TWINS REPORT: The Twins (36-34) were walked off 3-2 in Houston last night. Brooks Lee tied the game at 2-2 with a two-run blast, his sixth of the season, in the fifth. Cam Smith singled off Jhoan Duran in the bottom of the ninth to win it for the Astros. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (33-29) have won three straight after topping Corpus Christi (HOU) 3-1 yesterday at home. 24-year-old 3B Rubel Cespedes is riding a 7-game hit streak and is 17-last-30 (.400) with a .960+ OPS in the month of June. High-A Cedar Rapids (37-25) blanked Peoria (STL) 8-0. Twins No. 4 prospect Kalen Culpepper went O-for-2 with a walk and still ranks among the top-10 in the Midwest League in average, slugging, and OPS. Low-A Fort Myers (27-34) were walked off in 11 innings in Dunedin (TOR) despite matching the Blue Jays with 11 hits. 20-year-old Byron Chourio led the way with a 3-hit game for the Mighty Mussels. LAST APPEARANCE: Started May 27th in the series opener at Werner Park. Pitched around traffic in his first two innings of work, but threw up a pair of zeroes. Recorded a 1-2-3 third inning before running into trouble in the fourth, an inning in which he walked three hitters, including one that brought in a run and then yielded a two-run single to Peyton Wilson before he was lifted for Randy Dobnak rather than face Jac Caglianone for a third time. Threw 26 sliders (35%), 22 four-seamers (29%), 12 knuckle balls (16%), 9 curveballs (12%), 4 changeups (5%), and 2 cutters (3%). Generated seven whiffs, led by four on the slider. Threw 7 of his 12 knuckle balls for strikes and got just one swing-and-miss on the pitch. Recorded a nunchout aniece on the slider. Knuckle ball, and curveball. Recorded a punchout apiece on the slider, knuckle ball, and curveball.

THE KNUCKLEBALL FRATERNITY: When he debuted on September 19 with the Saints last season Lewis became just the third pitcher in Triple-A to throw an offering recorded as a knuckleball (not counting position players) by pitch tracking last year, joining El Paso's Matt Waldron and Lehigh Valley's Nick Nelson. Only Waldron threw the knuckleball more than 7% of the time like Lewis (it was Waldron's primary offering at 43%) & neither Waldron nor Nelson's knuckleball averaged more than 80 mph. Lewis' hard-knuckler came in at an average of 83.2 mph, with his hardest of the day clocking in at 85.8 mph. MLB's Statcast system has never in its 17 seasons of existence recorded a knuckle ball in the Major Leagues faster than 84.2 mph (thrown by Padres' Matt Waldon in June 2024). In a poll of seven Twins catchers at this year's Spring Training, the group identified Lewis' knuckleball as the filthiest pitch in camp. Saints catcher Patrick Winkel told the Minnesota Star Tribune's Bobby Nightengale that one of the knuckleballs Lewis threw in pregame warm-ups hit him squarely in the mask.

R.A. DICKEY ON LINE 1: One of Lewis' secondary offerings is a knuckleball that he picked up when he was 10 years old. He started throwing it at a Pony League All-Star practice and blew away coaches with it. His high school coaches allowed him to stick wih it and realized in college that it was for real. Along the way, he has gotten tips from R.A. Dickey on how to throw the pitch, which will average in the mid-80s.

THE BEST WAY TO CATCH A KNUCKLEBALL? WAIT TIL IT STOPS ROLLING AND PICK IT UP: When the Twins took Lewis in the ninth round of the 2022 MLB Amateur Draft, Lewis bough an oversized catching mitt, which he passes along to anyone who catches for him. Catchers joke that it looks like a softball first base mitt, but it's absolutely necessary.

LEWIS KNOWS NO-NO's: In Lewis' final Double-A outing last season on September 12, he did not allow a hit until there were two outs in the fifth inning. However, he has been part of a no-hitter in his career. On May 14, 2023 with Fort Myers, Lewis spun 5.2 innings of perfect baseall, retiring all 17 hitters he faced, striking out seven. The Mighty Mussels went on to finis hthe game without allowing a hit or a walk, but lost the perfect game on a wild pitch and a dropped third strike in the eighth inning.
