**BACK IN THE WIN COLUMN:** The Omaha Storm Chaser scored five runs against St. Paul right-hander Michael Pineda, who was making a rehab start, including four runs in the second inning, to win 6-1 and snap a three-game losing streak. **OF Rudy Martin** doubled and scored in the first inning, finishing the game 2-for-4 with a stolen base in his 2021 Triple-A debut. **OF Anderson Miller** doubled with the bases loaded as part of the four-run second inning, and **INF/OF Erick Mejia** smacked a solo home run to cap the scoring in the eighth. On the mound, **LHP Marcelo Martinez** held the Saints to one run on five hits in 5.2 innings while striking out seven and walking none. Martinez did not allow a run until the sixth, when Drew Maggi hit a solo home run.

**RED, WHITE, AND BUBBA:** **OF Bubba Starling** was named to Team USA's roster for the upcoming Olympic Games in Tokyo, Japan. Starling is one of 24 players selected to compete for Team USA—12 position players and 12 pitchers—and is one of two players on the roster to have played for Omaha. **OF Jack Lopez**, who currently plays for Worcester (BOS), was also named to the Olympic Team roster. The squad will begin pre-Olympic workouts on Thursday, July 16 at the USA Baseball National Training Complex in Cary, N.C., before traveling to Japan for their first game on Friday, July 30, against Israel. Starling is batting .271 (23-for-85) in 24 games with Omaha this season, tallying six doubles, one triple, and seven home runs. His .612 slugging percentage is eighth in the league among players with at least 90 plate appearances.

**BROHEARN BLASTS:** **INF/OF Ryan O'Hearn** was named Triple-A East Player of the Month for June on Friday after hitting .365 (25-for-65) with a league-leading 12 home runs and 1.452 OPS in 17 games with Omaha in June. O'Hearn hit a walk-off, two-run homer to begin the month of June and hit five homers in a six-game series against Iowa at Werner Park, then hit five homers in a three-game span—including back-to-back two-homer games—at CHS Field against St. Paul—before hitting safely in five of six games against Louisville at Werner Park. O'Hearn was recalled by Kansas City on June 21.

**ALL-STAR ALUM:** Former Storm Chaser **Salvador Perez** ('11-'12, '18) was named a 2021 American League All-Star on Thursday, marking the seventh All-Star selection of his career and the sixth time he will start at catcher in the MLB All-Star Game, to be played this year on Tuesday, July 13, at Coors Field in Denver, Colorado. His seventh selection marks the second-most All-Star game selections by an Omaha alum, trailing **George Brett** (73-'74), a 13-time All-Star.

**JOYOUS JUNE:** After going 16-7 in May, the Storm Chasers went 16-10 in June to remain in first place in the Triple-A East Midwest Division. It's the 17th time since 2011 that Omaha has won at least 16 games in a single month. Omaha held sole possession of first place for the entire month of June and has been in sole possession of first place since May 26 (36 days). Following a 1-0 start to July, Omaha is 33-17 (.660) on pace to finish the 130-game season 85-45, which would tie the inaugural 1969 Omaha Royals (85-55) for the second-most wins in a single season in franchise history, trailing the 1990 Omaha Royals (86-60), and set a new franchise record for winning percentage in a single season (currently .607, 1969). In 26 games in June, the Chasers offense hit .280/.342/.540, averaged 6.7 runs/game, and hit 59 home runs in June. Omaha's 59 home runs in June were tied with the Reno Aces for the most home runs in June in affiliated baseball (MLB and MiLB). On the mound, the Chasers posted a team ERA of 5.35 with a starting pitching ERA of 6.12 and a bullpen ERA of 4.69.

**HISTORIC HOMER PACE:** The Storm Chasers lead Triple-A East and all of Minor League Baseball with 96 home runs in 50 games, averaging just under two home runs per game. Omaha is on pace to hit 249 home runs in the 130-game season, which would break the franchise record of 231 set in 1999 (141 games). The 1999 Omaha Golden Spikes' 231 home runs in a season was a modern Pacific Coast League record until 2019, when El Paso hit 258 home runs in 140 games. If the 2021 season included all 142 initially-scheduled games, Omaha would be on pace for 272 homers. The Sacramento Solons hit 305 home runs in 1974 while playing home games in a converted football stadium with a left-field fence located 233 feet from home plate. Omaha's 96 homers are also more than 14 teams in Major League Baseball. The Chasers have at least one home run in 42 of 50 games this season, notching a 30-12 record when hitting at least one home run. Omaha has recorded 23 multi-homer games, including three four-homer games, five five-homer games, and one seven-homer game.

**FOR OMAHA:** **LHP Daniel Lynch** makes his eighth start (ninth appearance) for Omaha after tossing 5.0 scoreless innings on 6/26 @ IOW in his last start. Lynch tied a season-high with seven strikeouts in his last start, marking the most strikeouts in a start since 5/30 vs. IND. The left-hander faces St. Paul for the second time—he allowed a career-high seven runs on eight hits (including three home runs) in 5.0 innings at CHS Field on 6/10.

**FOR ST. PAUL:** **RHP Josh Winder** makes his Triple-A debut with St. Paul. Winder, who had a 1.97 ERA in 10 starts with Double-A Wichita, is the No. 19 prospect in Minnesota Twins organization according to *Baseball America* and was named to the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game earlier this week.
