, in Game 2 of a doubleheader...It was the first one-hitter in a nine-inning game since a 6-1 rout vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...RHP **Conner Grey** carried a no-hit bid into the ninth inning that night...Friday's blanking marked the fourth of the season for Brooklyn's pitching staff...The four shutouts are tied for the most in the South Atlantic League and tied for fourth most in all of Minor League Baseball...The Cyclones set a franchise record with 11 shutouts in 2023.

COUNTDOWN TO 1K: After Friday's 2-0 win over Aberdeen, the Brooklyn Cyclones are now five wins shy of their 1,000th in franchise history...Brooklyn holds a record of 995-840 (.542) in 1,835 games since 2001...Brooklyn captured its 900th victory in franchise history with a 6-5 triumph vs. Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's very first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown...Since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021, the Cyclones are 197-209 (.485) in 406 games.

SWIPING THE TOP SPOT: With a pair of stolen bases off the bench on Thursday afternoon, OF **Omar De Los Santos** (52) became the Cyclones' all-time stolen base king, breaking a tie with UT **Jaylen Palmer** (50)...In 2023, the 24-year-old eclipsed INF **Walter Rasquin's** (32) single-season stolen base record with 37 swipes...De Los Santos enters Saturday's contest 15-for-16 stealing bases to start the season...The 15 swipes are tied for second in the South Atlantic League and tied for sixth throughout the minors...Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is tied for sixth across the Minors for steals (122).

THE TONG SONG: RHP **Jonah Tong** joined Brooklyn's roster from Single-A St. Lucie on Monday and punched out seven batters against Aberdeen in his High-A debut on Thursday...In five appearances (three starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old was 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 23.2 IP)...No pitcher in Minor League Baseball has thrown more innings this year without allowing an earned run...Entering play on Saturday, the Markham, Ont. native is second among qualifiers in Minor League Baseball in strikeout rate (.48.9%)...Single-A Lynchburg's LHP **Matt Wilkinson** (50.5%) is first...Tong's 39.8% strikeout-to-walk rate is also second in MiLB to Wilkinson (40.7%)...Tong's 43 strikeouts are good for fourth-most in the minors.

ALL ABOARD THE 7 TRAIN: RHP **Christian Scott** is expected to make his Major League debut for the New York Mets tonight at Tropicana Field against the Tampa Bay Rays...The 24-year-old will become the 99th former Brooklyn Cyclone to appear in the big leagues and the first to debut in 2024...Through five starts this year at Triple-A Syracuse, the Mets' top pitching prospect held a 3-0 record with a 3.20 ERA (9 ER in 25.1 IP) with six walks and 36 strikeouts...Scott spent part of the 2022 and 2023 seasons on Coney Island, making six appearances in each campaign...In 12 outings (11 starts) with the Cyclones, the Florida native accrued a 1-0 record with a 3.00 ERA (15 ER in 45.0 IP) with 14 walks (7.53 BB%) and 52 strikeouts (27.96%).

KING STANLEY: With his RBI double in the bottom of the first inning on Friday, OF **Stanley Consuegra** became the first player in Cyclones history to reach the century mark in RBI...The 23-year-old is Brooklyn's all-time leader in several categories, including 67 extra-base hits, 29 home runs, and 100 RBI...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

NICK THE STICK: INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The Connecticut native reached base three times on Tuesday, adding a pair of extra-base hits and a career-high-tying three RBI...Lorusso is one of two Cyclones with a multi-extra-base hit contest in 2024 and the only one to accomplish the feat on multiple occasions...Coming into Saturday's contest, the 23-year-old is tied for second in the South Atlantic League in triples (2), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (10) and doubles (6), fifth in slugging (.537) and OPS (.925), seventh in batting average (.299), and tied for seventh in RBI (14)...Lorusso trails only Triple-A Syracuse's OF **Ben Gamel** (13) for the most extra-base knocks in the Mets' farm system.

