### PITCHING SHINES AGAIN IN WIN OVER ROCKHOUNDS:

The Frisco RoughRiders had dominant pitching again in their 3-1 win over the Midland RockHounds from Momentum Bank Ballpark on Saturday night. The Riders (23-15, 67-40) once again were dominant on the hill, led by starter **Winston Santos** (3-2), who threw five shutout innings, allowing just three hits while striking out seven and walking two to earn the victory. Frisco starting pitchers on the road trip have a 1.66 ERA (10ER/54.1IP) over 11 games. **Damian Mendoza** and **Jackson Kelley** combined to allow just one run to Midland (23-14, 63-43) over their four innings from the bullpen with Kelley capturing his first-career Double-A save. Offensively, the Riders found the scoreboard in the fifth inning, scoring on a **Keyber Rodriguez** RBI single to make it 1-0. In the sixth, Frisco added on when **Luis Mieses** laced an RBI single to right and an RBI fielder's choice from **Max Acosta** brought in their third run in the seventh. Midland's Shohei Tomioka (2-4) took the loss, allowing two runs in relief. The trio of Rodriguez, Mieses and **Abimelec Ortiz** all had two hits on the night.

### START ME UP:

RoughRiders starting pitchers have been dominant over their last 11 games, owning a 1.66 ERA (10ER/54.1IP). Overall, Frisco has allowed just 25 earned runs in their last 11 games for a 2.34 ERA (96.0IP). The Riders have played incredibly close games over the road trip with nine of the 11 games being decided by three runs or fewer (Frisco is 5-4 in those games).

### CHICKS DIG THE LONG BALL:

The RoughRiders have hit 15 home runs over their last 17 games, the sixth-most in the Texas League over the last two weeks. During that span, the Riders are third in the Texas League with a .739 OPS, second with a .259 batting average and are sixth with 4.0 runs per game. Holding them back, Frisco is just batting just .172 (26-for-151) with runners in scoring position over their last 17 games.

### READY TO ROCK(ER):

RoughRiders starting pitcher **Kumar Rocker** has been fantastic in his three starts with the RoughRiders since returning from his "Tommy John" surgery rehab this season. In the three starts, he has pitched 11.0 shutout innings, allowing just five hits and one walk with 16 strikeouts. Additionally, he has been incredibly efficient, averaging just 11.9 pitches per inning with the Riders. Rocker, who was selected by the Rangers as the No. 3 overall pick in the 2022 draft, is the No. 3 prospect in the Rangers organization and the No. 1 pitching prospect.

### HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 35-15 at Riders Field this season. Their 35 wins and .700 winning percentage at home are both first in Double-A and first among non-Triple-A teams in Minor League Baseball. At home this season, Frisco has a +74 run differential, a 3.73 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .761 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 32-25 with a 3.22 ERA, but a +24 run differential while averaging 3.9 runs per game and owning a .641 OPS (10th in the league). **Cody Freeman** is slashing .339/.398/.594/.992 at home this season with nine of his 13 home runs. His .339 batting average is the best in the Texas League by a player at their home stadium.

### OSUNA FROM THE RIDERS:

**Alejandro Osuna** has been incredible for Frisco since joining them from High-A Hickory. In 31 games, he is hitting .303 (36-for-119)/.404/.521/.925 with 13 doubles, two triples, three home runs and 17 RBIs. Over his last 28 games, he is batting .311 (33-for-106)/.422/.538/.960 with 11 doubles, two triples, three home runs and 17 RBIs. He has reached in 28 of his 31 games with the Riders. He set that career high in his final game in High-A this year, also hitting for the cycle in a 5-for-5 game.

### THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen is the second-best in the Texas League this season, owning a 3.11 ERA, which is also the fourth-best in all of Minor League Baseball. Overall, the Riders are on pace to have the second-best team ERA in franchise history (3.47), just behind 2014 (3.39). Additionally, their .228 BAA is on pace to tie the best in the franchise's history (.228 in 2021).

### WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

### ABOUT EMILIANO

-Signed in 2020 for \$10,000 at age 18 (which is much older than the normal 16-year-old international signing age for most Dominican players).

-Routinely touches triple digits with his fastball.

-Comps to Yordano Ventura because of small frame and electric stuff. Changeup has splitter-like action to it.

### 2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation and as the No. 16 prospect in the Rangers organization according to MLB.com.

-After allowing four runs over 2.2 innings in first start, has gone 2-0 with 1.20 ERA over last six starts (4ER/30.0IP).

-He allowed two doubles in his first start and did not allow any extra-base hits after until 5/26, when he surrendered a solo home run.

-Tied career-high with 11 strikeouts on 6/16 vs. AMA.

-Participated in the 2024 Futures Game. As the starter for the American League at Globe Life Field, he became the first pitcher in Futures Game history to throw two perfect innings, retiring all six batters he faced on 14 pitches (6 in the first inning, 8 in the second) with one strikeout.

### 2023 SEASON

-Finished 4th among Rangers farm hands in 2023 with a 12.26 K/9 (7th-best in the South Atlantic League).

-Missed the first month and more with minor right forearm tightness (activated 5/23).

-Went 2-1, 4.88 ERA (13 ER/24.0 IP) with 27 SO/15 BB and a .258 opp. BA over first 8 G/5 GS before forgoing his 4-seam fastball for a sinker, and was 3-2, 4.30 ERA (18 ER/37.2 IP) with 57 SO/18 BB and a .213 opp. BA in 10 G/9 GS after making the change (beg. 7/16).

-10.13 K/9 with 4s fastball, 13.62 K/9 after change to 2s fastball.

-Named the Arizona Fall League Reliever of the Year after going 1-0 with five saves across eight scoreless outings (11.0 innings) with 48.7 % strikeout rate (19 of 39 batters).

### 2022 SEASON

-Transitioned to a starting role after appearing exclusively as a reliever in 2021

-Spent entire campaign at Down East (A), recorded team-high 115 strikeouts, 7th-most in Carolina League, and his 12.27 SO/9 figure ranked 2nd among Texas farmhands (min. 50.0 IP) to Larson Kindreich (12.66)

-Went 1-0, 1.53 ERA (3 ER/17.2 IP) and 35 SO over 4 starts in August, earning the Texas organization's Minor League Starting Pitcher of the Month award.

### 2021 SEASON

-Struck out 48 of 133 (36.1%) batters faced and held opponents to a .214 BA (24-112)

-Participated in the Rangers' Fall Instructional League and Texas Tour games against local universities in October
