

On June 23, 2021, the Pelicans threw just the second combined no-hitter in franchise history against the Columbia Fireflies, and first since 2012. DJ Herz, Jeremiah Estrada (pictured), Bailey Reid, and Danis Correa struck out 16 batters in Columbia to secure the historic achievement. Estrada finished the season with a 1.57 ERA in 23 innings pitched as a Pelican.