THE WIZARD OF OS: C **Drake Osborn** has been unstoppable at the plate to start the 2024 season...The 25-year-old has collected an eye-popping .381 (16-42) with a 1.038 OPS, adding four doubles, a home run, and four RBI...Among players in the South Atlantic League with at least 50 plate appearances, the Corpus Christi, Texas native leads the circuit in batting average (.381), on-base percentage (.490) and OPS (1.038)...He is also fifth in slugging (.548).

vs. ABERDEEN: Brooklyn continues its first two-week homestand of the season against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...The IronBirds possess six of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** (6), INF **Mac Horvath** (11), RHP **Jackson Baumeister** (18), RHP **Juan Núñez** (26), RHP **Carter Baumler** (28), and C **Creed Willems** (29)...Bradfield Jr. is currently on the 7-day injured list...In 18 meetings during the 2023 campaign, Brooklyn posted a 10-8 record against Aberdeen, including a 7-5 record at Maimonides Park...Since 2002, the Cyclones and IronBirds have met 243 times with Brooklyn leading the all-time series, 128-115 (.527).

FEAR THE HAWK: RHP **Dakota Hawkins** continued his stellar start to his 2024 season on Thursday with four innings of shutout relief...Since one out in the bottom of the eighth on April 19 at Jersey Shore, the 24-year-old has not allowed a run...The 8.2-consecutive scoreless frames is the longest spotless stretch by a Brooklyn reliever this year...Among South Atlantic League relief arms, Hawkins is tied for second in strikeouts (23), fourth in innings pitched (15.2), and fifth in strikeout-to-walk rate (11.50).

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: With his scoreless relief outing on Wednesday night vs. Aberdeen, RHP **Josh Hejka** is now tied with RHP **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...The 27-year-old broke a tie with LHP **Carlos Valdéz** (46) for second place on the all-time list in the contest...In his 47 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.74 ERA (23 ER in 75.2 IP) and three saves, walking just 17 and striking out 68.

LONG ARM OF THE LAW: RHP **Justin Lawson** has started his 2024 with a bang...The reliever yielded just one unearned run over 2.1 innings on Wednesday and notched a three-inning save in last Friday's shutout of Wilmington, good for his fourth of the season (and second that spanned three full innings)...The former member of the N.C. State Wolfpack is third in the circuit in saves (4)...Among South Atlantic League relievers with at least 11.0 innings pitched, the 23-year-old has the lowest WHIP (0.35) and opposing OPS (.188) in the circuit and has permitted the fewest hits (2)...He is also one of three relievers (Greenville's RHPs **Caleb Bolden** and **Jonathan Brand**) in the circuit to throw that many innings and not allow an earned run.

DOOGIE HOWSER: RHP **Douglas Orellana** celebrated his 22nd birthday on Wednesday and continued his impressive pitching to start the year on Tuesday, hurling 4.1 scoreless innings in his first start of 2024, extending his scoreless innings streak to a season-high 91...Orellana began the year with 8.1 consecutive spotless frames out of the bullpen...Last Wednesday in relief, the 21-year-old retired all 15 batters he faced — striking out six — in five shutout innings of relief, earning the hold...Orellana became the first Cyclone since at least 2005 to throw five or more innings out of the bullpen without allowing a hit...RHP **Benito Garcia** (8/12/23 vABD), RHP **Daison Acosta** (6/21/22 vJS), and RHP **Chris Schwinden** (6.0 IP; 7/18/08 @ONE) each posted 5.0+ innings, but allowed only one hit.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: The Cyclones' offense exploded for seven runs in the bottom of the first in Tuesday's 9-2 win vs. Aberdeen...They also accomplished the feat in the bottom of the third in a 13-3 win vs. Wilmington last Wednesday...Brooklyn had 10 consecutive batters reach base with one out in the inning...The seven-run frames are the largest for the Cyclones since they erupted for nine in the bottom of the second inning on July 27, 2023, vs. Wilmington, in an 11-7 triumph...The 13 runs for Brooklyn set a new season high...The Cyclones had not tallied that many in a single contest since a 13-12 win at Asheville in 10 innings on August 24, 2023...It was the first time Brooklyn scored 13+ in a nine-inning game dating back to an 18-1 thrashing at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2005...Since 2005, the Cyclones' highwater mark for runs in a single inning is 10 in the top of the sixth of a 20-6 romp at Bowling Green on May 27, 2022...The 20 runs were also a franchise record.

YOUTH IS SERVED: **Gilbert Gómez** takes over as manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2024...At 32 years of age, the Santo Domingo, D.R. native is the youngest skipper in franchise history...After leading Single-A St. Lucie last summer, Gómez served as manager of Tigres del Licey in the Dominican Winter League (LIDOM)...Became the youngest manager to win a championship in LIDOM history and the second-youngest manager to win a game in Caribbean Series history...Gómez's younger brother, **Dariel**, played at Double-A Binghamton in the Mets' organization last summer and is currently with the Charleston Dirty Birds of the MLB Partner Atlantic League...Older brother, **José**, is a scout for the Tampa Bay Rays and general manager for LIDOM's Leones del Escogido...Older brother, **Héctor**, is a well-known baseball reporter...Gómez also played seven years in New York's farm system, posting a .662 OPS in 537 games.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The Cyclones have four of the Top 30 per BA: **Ryan Clifford** (No. 5), **Brandon Sproat** (11), **Nolan McLean** (15), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)... Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Clifford (4), Sproat (13), McLean (19), Ziegler (22), and INF **Wilfredo Lara** (23)...MLB Pipeline also considers Clifford the 87th-best farmhand in all of baseball.

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision last Sunday afternoon vs. Wilmington...Did not allow a run on one hit over three innings...Walked one and struck out two...Induced a double play...Removed after 37 pitches and 21 strikes (56.76%) in his first career start on four days rest...Relieved by RHP **Ben Simon** to start the top of the fourth in a scoreless game...Wilmington went on to snatch the series finale, 5-1.

HAVE IT TWO WAYS: McLean is listed as a two-way player on the Brooklyn Cyclones roster and is expected to serve as a designated hitter on weekends during the season...At the plate this season, the 22-year-old has reached base safely in 10-of-11 games played...He is 9-for-41 (.220) with a eight runs scored, five doubles, three home runs, and seven RBI...In his professional career, McLean is 11-for-57 (.193) at the plate with a five doubles, four home runs, and 10 RBI with a .800 OPS.

PROSPECT RADAR: McLean enters the 2024 campaign as one of the top prospects in the New York Mets farm system...The 22-year-old is considered New York's No. 15 prospect per *Baseball America* and No. 19 by MLB Pipeline.

SPRING BREAKOUT: The Willow Springs, N.C. native earned the win pitching in relief for the New York Mets prospects in their contest against the Washington Nationals' farmhands on Friday, March 15...McLean came on in support of former Cyclone RHP **Blade Tidwell** in the top of the fifth...The right-hander did not allow a run on one hit, did not walk a batter, and struck out a batter...Tossed only 10 pitches (7 strikes)...Relieved by RHP **Brandon Sproat** to start the sixth in the Mets' 4-2 win.

COWBOY UP: The second-year pro had a tremendous career at Oklahoma State before departing...In 2023, McLean served predominantly as a relief pitcher, posting a 1-2 record with a 3.30 ERA (11 ER in 30.0 IP) and six saves, tallying 34 strikeouts...As a hitter, he collected a .250/.379/.532 line with a .911 OPS, nine home runs and 29 RBI...McLean was a Perfect Game/Rawlings Second Team All-American in 2022 and was a member of the Oklahoma State football team as a quarterback in 2020.

TWO TIMES: McLean was drafted for the second time last summer, as the New York Mets chose him with the 91st-overall pick...The right-hander was also selected by the Baltimore Orioles in the third round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Oklahoma State University, but did not sign...Joined teammate RHP **Brandon Sproat** as two of three players selected in the top 10 rounds that did not sign.

FAMILIAR FACES: While at the Oklahoma State University, McLean spent the summer of 2021 pitching for the Chatham Anglers of the Cape Cod Baseball League...During that time, the right-hander was teammates with current Cyclones RHP **Brandon Sproat** and former Brooklyn RHP **Kolby Kubichek** and C **Kevin Parada**.
